Re: Change in Identification – FCCID: QRF-MX5060N

This letter is to inform you that the product family TR-MX50-XX and TR-MX60-XX are electrically and functionally identical (same radio module, same amplifier, same hardware platform) to the WPJ342LV, WPJ342HV, MML342LV, MML342HV, MMJ342LV, MMJ342HV, MMS342LV, and MMS342HV currently marketed by Compex under the FCC ID TK4WPJ342. The electrical components are exactly the same in all models, just different antenna or case style. For example, the Tranzeo model TR-MX50-15 uses the 15dBi panel antenna tested in the FCC report and the TR-MX60-15 would be identical except has IP67 rating case for water and dust protection instead of IP55 protection in the TR-MX50 family.

The date of the original grant of equipment authorization is 09/01/2014. No modifications have been made to the operation of the electrical hardware; the change in identification is for marketing purposes. A sample the product label is attached. Photographs detailing the exterior of the units are also submitted.

The equipment bearing FCCID TK4WPJ342 will continue to be marketed by Compex Systems Pte, LTD.
