Dear Sir:

In regard to the question that has been raised about the difference between the photos of the device in the SAR test and part 90 reports.

The device that is correctly shown in the photos taken during the part 90 certification test is the transmitter module that is actually installed into the housing photographed during the SAR test.

The SAR testing lab requested that we supply the complete device. This was requested so the lab could complete the SAR testing as the operator would use or hold the device. The SAR lab photographed the assembled device as they tested it and apparently did not photograph the transmitter module.

The transmitter module, pictured in the part 90 test photos, is installed in the device housing along with the video camera, the batteries and supporting circuit boards. The device housing protects the components from the surrounding environment.
