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Bluetooth Setup

Pairing a Bluetooth Device for the First Time

- Power on the unit by pressing the Power button.
- 2. Press the Source button to switch to Bluetooth mode.
 - Bluetooth mode is indicated by "BT" on the display.
 - The pair indicator will flash blue slowly.
- Press the Pair button until pair indicator flashes blue quickly.
 - When pairing, remain within 3 feet of the
- Using the native controls on your Bluetooth device, select the "IBB313" in your Bluetooth settings to pair.
 - If your device requests a password, enter the default password "0000".
 - Refer to the user's manual for your specific device for instructions on pairing and connecting Bluetooth devices.
- When successfully paired and connected, the pair indicator will remain solid blue.
 - After initial pairing, the unit will stay paired unless unpaired manually by the user or erased due to a reset of the device.
 - If your device should become unpaired or you find it is unable to connect, repeat the above steps

Playing Audio Wirelessly

- Follow the instructions for Pairing a Bluetooth Device.
- Use the native controls on the connected Bluetooth Device to select a
- To play or pause the selected track, use the native controls on the connected Bluetooth Device or press the Play/ Pause button.
- Audio played through the connected Bluetooth device will now be heard through the speakers.

Radio

Tuning the FM Radio

- Power on the unit by pressing the Power button.
- Press the Source button to switch to FM Radio mode.
- Press the Tun+ and Tun-buttons to adjust the radio to the desired frequency.
- Press and hold the Tun+ and Tun- buttons to search for the next available frequency.
- Press the Vol+/- buttons to adjust the volume.
- Turn the radio off by pressing the Power button.

Saving a Station as a Preset

- Follow the instructions for Tuning the FM Radio.
- Tune to the desired station.
- Press and hold the Mem button.
- Press the Tun+/- buttons to choose the preset number.
- Press the **Mem** button to save the station as a preset.
 - Up to 20 stations may be saved as presets.

Tuning to a Preset Radio Station

- Follow the instructions for **Tuning the** Radio and Saving a Station as a Preset.
- Press the **Mem** button repeatedly to cycle through preset radio stations.

Radio Reception

Adjust the position of the FM Antenna to improve FM radio reception.

Clock

Setting the Clock

- If powered on, press the Power button to turn the unit off.
- 2. Press the Clock button.
- Press the Tuning-/Hour button to adjust the hour.
- Press the **Tuning+/Min** button to adjust the minute.
 - The PM indicator will light when the hour is set in the PM.
- Press the Clock button again to finish setting the time.

Line In

Using the Line In

Requires a 3.5mm audio cable (not included)

- Connect the 3.5mm audio cable to the Line In on the unit and an audio output on an MP3 player or other audio source.
- Press the Source button to switch to Line In mode.
- Use the native controls on the connected MP3 player or other audio source to play and control audio played through the clock radio.
