

Confidentiality Request

Details of the confidentiality rules are below.

The letter that needs to be completed and returned is on page 2 (this relates to permanent confidentiality only).

Letter of confidentiality (Permanent Confidentiality)

If exhibits are to remain confidential then a request letter should form part of the submission. The letter should request confidentiality pursuant to rule part 0.459 and should list the specific exhibits that are to remain confidential. The following Exhibits can be retained for long term confidentiality:

Parts list / Bill of Materials
Schematic Diagrams
Operational Description
Radio RF Block Diagram

In addition to the above, the user manual can be retained as confidential if it is very technical and not supplied to the end user but to service personnel and professional installers. The internal photographs can remain confidential if the product will be fully potted in use

Letter of confidentiality (Temporary Confidentiality)

An exhibit that is classed as business sensitive can be held temporarily confidential for a period up to 180 days if the product is not being marketed in the US. The temporary confidentiality is valid initially for 45 days at which point an additional declaration will be required to extend for a further 45 days and so on. Failure to submit additional declarations will result in the temporary confidentiality being automatically removed at the end of the 45 day period.

As soon as the product begins to be marketed the TCB should be informed and any exhibits held temporarily confidential will revert to public domain. Failure to inform the TCB at the marketing stage will be in violation of FCC regulations and the FCC could take further action.

A letter of requesting temporary confidentiality will be required, this should include the reasons the exhibit(s) are to be held confidential and a declaration stating that the product is not being marketed in the US. The following exhibits are eligible for short term confidentiality.
