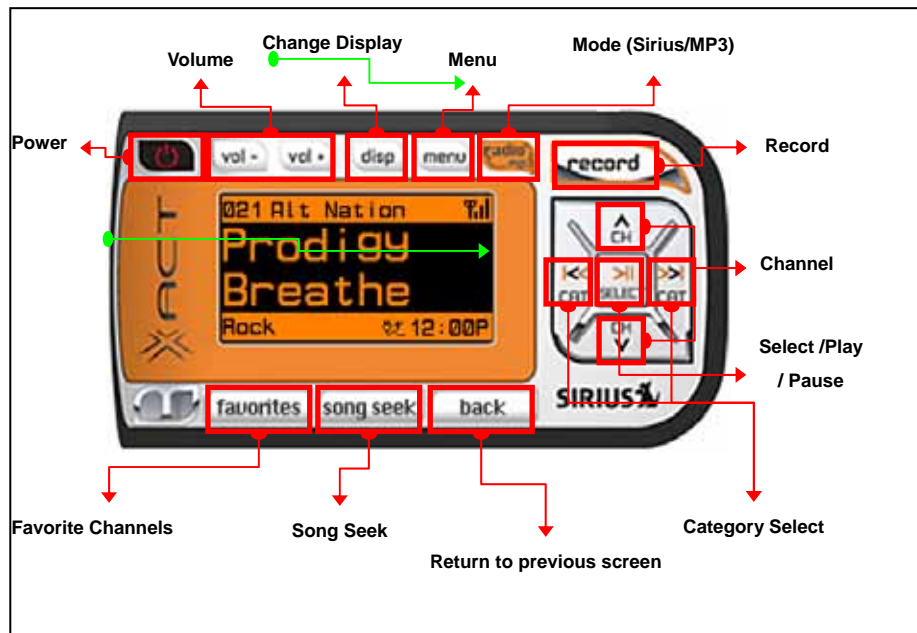

Mounting Your XACT ReGo Satellite Radio at Home

Find an appropriate location near your stereo receiver to install your plug and play satellite

radio receiver.

Mounting Your XACT ReGo Satellite Radio in a Vehicle

Find an accessible location in your vehicle to install your plug and play satellite radio receiver; usually, this is the dashboard.

-  Do not mount your device where it may obstruct your view through the windshield or your view of your vehicle's indicator displays.
-  Do not mount your device where it may impede your access to the vehicle's controls.
-  Do not mount your device where it may hinder the function of safety devices, such as an airbag. Doing so may prevent the airbag from functioning accordingly in the event of an accident.
-  Mount your satellite radio where it can be easily reached.
-  The device must be directly in line-of-sight of the remote controller.
-  If you're not going to operate your vehicle for an extended period of time (e.g. parking garage while on vacation) unplug your ReGo Satellite Radio from the cradle or remove the cigarette lighter adapter.

NOTE! Do not modify or alter in any way the wires or connections especially to the 12v vehicle adapter. Doing so will prevent the protection provided in the circuitry from functioning properly and result in damaging your receiver. This will void your warranty

Activating Your SIRIUS® Subscription

Before beginning to use your new device, you must first register with the SIRIUS® Satellite Radio service.

There are two ways to activate the SIRIUS® Satellite Radio Service:

1. Visit sirius.com and click activate, then follow the on-screen instructions.
2. Call SIRIUS® at 1-866-845-7474. A representative will help you activate your SIRIUS® Satellite Radio Service.

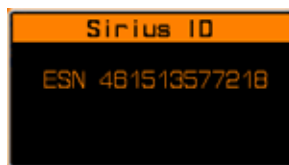

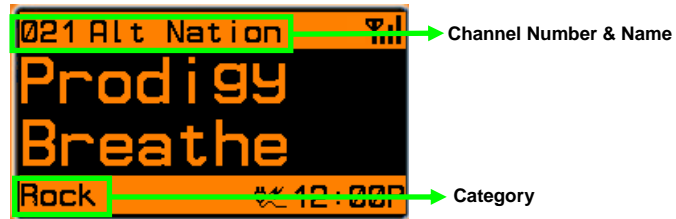
BASIC OPERATIONS

After your SIRIUS® subscription is activated, the Normal (default) Operation screen will be displayed.



