



You can control playback speed in 3 levels.

### ● MP3 Playback Function

You can listen to the saved MP3 files.

### ● Equalizer Function

You can listen to a MP3 file in the Flat, Pop, Classic, Jazz, or Rock mode.

### ● Receiving and Recording FM Radio






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## Before Using

### How to Charge Battery

1. Insert the Ni-MH rechargeable battery into the charger with correct polarities.
2. Plug the charger to outlet.  
After fully charging, the light changes from red color to green color.



☞ Note ☞

- It takes around 2.5 hours in totally discharged condition.
- The charger is free voltage.




### Warning

- Do not disassemble the charger.
- Do not over charge or over discharge.
- Use the specified standard battery only.  
('Ni-MH' rechargeable battery)

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## Before Using

### ● Inserting Battery



1. Push the battery cover slightly and slide it in the arrow direction.
2. Insert the rechargeable battery with correct polarities (+, -).
3. Close the battery cover.



#### Caution

- Make sure to replace the batteries in stop state.
- Make sure that the polarities (+, -) are correct.



- ▶ The "Low Batt" message is displayed when the voltage is low due to consumption. If the low voltage state continues more than 10 seconds, the power is turned off automatically.


- ▶ Battery lifetime is subject to the volume you use.
- ▶ The power is turned off automatically for efficient use of the battery if you do not use the product for more than 1 minute.
- ▶ When you do not use the product, set the HOLD switch to ON to prevent unwanted consumption of the battery due to misuse of the buttons.

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## Before Using

### ● Powering On/Off

1. Set the HOLD button to OFF.
2. [Recorder] Press the POW/PAUSE/DISP button shortly once to turn the power on.  
[Remote Controller] Press the POW/PAUSE/FUNC /DISP button shortly once.
3. [Recorder] Press the POW/PAUSE/DISP button longer than 3 seconds to turn the power off.  
[Remote Controller] Press the POW/PAUSE/FUNC /DISP button longer than 3 seconds.



Note

- ▶ The power is turned off automatically if there is no operation in VOICE and MP3 mode for 1 minute.

### ● Button Functions


- ▶ PLAY/STOP: Playback and Stop
- ▶ REC/STOP: Recording and Stop
- ▶ FF: Fast forward
- ▶ REW: Rewind
- ▶ VOLUME: Volume control
- ▶ POW/PAUSE/DISP: Turns the power on, stops playback/recording temporarily, and selects functions.
- ▶ MENU: Selecting folder, mode and VOS function
- ▶ ERASE: Deleting recorded files.
- ▶ HOLD: Button hold on/off to prevent unwanted operations.

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## Before Using

### ● Connecting Remote Controller

1. Insert the remote controller's plug into Earphone Terminal on top of the recorder.
2. Insert the earphone plug into Earphone Terminal on top of the remote controller.



### ● Setting Date/Time

1. Turn the power on.
2. Press the MENU button.
3. Select '6. Set date' using the FF/REW button.
4. Set the year.  
Select a year you want using the FF/REW button when the "-Y" message blinks on the LCD screen and press the MENU button shortly once. The year you selected is set and the mode changes to the month you can set a month.
5. Set the month  
Select a month you want using the FF/REW button when the "-M" message blinks on the LCD screen and press the MENU button shortly once. The month you selected is set and the mode changes to the day you can set a day.
6. Set the day  
Select a day you want using the FF/REW button when the "-D" message blinks on the LCD screen and press the MENU button shortly once. The day you selected is set and the mode changes to the 12/24 time mode you can set a time.

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## Before Using

### 7. Set the 12/24 time mode.

Select the 12 or 24 time mode using the FF/REW button when the "12MOD" message blinks on the LCD screen and press the MENU button shortly once. The time mode is set to 12 or 24 and the mode changes to the mode you can set a time.

### 8. Set the time.

Select the time you want using the FF/REW button when the "12" message blinks on the LCD screen and press the MENU button shortly once. The time you selected is set and the mode changes to the mode you can set a minute.

### 9. Set the minute.


Select the minute you want using the FF/REW button when the "00" message blinks on the LCD screen and press the MENU button longer once to set the minute you selected. The time setting is completed and the product changes to the standby mode.


