Troubleshooting

Volume is not high enough

Hearing Distortion

- Lower BT-129, Mobile phone/device volume.
- If low battery capacity, please charge it.

Can not paired with Bluetooth device

- Make sure that your mobile phone/device is compatible with Bluetooth.
- Make sure it's charged up.
- Turn off your BT-129 and mobile phone/device, then power on and reconnect.

Signal loss or distortion

- Move BT-129 to the place near the mobile phone/device.
- Ensure it's charged up.
- Power off the BT-129, Mobile phone/Device, then repower on.

Music Playing

After the speaker is connected to your mobile phone via Bluetooth, press on the speaker to play, press it again to pause. Press + 2 seconds to play next song. Press - 2 seconds to start over the current song or get backward to the previous song. Press + 1 time or press time to adjust the volume.

Notes:

- The music player build-in your mobile phone is necessary to support this feature.
- Pair and connect your mobile phone with the speaker before using this feature.
- If a call is coming in when you are listening to music, the music will pause automatically and replaced by the incoming-call-tone. Once the call is finished, the music will continue.

Voice Dialing

In standby mode, short press + and at the same time then you will hear a tone for voice dialing.

Note:

• This function need the support of the mobile phone.

Mute/Un-mute

Press + and = at the same time during a call to mute the microphone.


A single beep will follow to indicate success of the operation.


• There will be two beeps every 5 seconds until you hold these two buttons again to un-mute the microphone.


Front View

Calling

Answer a call Short press **>** to answer an incoming call.

Reject a call Press and hold ▶ for 2 seconds to reject the call.

End a call

After calling, short press **b** to end the call, or end the call on the phone.

Last Number Redial

Short press \mathbf{D} 2 times to redial the last call.

Pairing and connecting

Enter pairing mode

Press and hold **b** for 7 seconds. Wait until red LED and blue LED flash alternatively along with two beeps.

Pair

- 1.Enable Bluetooth function on your phone or other smart devices and search Bluetooth accessories in range.
- 2.Choose BT-129 when it shows up and get connected (input 0000, if a pairing code is requested).
- 3.When blue LED flashes 4 times along with two beeps, BT-129 gets connected successfully.

Notes:

- If the paring is not complete within 5 minutes, the speaker will quit the pairing mode. You need to repeat the steps of pairing again.
- After the connection is successful, if you turn the speaker off and turn it on again, it will be connected to the last connected mobile phone automatically. Also, a beep will be heard.

Disconnect

Power off the BT-129 or disconnect the Bluetooth function on your phone or other smart devices.

Battery/Charger

The speaker has a built-in Li-ion battery (3.7V, 2200mAh), so it can be used without connecting with a power supply(5V,0.5A). To charge the battery, please connect with computer or charger through charging line.

Notes:

- When BT-129 is charging the LED status indicator will be RED. When fully charged the RED status indicator LED will go off.
- From fully discharged battery to fully charged will take 3 hours.
- You can plug the cable to charge BT-129 while still using it when its battery is low, but this can shorten the battery life. It is recommended to power off BT-129 and fully charge it before use.

Operations

PowerOn/Off

Power On: in power off mode, press and hold **>** for 4 seconds to power on BT-129. Wait until the blue LED flashes 3 times along with a single beep.

Power Off: in standby status, to power off the device, press and hold **>** for 3 seconds when it is on . Wait until the red LED off along with a single beep.

Volume Adjust

Volume Up: press + 1 time to adjust the volume. Volume Down: press - 1 time to adjust the volume.
