
Description of Parts:



Item	Function	Operation
1	LED charge indicator	Red light stays on during charging, and turns off when speaker is fully charged.
2	PREV / Volume decrease (-)	Short press will skip backward to the previous track, and long press will decrease the volume.
3	LED Lantern button	To adjust white LED light brightness, or change different color light mode.
4	►II / phone button	Play / pause button - Short press will pause or restart the music. Phone button - Answer / reject / end call / redial last number. For Hands-Free Conversation
5	Power button	To turn ON/OFF the speaker.

6	Volume increase (+) / NEXT	Short press will skip forward to the next track, and long press will increase the volume level.
7	Bluetooth / Aux-in mode LED indicator	Bluetooth mode - Blue LED indicator blinks. Aux-in mode - Blue LED indicator will flash.
8	DC Charging Port	DC Charging Port – To charge the speaker
9	USB Charging Port	Use this USB Charging Port to charge your smart phones and other mobile devices
10	TF Card Slot	Play music from TF card
11	Aux-in jack	To play music through auxiliary cable.
12	Built-In Mic	For Hands-Free Conversation
13	Rubber Cover	To protect water ingress when not in use

(Note: Some of the above functions can be used in Bluetooth mode only.)

INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE

Charging the speaker

For best results, fully charge the speaker before its first use.

- Connect the USB charging cord (included) to the DC 5V charging port of the speaker and insert the other end into a port on your computer or similar power source.
- Red LED glows indicating that the battery is being charged. Once it is fully charged, the Red LED will turn off. It will take around 2-3 hours to fully charge the battery.

Turn On/Off the Speaker with LED Lantern

Press and hold the "Power" button for 1-2 seconds until you hear the indication tone. Blue LED indicator light will blink, your speaker is now ON and is entering "pairing" mode.

Press and hold the "Power" button for 1-2 seconds to turn off the speaker.

Turn the speaker to Bluetooth pairing mode -

- 1. Press and hold the "Power" button for 1-2 seconds until you hear the indication tone.
- Blue LED indicator light will blink, your speaker is now ON and is entering "pairing" mode.

(Note: Speaker automatically pairs with the previously paired devices)

Function	Operation	Button
Increase / Decrease Volume	Playing music	Long press + to increase the volume or long press - to decrease the volume
Pause	Playing music	Press ►II once to pause the music
Play	Pause	Press ►II once resume the music
Skip Forward / Skip Backward	Playing music	Short press + to skip forward the track. Short press - to skip backward the track.

(Note: An indication tone will alert you when the volume is adjusted to the maximum level.)

Stream music from TF card -

- Turn ON the device.
- Insert the TF Card with songs into the TF Card Slot of the speaker.
- · Speaker would automatically start playing songs from the TF Card
- To Skip Track Forward Short press the + button.
- To Skip Track Backwards Short press the button.
- To Pause the Track Short press the Mutton.
- To Play the Track Short press the ►II button.
- Long press + to increase the volume or to decrease the volume.

(Note: When you insert TF Card with songs into the TF Card Slot of the speaker, the Bluetooth of the speaker will Turn Off, automatically.)

Play music using "Aux-In" Jack

- 1. Turn ON the device.
- 2. Insert the 3.5 mm Aux in cable (included) in the Aux-in jack of the speaker. And, the other end of the cable, to the audio device (such as computer / tablet etc.).
- 3. The Blue LED indicator light will flash.
- 4. Select your favorite song at the source device.

(Note: When you insert 3.5 mm Aux in cable into the Aux-in jack of the speaker, the Bluetooth or stream music from TF card of the speaker will Turn Off, automatically. Functions except Volume Increase or Volume Decrease can be only controlled through source devices, while playing music in Auxiliary mode. An indication tone will alert you when the volume is adjusted to the maximum level.)

White LED light Mode (LEDs are not replaceable)

- 1. Turn ON the device.
- 2. Short press the LED Lantern button to turn on the White LED light mode.
- 3. This mode has 3 levels of brightness (low, medium, high), short press the LED Lantern button each time to change the brightness.

Color Changing LED light Mode (LEDs are not replaceable)

- 1. Turn ON the device.
- Long press to turn ON the color changing LED lantern mode with Red light first, and then short press each time to switch to different light modes. The light modes include: Red -> Blue -> Green -> Purple -> Cyan -> Alternative -> Dynamic.
- While it is on any color light mode, long press to change to white LED light model.

Recharging External Devices (through this speaker)

Turn ON the device. Use the USB Charging port of the speaker to charge your external devices like smart phones etc. Using this saves you from having an extra charger to keep your devices powered.

Do's and Don'ts

Do not play music at excessive levels. Damage to hearing and/or equipment may result. Do not use outdoors in excessive rain or extreme weather conditions.
