Lighter Adapter

Connects to your vehicle's lighter/accessory Socket

Modular Connector

Connects to your detector

USB Jack

Charges other devices simultaneously

High Speed Charge Selector (underneath)

For high speed charging select the type of device that you are charging from the USB Jack:

1. Apple device
2. Non-Apple device

Power/Alert Light

Blinking blue: Cord has power but no Bluetooth connection

Solid blue: Cord has Bluetooth connection and you are connected to the Escort Live! app

Blinking red: Receiving an alert

Solid orange: Receiving a locked-out alert

Mute Button

Push to mute an alert

Push and hold to report an alert when connected to Escort Live!

Push three times to lock out an alert or to unlock a stored false alert

Registering, Downloading and Pairing

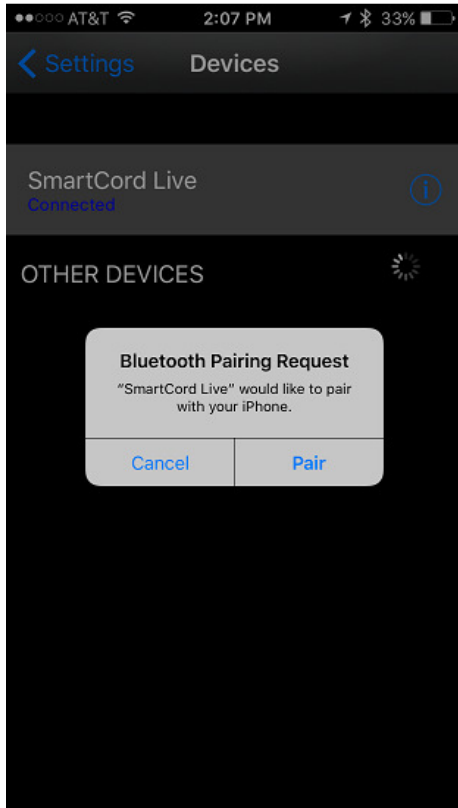
Before downloading ESCORT Live!, you must first register your SmartCord Live.

Visit EscortInc.com, click **Product Registration** and follow the instructions to complete the product registration.

1. Enter the App Store or Google Play on your iPhone or smartphone and search for **Escort Live Radar**



2. Follow the onscreen instructions to download **Escort Live Radar** and then open the app
3. When prompted, enter the username and password you created when registering your product at EscortInc.com
4. Press the Settings button then press **Devices**
5. If your SmartCord Live cord is nearby and plugged into your vehicle's accessory outlet then you should see **SmartCord Live** listed with **Not Connected** shown underneath.
6. Press the **SmartCord Live** device entry and when prompted select **Pair**



7. The SmartCord Live **Power/Alert** light will be solid blue to confirm the connection