► When setting date and time, if you do not press any button for more than 20 seconds or you press the MENU button longer, the date and time you have set is canceled and the mode changes to the standby mode.





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

### ● Recording


1. Turn the power on and press the REC/STOP button shortly once.
2. Press the REC/STOP button again recording.




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
## Using Voice Recorder

### Note

- If the recording source is shorter than 2 seconds, it is not recorded.
- Volume control is disabled during recording.
- If the number of the files is more than 100 for a folder, "Indexed Full!" is displayed and recording is disabled.
- When the recording time is over, "Memory Full!" is displayed and recording is disabled (See Specifications).



## Using Voice Recorder


### Playback

You can hear the recorded sound using the built-in speaker or earphone.


- Select the number of the folder or the file you wish to playback (See page 19, 29).
- Control the volume using the VOLUME button.
- [Recorder] Press the PLAY/STOP button shortly once.  
[Remote Controller] Press the PLAY/STOP/PRESET button shortly once.
- [Recorder] Press the PLAY/STOP button again shortly to stop playback.  
[Remote Controller] Press the PLAY/STOP/PRESET button again shortly.





## Using Voice Recorder

### Scanning File (FF/REW)

Using the FF/REW button, you can move to the file you want.

- ▶ Moving to the previous or next file:  
[Recorder]/[Remote Controller] Press the FF/REW button shortly during playback.
- ▶ Scanning file:  
[Recorder]/[Remote Controller] Press the FF/REW button longer during playback. For the first 10 seconds: The playback time is increased or decreased by second. After 10 seconds: The playback time is increased or decreased by 10 seconds.
- ▶ Selecting the previous or next file:  
[Recorder]/[Remote Controller] Press FF/REW button shortly in the stop state.



Moving to the previous or next file

- ◆ When you want to listen to the recorded sound from the 30-minute position on the fourth of 5 recorded files:
  1. Move to the fourth file by pressing the FF/REW button shortly in the stop mode.
  2. Press the PLAY button.
  3. Press the FF/REW button longer to move fast to a position. Fast forward/rewind works while you are holding it down. When moved to the 30-minute position, stop holding it down and playback starts from the position you stop.


### Deleting Recorded Sound

Deletes the sound recorded in the product.

#### Deleting one file



Deletes one file in the recorded sounds. The file numbers are decreased by one after deleting file.

▶ When deleting the file #3:



\* The number 4 file is moved to the number 3 file automatically.

1. Select the file to delete in stop state.
2. Press the ERASE button longer once. The "FILE ERASE" message blinks and the first 5 seconds of the recorded file are played back.
3. Press the ERASE button longer once again to delete file.



### Note

- ▶ If you press other button except the ERASE button, file deletion is cancelled.
- ▶ If you do not press any button for 5 seconds the ERASE function is released automatically.


### Deleting all files in a folder

Deletes all the recorded files saved in a folder.

1. Select the folder to delete.
2. Press the ERASE and REC/STOP buttons at the same time in stop mode for more than 2 seconds. The "FOLDER ERASE" message blinks on the LCD screen.
3. Press the ERASE button longer once again to delete all files in the folder.



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## Using Voice Recorder

### Formatting

Deletes all recorded files in the product.

1. Press the ERASE and REC/STOP buttons at the same time in stop mode for more than 4 seconds. "FOLDER ERASE" message is displayed then "FORMAT" message blinks on the LCD screen.
2. Press the ERASE button longer once again to delete all recorded files saved in the product.



### Note

- ▶ When deleting all the files or formatting, if you press other button except the ERASE button or you do not press any button for 5 seconds, file deletion is cancelled.



### Caution

- ▶ The deleted recording file cannot be recovered. Please make sure to decide carefully and check the file(s) you select to delete.


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## Using Voice Recorder

### Recording Functions

#### Recording Monitoring


Records the sound with hearing the recording sound using an earphone.  
Connect an earphone to the earphone terminal of the product.



#### Recording Pause

Stops the recording temporarily.