Tuning to Different Entertainment Channels and Categories

1. Press the CAT << >> buttons to scroll through music and entertainment categories. The first channel in the selected category will be displayed.



2. Press the CH UP / DN buttons to change the channel within the selected category.
3. You can also change channels by entering the channel list mode. Press the SELECT button to

enter channel list mode to preview a list of channels in the selected category. Use the CH UP/DN buttons to move the cursor to the desired channel then press the SELECT button.

4. You can direct tune to any channel using the remote control. Enter the desired channel number using the remote control 0 – 9 key pad.

Setting the Headphone Volume Level

1. Press the [Vol+], [Vol-] buttons to change the headphone volume level. The Headphone Volume level display will change indicating the volume level.



Changing the Display Text Size

1. Press the [DISP] button to toggle the display text size.

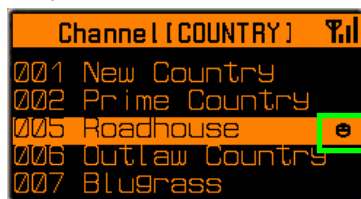


Storing Your Favorite Channels

Using the FAVORITES button you can store your Favorite channels in any of the SIRIUS® Categories.

1. To save a Favorite channel press and hold the [FAVORITES] button to enter the Favorites Edit Mode.
2. Find your Favorite channel using the CAT << >> buttons to scroll through music and entertainment categories and the CH UP/DN buttons to scroll through the channels in the selected category.
3. To store your Favorite channel press the SELECT button. A Happy Face ☺ icon is displayed next to the selected Favorite channel. You can store as many channels as you like using this method.
4. To exit the Favorites Edit mode, press the BACK button.

5. To delete a Favorite channel from your list, perform steps 1 and 2 above and highlight the channel to be removed. Press the SELECT button and the Happy Face ☺ icon disappears.

6. To exit the Favorites Edit mode, press the BACK button.

Note: Deleting the channel from your Favorite list does not remove the channel from your Sirius subscription.

Using Favorites Mode

1. To access your Favorite channels, enter the Favorites tuning mode by pressing the FAVORITES button.
2. Then select the desired channel from the Favorite list using the CAT << >> buttons to scroll through music and entertainment categories and the CH UP/DN buttons to scroll through the channels in the selected category.
3. Highlight the desired channel and press the SELECT button. The Happy Face ☺ icon is displayed on the Normal (Default) screen indicating Favorites mode is active.
4. To tune to your Favorite stored channels, use the CAT << >> and CH UP/DN buttons.
5. To exit Favorite mode, press the FAVORITES button.



Song Seek

The Song Seek feature will store the currently playing song information in memory and your satellite radio automatically checks to see if the song is playing on any other channel and alerts you. You can store up to 50 songs.

1. Press the SONG SEEK button to store the currently playing song data. A message appears confirming the song information has been stored.



2. When your satellite receiver finds a song playing on another channel that matches one of your stored songs, an alert message is displayed and an audible alert is heard. If you want to listen to the song on the indicated channel press the SELECT button. If you wish to continue listening to the current channel, no action is required and the alert message will automatically disappear after 5 seconds.



What If You Have Already Recorded the Same Artist/Song?

Your satellite radio automatically checks your recorded data information and compares it with the newly selected program. If the newly selected program has already been recorded, to avoid duplication no entry will be made.

Editing Your Stored Song List

You can easily delete individual songs or all the stored songs from memory.

1. To access the Song Seek Edit menu, press and hold the SONG SEEK button.
2. Select LIST if you want to edit individual songs. Select CLEAR ALL if you want to delete all songs in memory.

