Your antenna is the interface between an RFID reader and the world beyond. It must be ruggedly built to survive in extreme, realworld conditions that include dust, shock, vibration and very high or low temperatures. The most important electrical features of an RFID antenna are an excellent VSWR, indicating an efficient transfer of power from the reader to the antenna, dual circular polarization to ensure orientation independence and good performance with both single- and dual-element tags and good isolation to ensure minimal interference between the reader's transmitter and receiver. The Mercury4 Antenna is field proven to provide excellent performance.