- [Recorder] Press the POW/PAUSE/DISP button shortly once to pause a recording.  
[Remote Controller] Press the POW/PAUSE/FUNC/DISP button shortly once to pause a recording.
- [Recorder] Press the POW/PAUSE/DISP button or REC/STOP button shortly once to start recording again.  
[Remote Controller] Press the POW/PAUSE/FUNC/DISP button shortly once to start recording again.



Note

► When 30 minutes are passed after you paused, the power is turned off automatically.

## Using Voice Recorder

#### Index Added Recording

Adds the indexing number (file number) of the file being recorded.

[Recorder] Press the FF button during recording, the file number of the file being recorded is increased and saved automatically.


[Remote Controller] Press the FF button during recording, the file number of the file being recorded is increased and saved automatically.

◆ When you press the FF button and record for 30 minutes after recording for 30 minutes starting from the number 1 file, the sound is recorded in the number 1 file for 30 minutes and in the number 2 file for 30 minutes.

#### Memory Capacity and Remaining Recording Time Display

Shows currently remaining memory capacity and remaining recording time.

- [Recorder] Press the POW/PAUSE/DISP button longer during recording, REC DATE(recording date) displays.  
[Remote Controller] Press the POW/PAUSE/FUNC/DISP button longer during recording, REC DATE displays.
- [Recorder] Press the POW/PAUSE/DISP button shortly once again, currently remaining memory capacity shows on the LCD.  
[Remote Controller] Press the POW/PAUSE/FUNC/DISP button shortly once again, currently remaining memory capacity shows on the LCD.



Note

► You can check the memory capacity and remaining recording time only during recording and playback. During recording, REC DATE -> Remain (remaining recording time) is displayed. And during playback, remaining playback time -> Remain (remaining capacity) is displayed.

## Using Voice Recorder

### ● Playback Functions

#### Volume Control

Controls the volume using the VOLUME button. The range is between 0 and 15.



#### Warning

- Do not listen to the recorded files with a loud volume. Otherwise it may damage your hearing.
- Start from a low volume, and then set the volume to an appropriate level.

#### Pause

Stops the playback temporarily.

1. [Recorder] Press the POW/PAUSE/DISP button shortly once during playback.  
[Remote Controller] Press the POW/PAUSE/FUNC/DISP button shortly once during playback.
2. [Recorder] Press the POW/PAUSE/DISP button or PLAY/STOP button shortly again to start playback again.  
[Remote Controller] Press the POW/PAUSE/DISP button or PLAY/STOP button shortly to start playback again.

#### Note

- If there is no operation for 30 minutes after the product paused, the power is turned off automatically.

#### Scan and Playback

The first 5 seconds of each files are played back one by one.

1. [Recorder] Press the PLAY/STOP button longer once in the stop mode.  
[Remote Controller] Press the PLAY/STOP button longer once in the stop mode.
2. ► SCAN PLRY- blinks on the LCD and the first 5 seconds of each file are played back in the order.

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
## Using Voice Recorder

#### Resume

Playbacks from the position you stopped when you stopped playback by pressing the PLAY/STOP button during playback and then press the PLAY/STOP button again.

#### Additional Recording

During playing back file # 2 start an additional recording.



1. Press the REC/STOP button longer once during playback.
2. Recording starts successively at the end of the file being played back.
3. Press the REC/STOP button once again to stop recording and change to the standby mode.

◆ When you want to add an additional recording to the number 2 file:

1. Press the FF/REW button to search the file # 2.
2. Press the PLAY button to playback the file.
3. Press the REC/STOP button longer than 1 second during playback to record additional sound at the end of the number 2 file.
4. Press the REC/STOP button to stop recording.




## Using Voice Recorder

### Playback Speed Control

You can control playback speed in 3 levels: Fast (20% faster than the normal speed), Normal (steady speed), or Slow (20% slower than the normal speed).


1. Press the PLAY/STOP button longer during playback.
2. Select Normal, Fast, or Slow using the FF/REW button.



### Repeating File

Repeats the selected file continuously.

1. Press the MENU button longer during playback to repeat playback.
2. Press the MENU button longer once again to release repeating file.




## Using Voice Recorder

### Repeating A-B Section

Repeats playback for a specified section.

