



5. Connect the battery plug with the cable socket inside the vehicle's battery compartment




4. Remove the battery

Charging the vehicle's battery:

- Connect the battery plug with the charging cable . Plug the charging cable into the USB socket.
- The total charging time for a full charge is 3 hours When charging, the charging cable indicator light flashes green; when charging is complete, the green light will turn off.

- 2. Use a screwdriver to loosen the screw
- 3. Remove the battery cover.
- 4. Insert 6 AA batteries according to the polarity indicated inside the battery
- 5. Replace the battery cover and tighten the screw.