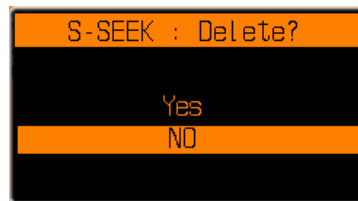


Edit List

To delete a stored song from the list, highlight the song using the CH UP/DN button and press SELECT.

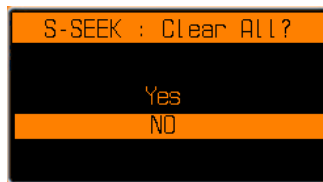


A confirmation screen will appear. To delete the song select YES. To keep the song select NO.



Clear All

To delete all the stored songs from memory, select YES. To keep the song list select NO.



Storing SIRIUS® Content

Your ReGo has the ability to store over 4 hours of SIRIUS® content. You can store a single song or store an entire program.

Storing a Single Song

To store a single song that is currently playing, press the RECORD button. Recording will start immediately and the Recording Icon ® will appear in the display. A recording progress bar is displayed indicating recording progress and remaining memory space. The time remaining indicator displays the remaining record time. Recording stops automatically when the song ends.




Continuous Recording

To continuously record a channel that is currently playing, press and hold the RECORD button. A confirmation screen will be displayed. To continuously record the currently tuned channel highlight

YES with the cursor and press SELECT.

Recording will start immediately and the Recording Icon  will appear in the display. A recording progress bar is displayed indicating recording progress and remaining memory space. The time remaining indicator displays the remaining record time. To stop recording, press the RECORD button. .



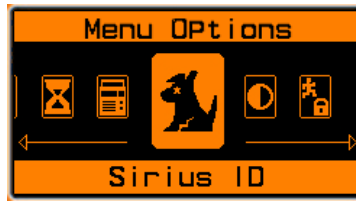
Setting Menu Options

The MENU features allow you to personalize the operation of your ReGo Satellite Receiver. To enter

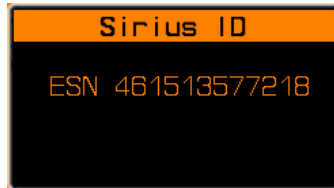
the menu mode, press the MENU button.

Sirius ID

1. Press MENU to enter the Menu Options Screen and highlight the Sirius Logo.



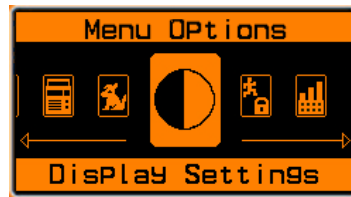
2. Press the SELECT button to display your Receivers 12-digit SIRIUS® ID Number (ESN).



Display Settings

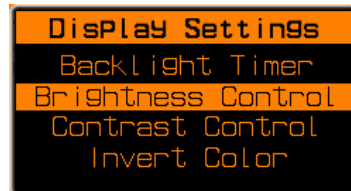
To enter the display setting menu, highlight the DISPLAY SETTINGS icon using the CAT << >>

buttons and press the SELECT button.



Brightness Control

To change the display brightness, highlight Brightness Control using the CH \wedge V buttons then press the SELECT button.



To increase or decrease the display brightness press the << CAT >> buttons. When the desired brightness level is set, press the SELECT button to store the setting.

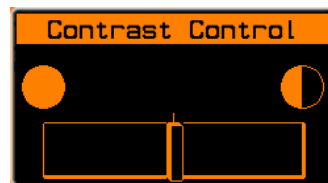


Contrast Control

To change the display contrast, highlight Contrast Control using the CH \wedge V buttons then press the SELECT button.

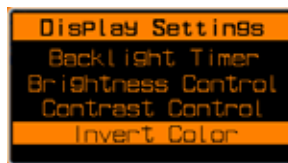


To increase or decrease the display Contrast press the << CAT >> buttons. When the desired brightness level is set, press the SELECT button to store the setting.

