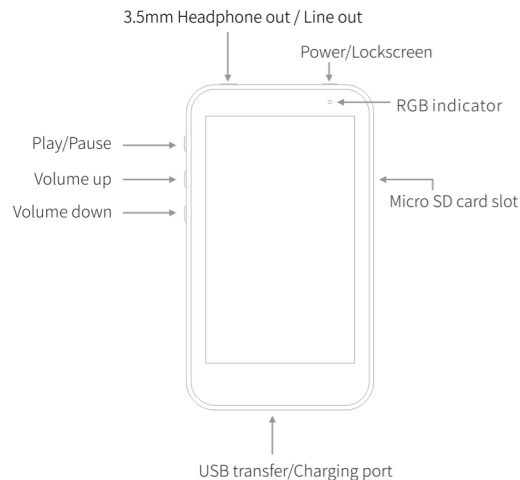


Buttons and Ports Labeled/Operation Explained



Power on/off

Hold the Power button to turn on the M6. Click the preferred language onscreen to enter main UI. Hold the Power button while M6 is on, a shutdown dialogue will pop up, and you can select to power off or reboot the player.

Charging

It takes about 2 hours to complete a full charge with a DC 5V/2A charger. To achieve the ideal charging, it's recommended to use a charger with DC 5V/2A or above.

Gestures

Return to previous menu: swipe up from the bottom-left area of the screen.

Return to home menu: swipe up from the bottom-right area of the screen.

Used as an USB DAC connecting with computer

Please download the USB DAC driver on our website (or find it via 'FiiO driver > Windows-USB DAC driver' after connecting the M6 to the computer), and follow relevant instructions to install and use M6 as an USB DAC.

Firmware upgrade

1. Over-the-air automatic firmware updates

Turn on the M6's WiFi and connect to a hotspot connected to the internet, the M6 will detect it automatically. If no firmware update detected, please click "Technical support -> Firmware Update -> Online Upgrade" to check and upgrade manually.

2. Manual update via update zip file

Third-party music streaming apps

In the heart of the M6 lies the Android operating system, deeply customized by FiiO. To ensure the system stability, apps for popular streaming services including NetEase Cloud Music, MOOV, Tidal and KKBOXS are pre-installed, and it allows to install whitelisted third-party music streaming apps (currently including NetEase Cloud Music, MOOV, Tidal, KKBOX, Spotify, Qobuz, Roon and Deezer; with more to be added); You can also uninstall any app--go to 'Settings -> General -> Apps' and click the app info to uninstall.

Notes and precautions

★Do not repair or disassemble the product by yourself and put it in water.

★Please charge the battery on a regular basis to secure the battery life if no use of it for long time.

★You might not able to hear the sound of the surrounding when using headphones. For your safety, please avoid using headphones in dangerous situation.

★It's recommended to use suitable charger in case of high-voltage adaptor causing damage to the M6.

★In the likely event that the M6 hangs up, you may hold the Power button and Play/Pause for 10 seconds to force a reboot.
