The device complies with Part 15 of FCC rules. Operation is subject to the following two conditions:

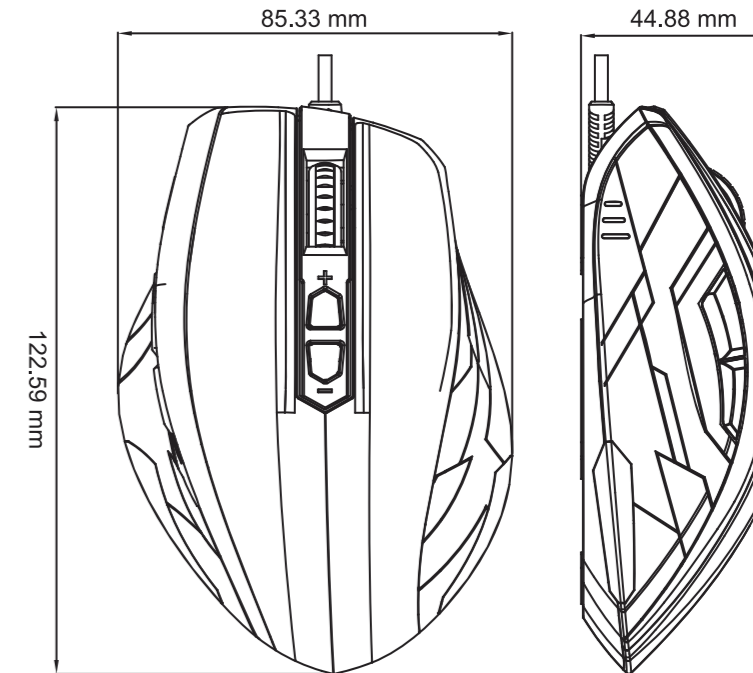
- (1) This device may not cause harmful interference.