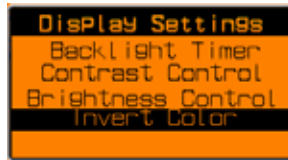


Invert Color

To invert the color in the display, highlight Invert Colors using the CH \wedge V buttons.



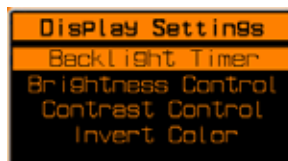
Press the SELECT button to invert the display color. To revert back to the original setting press SELECT again. Press the BACK button to exit.



Backlight Timer

To maximize battery life when using your ReGo Satellite Receiver in portable mode, use the backlight timer settings to configure the amount of time the display remains on.

To change the display on time in portable mode, highlight Backlight Timer using the CH \wedge \vee buttons then press the SELECT button.



To set the display backlight on time, highlight the desired time and press the SELECT button. The star icon indicates the selected time.



. Note: The Backlight Timer feature only operates when using the battery.

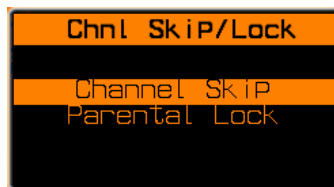
Channel Skip / Parental Lock

Your ReGo Satellite Receiver has the ability to skip and lock out certain channels. To enter the Channel Skip / Parental Lock menu, highlight the CHANNEL SKIP/LOCK icon using the CAT << >> buttons and press the SELECT button.

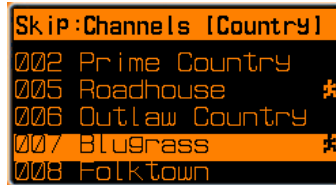


Channel Skip

To enter the Channel Skip menu, highlight Channel Skip using the CH ^ v buttons then press the SELECT button.



Use the << CAT >> and CH ^ v buttons to navigate to the desired channel(s). Highlight the desired channel and press the SELECT button. The selected skipped channel displays the skip icon. Press SELECT again to remove the icon. Press the BACK button to return to the Channel Skip / Lock menu.



Parental Lock

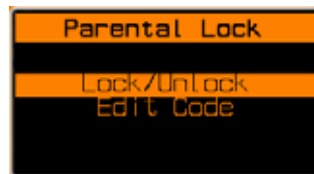
Access to particular channels can be set with codes. When you tune to these particular channels, your receiver will require you to enter the 4-digit access code. To enter the Parental Lock menu, highlight Parental Lock using the CH ^ v buttons then press the SELECT button.



The following adjustments can be made:

- Lock/Unlock

- Edit Code

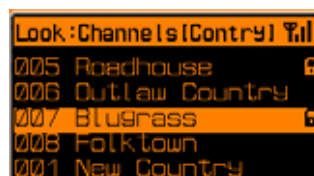


Lock/Unlock

When using Lock/Unlock for the first time, you are asked to type in the 3-digit code that is used to Lock/Unlock the channel access. Press the "0" button four times to enter the default Access Code: 000



Thereafter, each time you enter this mode, a channel list will be displayed and the currently playing channel will be highlighted. Press the << CAT >> and CH UP/DN buttons to select a channel you want to lock, and then press the SELECT button to confirm the setting. The "Lock" Icon pops up next to the channel.



Edit Code

You may change the access password (default code: 000) to your personal code.

To enter the Edit Code menu, highlight Edit Code using the CH ^ V buttons then press the SELECT button.



After entering this mode, press the CH UP/DN buttons to enter the number and the << CAT >> buttons to move to the next digit. Enter the current 3-digit access code (3-digit default code: 000 or your previously entered current code) and press SELECT. The "New Code" message pops up.



Enter the numbers for your new access code by using the CH UP/DN buttons to enter the number and the << CAT >> buttons to move to the next digit. Press SELECT. The confirmation screen will then be displayed.



Enter the numbers for your new access code again by using the CH UP/DN buttons to enter the number and the << CAT >> buttons to move to the next digit. Press SELECT. Your new access code is now saved.



