



To Whom It May Concern,

As stated in ThingMagic's Mercury5 ("M5") User Guide, the M5 and associated equipment must be installed by a ThingMagic representative or an installer approved in advance by ThingMagic. This requirement will ensure that the installer will be trained to install the equipment to ensure that a separation distance of at least 22 cm between the radiating elements of the antenna and the bodies of nearby persons is maintained at all times during its operation in order to comply with FCC requirements for RF exposure safety.

The M5 and associated equipment will be installed in a controlled environment to ensure proper antenna locations.
