Introduction:

New imperial 2.4G keyboard is one of the best computer input devices in the market today. It combines the convenience of radio frequency wireless and the trackball with two sets of mouse keys and scroll wheel.

As no cable connected to the keyboard, you can put it away to save space when you finish using it. New Imperial 2.4G keyboard is ergonomically designed allowing for comfortable use on table or lap.

Product Feature:

- 1. Built-in optical trackball, 25mm, 1000DPI.
- 2. Scissor structure key:87 keys, including 13 hot-keys 2 mouse keys and scroll wheel.
- 3. Normal/Gaming mode switch for shift function.
- 4. Non-skid rubber feet.
- 5. Under gaming mode, press and release gaming or left mouse key, will shoot three times each time.
- 6.2-AA rechargeable Ni-MH batteries included.
- 7. Compatible with Windows 98/Me/NT/2000/XP/Vista/Windows 7.
- 8. Keyboard dimension: 490x200x54. 5mm, Receiver dimension: 53x16. 5x9. 3mm.



9. Effective distance:up to 10 meters.

Installation:



1. Insert two AA Ni-MH batteries into the battery compartment at the bottom of the keyboard, take care to insert the batt -eries in the correct polarity, take out the RF receiver and close the battery cover.

2. Plug the RF Receiver into the USB port of your computer.

3. ID pairing:

- a.Keep the distance between keyboard and receiver within 1 meter.
- b. Press the connect button at the front side of key -board (see image2). Receiver LED light willflash 1-3 seconds and go out, which indicates ID pairing success.

Note:

- 1. RF signal LED on the receiver will flash when the keyboard is being used.
- 2. Battery Low indicator flashes red light, you need to charge the batteries. Connect the keyboard to a free USB port on PC with the mini-USB extension cable to charge batteries. During charging, Battery Low indicator displays red light, it would become green light after the batteries are fully charged.
- 3. This keyboard is using the recharge battery, please fully charged the battery or charge at least 8 hours upon the first use to increase the battery life.

Caution:

Please make sure the batteries inside the keyboard are rechargeable.




Troubleshooting:

If your keyboard can not work after installation please check followings:

- a. Make sure you have connected the receiver correctly to the computer. The receiver has been properly plug -ged into computer's USB port.
- b. Make sure you have inserted two AA batteries into its compartment correctly.
- c. If without any interference, such as other computer peripherals, the working distance (distance between keyboard and the receiver) is about 10 meters.
- d. If using more than two units and interference occur-red, please reset ID again.
