Pursuant to § 0.457 and 0.459 of the Commission's Rules (CFR 47), and § 552 (b) (4) of the Freedom of Information Act, Tecore, Inc. D/B/A Tecore Networks hereby requests Long-Term confidentiality and treatment of certain information accompanying this application. The materials contain trade secrets and proprietary information not customarily released to the public. The public disclosure of the matters will be harmful to the Applicant and provide unjustified benefits to its competitors.

The request for Long-Term Confidentially of the User's Manual (#5) is submitted because of the highly technical nature of the manual and of the product. The **QLJNIB-002** system operates in RF spectrum licensed from the FCC. The configuration, maintenance, and support of the system require highly-trained technical personnel trained by the Grantee, and **QLJNIB-002** is serviceable by only the Grantee or a designated 3rd party technical expert under non-disclosure protections. The User's Manual (#5) contains proprietary information that is supplied to any designated 3rd party technical expert only under non-disclosure provisions.

Tecore Networks also hereby request Short-Term Confidentiality for 180 days after the grant as outlined in the Public Notice DA – 04-1705. This provision will give Tecore Networks temporary confidentiality of commercially sensitive information prior to product release.