Once the channel configuration is done, press the [select] button to select the channel number. Once it is done properly, there will be a lock icon appearing on the right side of channel name.

Factory Default

To restore the ReGo Satellite Receiver factory default settings, highlight the FACTORY DEFAULT icon using the << CAT >> buttons and press the SELECT button.

Icons are in the wrong order →



Select "YES" to confirm. Select NO to exit.

Favorite Teams

You can select your favorite sports team and ReGo will automatically alert you when your favorite team is playing. When a match is found, the Game Alert screen is displayed, followed by tuning

information for that game. See the Favorite Team setting in the Menu Display Options section for information on setting your favorite team.

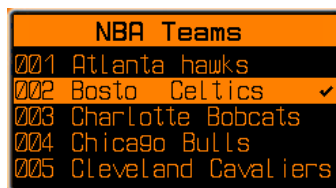
To enter your Favorite Team, highlight the Favorite Team icon using the CAT << >> buttons and press the SELECT button.



Using the CH UP/DN buttons, highlight the desired League and press SELECT.



Using the CH UP/DN buttons, highlight the desired Team and press SELECT. The ✓ icon appears indicating the selected team. You can select multiple teams. Press SELECT again to deselect the team. Press BACK to exit.



Antenna Aiming

Note: This adjustment setting is required only when you use your device at home. This way, you can assure optimum reception when mounting your SIRIUS® antenna.

To enter the Antenna Aiming mode highlight the Antenna Aiming icon using the CAT << >> buttons and then press the SELECT button.



Upon entering the Antenna Aiming mode, two 10-segment horizontal bar graphs are displayed. One is labeled "SAT" (satellite signal strength) and the other "TER" (terrestrial signal strength). The current

setting is indicated on the bar graphs. Move the antenna in a location according to the SIRIUS® Satellite Map placement indicated below which provides the strongest signal indication.



SIRIUS® Satellite Map

Due to the paths of SIRIUS® satellites over the US, the best location for the antenna in your home depends on where you live. Use the map below as a general placement guideline.

Area 1 : Place the antenna at an EAST - facing window.

Area 2 : Place the antenna OUTSIDE, away from any overhead obstructions.

Area 3 : Place the antenna at a NORTH WEST - or WEST - facing window.



Area 4 : Place the antenna at a WEST - or NORTH - facing window.

Area 5 : Place the antenna at a NORTH - facing window.

Area 6 : Place the antenna at a NORTH - or EAST - facing window.

Time Features

To enter the Time Features mode highlight the Time Features icon using the CAT << >> buttons and then press the SELECT button.

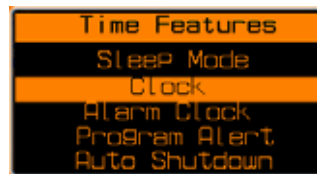

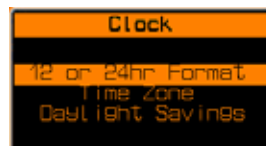

Clock

This option enables you to set up the time to be displayed on the screen. Time is kept directly by the SIRIUS® satellite and is transmitted in GMT FORMAT.



To set the time display 12 or 24 hour format, highlight the 12 or 24 hr Format and press the SELECT button.



Highlight the desired time format and press the SELECT button. The "star" icon indicates the currently selected format. Press the BACK button to exit.



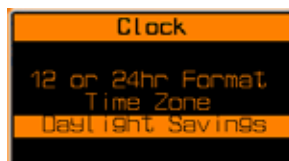
To set the time zone, highlight the time zone and press the SELECT button.



Highlight the desired Time Zone and press the SELECT button. The "star" icon indicates the currently selected Time Zone. Press the BACK button to exit.



If you observe Daylight Savings Time, highlight Daylight Savings and press the SELECT button. To set Daylight Savings Time, highlight Daylight Savings and press the SELECT button. To set Daylight Savings Time, highlight Daylight Savings and press the SELECT button.