1. Press the MENU button shortly once on the first position of the section you wish to repeat during playback, the position A is set.
2. Press the MENU button shortly once on the end position of the section you wish to repeat during playback. The position B is set and then the A-B section is played back repeatedly.
3. Press the PLAY/STOP button to release repeating section.



#### Note

► After selecting the position A, if you do not select the position B, the end position of the file is set to the position B.

## Using Voice Recorder

### Setting Menu

#### Setting Folder

You can save a file in one of A, B folders.

1. Press the MENU button shortly once.
2. Select '1. Folder Set' using the FF/REW button and press the MENU button shortly once.




3. Select one of A, B folders using the FF/REW button and press the MENU button shortly once to set the selected folder and move to the top menu.


#### Setting Recording Mode

You can record in appropriate mode you want according to your situation.

1. Press the MENU button shortly once.
2. Select '2. REC mode' using the FF/REW button and press the MENU button shortly once.



3. Select one option of HQ, LP, and SP using the FF/REW button and then press the MENU button shortly once to finish setting the recording mode and move to the top menu.



Recording Mode	Compression Rate
HQ (High quality recording mode)	64 Kbps
SP (standard recording mode)	32 Kbps
LP (long time recording mode)	16 Kbps

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## Using Voice Recorder


### Note

- ▶ The recording quality is better in the order of HQ > SP > LP.
- ▶ Recording time means the available maximum recording time. If you have recorded to the maximum recording time on the number 1 file in the HQ mode, no more can be recorded and you must delete the recorded files in order to record again.


#### Setting microphone sensitivity

You can record in appropriate mode of Hi or Low mode according to your situation.

1. Press the MENU button shortly once.
2. Select '3. Mic sense' using the FF/REW button and press the MENU shortly once.



3. Select one option of Hi and Low using the FF/REW button and then press the MENU button shortly once to finish setting the microphone sensitivity and move to the top menu.



Hi: Quiet place (when recording a lecture)



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## Using Voice Recorder

### Setting VOS

Recording is proceeded only when sound is emitted. It reduces memory usage.

1. Press the MENU button shortly once.
2. Select '4. VOS set' using the FF/REW button and press the MENU button shortly once.
3. Select ON or OFF using the FF/REW button and then press the MENU button shortly once again to finish setting VOS and move to the top menu.



► Note ◄


- The battery consumption in the VOS ON mode is the same with other mode.  
When the battery runs out the power is turned off automatically.
- Only VOS SET and MIC SENSE can be set during recording.

## Using Voice Recorder

### Repeating folder playback

Playbacks all the files in a folder repeatedly.

1. Press the MENU button shortly once
2. Select '5. Continuous set' using the FF/REW button and press the MENU button shortly once.
3. Select ON or OFF using the FF/REW button and press the MENU button shortly once to activate the repeating folder playback function and move to the top menu.



► Note ◄

- Press the MENU button, the REC/STOP or PLAY/STOP button longer once to escape from the sub menu to the Voice function directly after completing setting each item.
- Press the REC/STOP or PLAY/STOP button shortly once to cancel setting on the sub menu.



## Using MP3 Function

### Switching to MP3 function

[Recorder] Press the POW/PAUSE/DISP button shortly once in the power-on state to switch to the MP3 function.  
[Remote Controller] Press the POW/PAUSE/FUNC/DISP button shortly once to switch to the MP3 function in the stop state after turning the power on.







### Resume



Repeats playback for a specified section.


## Connecting to External Device

### ● When recording the sound of an external device to your recorder

You can record the sound of an external sound device to your recorder.

1. Connect the output terminal (earphone terminal) of an external device and the LINE -IN terminal of the recorder with an audio cable.
2. Control the volume of the external device properly. If the volume of the device is loud, the sound may be distorted when you playback the recorded sound.
3. Press the playback button of the external device and then press the RECORD button of your Voice recorder.



## Connecting to External Device

### ● When recording the sound recorded in your recorder on to an external device

You can transmit the sound recorded in your recorder onto an external device.

Connect the earphone terminal of your Voice recorder and the input terminal (microphone terminal) of an external device with an audio cable. Then, press the PLAY/STOP button of your Voice recorder and press the RECORD button of the external device.



▶ Please test before recording.  
▶ Please control the recording volume with the volume control of the external device.
