

- 1. This is an electronic product, please avoid using under the environment of over high temperature, over low temperature, moisture or dusty.
- 2. This product features touch screen, please do not touch the screen with hard or rough objects.
- 3. When carrying or moving, do not apply extra pressure to prevent the possibility of damage the components.
- 4. Avoid dropping of the product when using.
- 5. Please access the internet in the network covering area to avoid a poor networking.
- 6. Try to avoid formatting, in case of a formatting operation, do not interrupt it otherwise there will be harddisk malfunction.
- 7. Keep away from static when using and storing the product.
- 8. Please do not use the product for a long time to avoid eyestrain.
- 9. Please try to avoid using the product under direct sunshine to prevent the display effect from being influenced and the eyes from injury.
- 10. In case of a cleaning needed, please use a soft fabric to wipe gently the shell surface and the LCD screen, do not use a solution or other chemicals to wipe it.
- 11. The battery is fixed inside the machine, user is not allowed to load or unload it freely.



USB Connection

1.USB cable connects the PC with OpenPad, copies the files in the PC to the default mobile HDD of OpenPad.

2.If the user is setting according to the following sequence: Setting USB Mode Host, the user can connect external storage devices as U disk and mobile HDD etc. through OTG data cable, but independent power supplying should be applied to the external devices with large power consumption.

USB Close

1.After completing transmission, drag the status bar on top of the screen up to down until "Close USB storage device" is shown and click on it.

2.Click on Close on the popping out box to close the USB storage device.

Note: Files copied to OpenPad can only be available for use until USB data cable is closed completely.

Storage Card

- Copy files to TF card (refer to USB connection description)
- · Close Storage Card

1.After completing transmission, click " and choose "SD Card and Device Memory" in Setting.

2.Click on "Unload SD Card".

3.It is now safety to remove the storage card.

Note: the storage card can only be removed upon its complete closing, or there will be damage to the storage card.

Basic Operation

Turn on/off the machine

- 1. Press long the Power key to turn on the main menu.
- 2. Press long the Power key to show the turn off menu, click on it directly to turn off.

Note: Press the Power key for approximate 10 second can force the machine to turn off.

Temporarily turn on/off the screen

- 1. Temporarily turn off the screen: press short the Power key to temporarily turn off the screen and save power.
- 2. Temporarily turn on the screen: press short the Power key to turn on the screen.

Note: when in no use, the product will be in Sleep automatically, turn on the Power key to restart.

Charging

When the Power is lower than 20%, there will a prompt on the screen, please connect the charging device to ensure the normal operation.

Note: User can carry out normal operation while in charging in case the product is in start status.


1. Apply AC Power Adapter to connect the machine and the power, the input AC voltage is 220V.

• Touch Screen

- 1. Light touch: touch the menu items or the icons on the screen slightly.
- 2. Drag: drag in the blank place on the screen or press on the scroll bar for up/down moving.
- 3. Click: click on the icon on the current interface, and drag the icon to any place on the screen and release for viewing.

- Home: press to return to main interface Note: the running program does not exit when pressing Home to return directly to the main interface.



Quick Setting

· Set time and zone

Click on " Setting — Time and Zone (Refer to P10).

Text Edit





Input method: Click on the text or the browser search box, "Virtual Keyboard" will popup. Switch between "English or number and symbol" according to requirements. Directly click on Back to cancel.

Note: press long the input box to switch between input methods.

Set Brightness and Screen Standby

Click on "Setting — Sound and Display — Display Setting".


Switch between pages or functions



Click " on the left top of the screen for about 3 seconds to switch between recently used programs. Directly click on " or it cancel.

Basic Menu Functions


Rotary direction



Click on the right top of the screen Setting — Sound and Display—Direction to automatically change direction when rotating the screen.

Note: Rotation does not apply to the main interface, but you can rotate the machine 900 counterclockwise to change the screen direction automatically when running applications.

Main Interface Shortcut



- 1. Press on the blank place on the main interface, Shortcut menu will popup.
- 2. Select and click on menu items for setting.
- $\ensuremath{\mathtt{3}}_{\smallsetminus}$ Upon selecting an item, system will automatically go to the main interface.

Note:

Shortcut adding: user can add application in the main interface by Window Control.

Folder Rename



1. Enter Folder, select New Folder and click on OK.

Note: open the folder and press on the top for approximate 3 second, "Rename" will popup. User can now rename the folder if required.

Basic Menu Functions

Wallpaper Setting



1. Select "Picture, Wallpaper or Current Wallpaper" under Wallpaper item, Click on Setting after selecting the picture.

Note: If "Picture (Library)" is selected, the picture can be zoomed in and out if required. When Current Wallpaper is selected, further setting is available as per user's personality.

Menu Function

- Menu
- 1. Click on " 📰 " on right top of the screen to popup Menu Interface at the bottom of the screen, apply same application as per "Main Menu Shortcut" for "Add, Wallpaper and Search" functions. Function



• Notifications: Describe the running status of the program on left top of the screen.



The operations are similar, set some of them for example below:

Settings

Note: "√" indicates the mode is on.

1. Wireless & networks (Manage Network Connection)



Menu Function

- ①、First ensure the WiFi function is on (wireless network is on).
- ②、Click on WiFi setting, the system will list automatically the networks within the searching scope if WiFi is on.
- ③、Select the available WiFi network in the list and click on OK.
- (4), Now the WiFi icon is shown in the status bar.
- ⑤、Click on Back or Home to return to Main Interface.

Note: if a password is required for the WiFi setting, enter the password first before the connection setting.

2. Sound & display (ring, notice and screen brightness setting)



3. Location & Security (Set My Location, Screen Unlock Icon, Password)



Screen Unlock Icon: Draw personal unlocking icon, at least 4 points need to be connected.

4. Applications (Applications Settings)

Manage application: uninstalling or data deleting of applications.

5. Privacy(Privacy settings)

Restore to factory default: remove the data in the device, including: Google account; data and setting of the system and applications; applications downloaded.

Note: data which will not be removed includes: current system software and binding applications; files in the storage card as music or photo.

Menu Function

- 6. SD card & device storage (uninstall SD card and check available storage space)
- 7. Language & keyboard (select language region and IME)
- 8. Date & time (set date, time and format)



Time setting: setting can be completed by "+/- " or click on "Number Box" and touch the numbers.

- 9. Touch panel calibration, USB mode select, Update Media Library
- 10. About device (check legal information, machine status and software version)

Troubleshooting

- 1. If the machine can not be turned on, please check if the battery is OK.
- 2. If there is no sound, please try to press on volume for increasing or decreasing volume.
- 3. If the system is dull for a long time, please press the Power to turn off the machine and then restart. (Not recommended for normal shutdown).
- 4. If the system can not run properly, please press Reset (beside Power). (not recommended).

Operating Environment and Safety Instructions

- 1. Due to the used enclosure material, the tablet PC shall only be connected to a USB Interface of version 2.0 or higher. The connection to so called power USB is prohibited.
- 2. A socket outlet that is installed near equipment and that shall be easily accessible.
- 3. Do not use the mobile phone in the environment at too high or too low temperature, never expose the mobile phone under strong sunshine or too wet environment. The suitable temperature for the phone and accessories is 0 C-40 C.