Highlight the desired selection and press the SELECT button. The “star” icon indicates the current selection. Press the BACK button to exit.



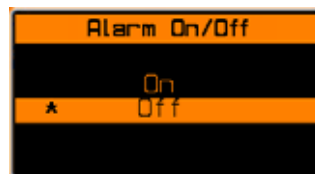
Alarm Clock

You can set your ReGo Satellite Receiver to turn on at a selected time.

To set the Alarm Clock, highlight Alarm Clock then press the SELECT button.



Press the CH UP/DN button to select either the “On” or “Off”(default) setting, then press the SELECT button to confirm the setting and display the Alarm Time Set Screen.



Enter the alarm time using the CH UP/DN buttons to enter the number and the << CAT >> buttons to move to the next digit. Set AM or PM then press the SELECT button to store and return to the menu.



Program Alert

This option allows your ReGo plug and play satellite radio to tune itself to a pre-selected channel at a pre-selected time.

Note: To use your programmed setting, make sure to set "Program Alert" to "Program Alert On".

The following settings can be made in this sub-menu screen:

- Program Time/Day (default-12:00 PM - Monday)
- Channel Selection (default-Currently Playing Channel)
- Program Alert On / Off (default-Off)

To enter the sub-menu, highlight Program Alert and then press the SELECT button.

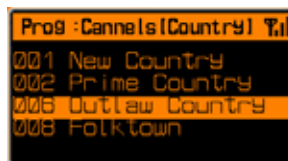


Program Alert On/Off

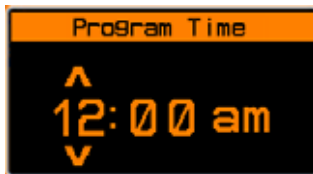
Press the CH UP/DN buttons to select either the "On" or "Off" setting. Press the SELECT button to confirm the setting.



Channel Selection: Press the << CAT >> and CH UP/DN buttons to scroll through the categories and channel list and highlight the desired channel. Press the SELECT button to confirm the setting.

**Set Time**

Enter the alert time using the CH UP/DN buttons to enter the number and the << CAT >> buttons to move to the next digit. Set AM or PM then press the SELECT button to store.

**Set Day**

Press the CH UP/DN buttons to navigate the day: Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, Friday, Saturday, Daily or Sunday. Press the SELECT button to confirm the setting.

**Continuous Record On / Off**

If you would like to record the Sirius program press the CH UP/DN buttons to select either the "On" or "Off" setting. Press the SELECT button to confirm the setting.

Note: Setting to “On” will record the program for later listening. Selecting “Off” will not record the program. Your program alert feature works whether you choose to record the program or not.



Set Record Time

Enter the record stop time using the CH UP/DN buttons to enter the number and the << CAT >> buttons to move to the next digit. Set AM or PM then press the SELECT button to store.



Note: if you enter a time that is before the program start time an alert message will appear.

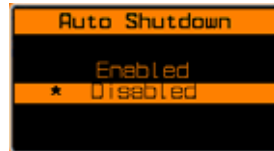
End Time is Before Start Time Display Here

Auto Shutdown

This option will automatically turn your satellite radio off after an hour of inactivity. An audible tone will sound one minute before your device turns off.



Press the CH UP/DN buttons to select the “Enabled” or “Disabled” setting. Press the SELECT button to confirm the setting.



Sleep Mode

When entering this mode, you can program your ReGo satellite radio to shutdown after a pre-selected period of time.

The following adjustments can be made:

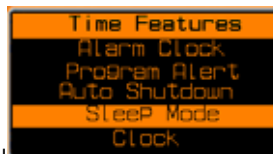

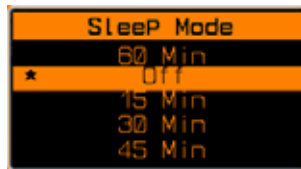

Press the CH UP/DN buttons to select the time. Press the SELECT button to confirm the setting. Your ReGo satellite radio receiver will now turn off after the selected time has passed. If “Off” is selected, the Sleep Mode will be canceled.

