- 1) Why is this not a modular approval? May need modular approval. ANS: Device is an Evaluation Kit.
- 2) Conducted for power misspelled on grant note. ANS: Grant note Corrected

3) 2.5cm in grant note implies this is portable device where SAR limits apply. MPE estimate does not apply to show compliance for portable devices and may be misleading. Please clarify/harmonize grant notes and RFx evaluation if appropriate.

ANS: MPE was provided for information purposes. Device is designed for use in computer on a desktop for evaluating 802.11 devices.

4) May need grant note that separate approval is required when installed in specific host devices for use in portable exposure conditions.

ANS: Device is an Evaluation Kit, general public does not use the device.

5) May need grant note with 20cm instructions for use without additional evaluation in mobile exposure conditions.

ANS: Please refer to #4

6) Why does grant list maximum antenna gain? Part 15 grants are only for specific antennas per 15.203 and 15.204(c). This grant note could imply that other antennas can be used without additional approvals. Please revise.

ANS: After the recent TCB training, I discussed this with Joe Dichoso and I was informed the conducted power was listed for 15.247 devices and the antenna gain was listed in the notes. The grant note has been revised for clarity.

7) Is this grant for a BGA module, or for a module evaluation kit? Users manual exhibit is for eval. kit. Please submit installation and use instructions for BGA module.

ANS: Device is an Evaluation Kit, used to evaluate 802.11 devices.
