## Safety Precautions

### ● Storage precautions

Do not scrub the product surface using alcohol, thinner or benzene.




Do not apply strong shock to the LCD.

## Safety Precautions

### ● Battery Usage Precautions



Make sure to use the battery specified in this manual.  
(AAA alkaline battery)



Do not have a short circuit, disassemble or heat the product.

Keep away from the metallic objects such as battery, coin or lock.



Check the proper polarities (+/-).

Remove the batteries from the product if you don't use the product for a long time.