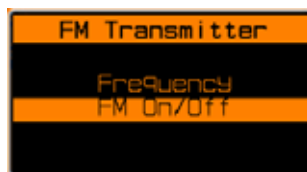


FM Transmitter

This option allows your ReGo plug and play satellite radio to transmit music to your car or home FM radio. To enter the FM Transmitter menu highlight the FM Transmitter icon using the CAT << >> buttons and then press the SELECT button.



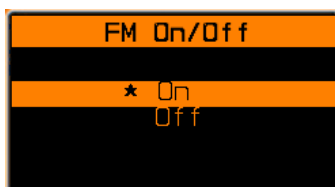
Press the CH UP/DN buttons to select the FM On/Off. Press the SELECT button to confirm the setting.



FM Transmitter On/Off

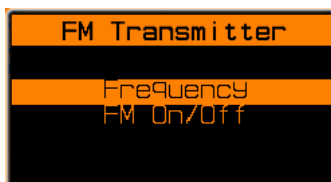
Press the CH UP/DN buttons and select "On" to turn the FM Transmitter "On" and press the SELECT button to confirm the setting. To turn the FM Transmitter "Off" select "Off" and press the SELECT

button to confirm the setting.



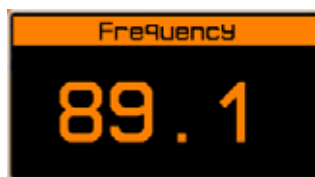
FM Frequency Setting

Press the CH UP/DN buttons and highlight "On" to turn the FM Transmitter "On" and press the SELECT button to confirm the setting. To turn the FM Transmitter "Off" highlight "Off" and press the SELECT button to confirm the setting.



Frequency Selection

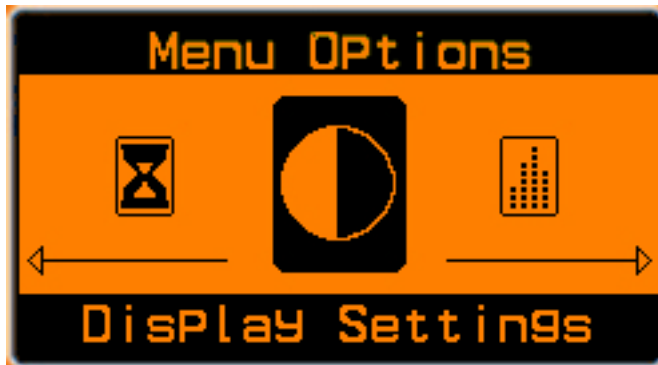
Select a frequency that is not being used by an FM Broadcaster in your area. Using the CH UP/DN buttons to change number and the << CAT >> buttons to move to the next digit. Press the SELECT button to store the setting.

3.3.1. Display Setting

Press the [||<< CAT], [||>> CAT] buttons and Press the [select] button to enter the "Display Setting".



Backlight Timer: Press the [CH], [CH] buttons to move the highlighted cursor. Select "Backlight Timer" and press the [CH], [CH] buttons to move the highlighted cursor. Press the [Select] button to select item.

Please check the Power Cables. Make sure you have contacted SIRIUS® to activate your Satellite Radio subscription 1-888-539-SIRIUS (7474).

I have no sound from my Satellite Receiver.

Check the audio cables and make sure they are plugged in correctly.

Check the FM Transmitter Setting and make sure that your FM radio is set to the correct channel.

The LCD displays Acquiring Signal.

When the Satellite Signal is lost, a pop-up window with the message "Acquiring Signal" is displayed until the signal is recovered. Move the antenna to a better location.

The LCD Displays Antenna not Detected.

When no antenna is detected and the signal is lost, a pop-up window with the message "Antenna Not Detected" is displayed until an antenna is detected and the signal is acquired. Make sure the antenna is securely plugged into the antenna jack.

Reception is weak or the audio has static and is unclear.
