




# I. Devices and accessories


Devices and accessories include: Alcatel onetouch VIEW Set-top Box, HDMI wire and adapter, and IR remote controller.











- 1 Power socket (5V DC In): for power supply through a 5V/2A adapter.
- 2 Optical fiber interface: for connection with external highfidelity acoustic system.
- 3 HDMI (High-definition Multimedia Interface): to connect an onetouch VIEW Set-top Box with a TV set with an HDMI connector for the display of HD contents (remember to switch the TV to HDMI mode).
- 4 CVBS analogue video interface: to connect the CVBS port of Alcatel onetouch VIEW Set-top Box with the AV port of a TV set with the

video connector (yellow) of the RCA cable (usually known as AV connectors) for the transmission of video signals from the TV.


- 5 L: left sound channel (analogue), usually the white AV connector, for the output of audio signals of the TV set.
- 6 R: right sound channel (analogue), usually the red AV connector, for the output of audio signals of the TV set.
- 7 ETHERNET: Internet interface, for access to the Internet to enable high-speed network access experience.

- 8 USB A: for connection with flash disks, mobile hard drives, wireless mice, wireless keyboards, and other devices with USB2.0 interfaces.
- 9 USB B: for connection with flash disks, mobile hard drives, wireless mice, wireless keyboards, and other devices with USB2.0 interfaces.
- 10 SD CARD slot: for the reading of information in SD cards

#### Notes

The device enables Internet connection with an embedded Wi-Fi module, as well as a cable modem.



How to connect onetouch VIEW Set-top Box with the TV set




Please set up the device in accordance with the following procedures.

- 1 Make sure that the device and all accessories are installed with power supply, including two 7# batteries for the IR remote controller and an adapter for the device.
- 2 Install the Video connector: use an HDMI connector or RCA cable to connect the device with the TV set for the output of HD or analogue AV signals.
- 3 Install the Audio connector: use an optical cable, or the RCA audio connector to connect the device with the audio system. If the HDMI connector is alread installed and the device is switched to HDMI output mode, the audio signal output will be available automaticall.
- 4 Set up network connection: The device enables Internet connection with a cable modem or an embedded Wi-Fi module.

# WI. How to operate the device

#### 1 Turn on the device



Turn on the device. You will see the welcome screen and the main menu in 40 seconds. Main menu options include local video, free video, games, applications, setup, application store, music, image and browser.

View and connect to wireless networks available. If the network selected is encrypted, you may need to enter your password or other IDs (you may need to contact your network operator for details).

The Wi-Fi icon appears on the top right of the screen after the setup of Wi-Fi connection.


#### Setup a wired network connection

#### 4 Local Video

The device supports AVI, RMVB/RM, WMV, TS, MKV, MOV, M2TS, TP, MPEG, MPG, MP4, VOB, ISO, DAT, ASF and FLV formats. Local Video enables users to view 1080P HD videos with resolutions up to 1920\*1080.



Google Chrome appears when the browser icon is opened.



Enter Local Video and it will search all the video formats that can be played in all the storage, such as U disk, SD card.

Image formats supported include: bmp, jpg and gif. Local Image allows the viewing of electronic albums.




Click the Local Music icon, and this screen appears (with a number of options, including album, song, artist, add music, and now playing).

#### 8 Online Video

The Online Video icon on the main screen



Online Video integrates free TV, video and radio information online.



Click Online Video and three icons: Muzee Radio, Muzee TV and Muzee Video appears, representing online radio, online TV and online video respectively.



Click Muzee TV and this screen appears, offering TV selections by categories, including TOP100, Local Selected, Top-Genre, Top-region,Top-language,Genre, Region,Language, Favorites and History.



Click Muzee Video and this screen appears, offering Video selections by categories, including TOP100,Local Selected, Top-Series, Top-Genre,

Top-language,Series, Genre, Language, Favorites and History.

# WII. Trouble Shooting

# Q: Why is my composite video connector of HD connector not shown?

- A:1.Check whether the connectors of different colors are installed as indicated in the instruction;
  - 2.Check whether the input mode has been set up for signal reception from the mainframe. Make sure to the video input mode is set up properly.
  - 3. Check whether the video connector is installed correctly.
- Q: Why can't I access the Internet after upgrade? Click "Setup", and re-configure network access setup.

#### A:

- Q: How to install the software applications?
- A: 1.Copy the applications in a USB or SD card;
  - 2.Click "Applications" on the main screen and select "Install Applications";
  - 3.Select /mnt/sda (USB) or /mnt/sdcard (SD card);
  - 4. Select the application you want to install and click "Install".
- Q: Why can't the application stored be displayed in full screen?
- A: Some programs have a fixed resolution, which might be inconsistent with that of the device. In this case, the application won't be displayed in full screen.
- Q: How to make it easier to visit my favorite websites?
- A: Click the browser to enter the webpage. Press the menu button on the remote controller. Move the cursor to "Add Bookmark Here". Enter name and address, and click "OK".

# VIII. Caution

In case of any of the following exceptions or failures, turn off the device and unplug the power socket immediately. Contact our designated service staff for the repair of the device. DO NOT repair it yourself to avoid accidents.

- The device smokes, or gives off odd smell or sound.
- Liquid or metal objects get into the device.
- There's no image or sound after the power supply is plugged and unplugged several times.
- The housing of the device is damaged in a drop or collision.

Protect the power cable and plug carefully to prevent fire or electric shocking accident.

- Do not cover the power cable with heavy objects.
- Do not fix the power cable with metal nails.
- Be careful not to damage, refit, bend, twist, extend, or bake the power cable when plugging or unplugging it.
- Please contact our service staff if the core of the power cable is exposed or broken.
- If the power cable cannot be plugged in, or is too loose when plugged in, replace your power socket to avoid electric shocking or fire accident due to exposure of the metal part.

Instructions for the storage of the device:

- Do not put the device on tumbling or tilt surfaces to avoid drop or rolling down, which might result in injury or failure of the device.
- Keep the device away from liquid or small metal objects, which might cause fire or electric shocking accident when they get inside.
- Do not put any candle or oil lamp on the device to prevent fire accidents.
- Do not use the device near windows, or in the bathroom to avoid fire or electric shocking accident due to moisture.

Instructions for the use of the device:

- The device uses high-voltage current inside its housing. To avoid fire and electric shocking accident, do not open the housing, or attempt to repair or refit the device. None of the parts shall be repaired by the user himself. Please contact our service staff for any repair work.
- Please take action to prevent any object (metal or flammable) from getting into the device from the ventilation hole to avoid fire or electric shocking accidents.
- If it is necessary to use the same power supply socket for a number of devices, please make sure that the total power does not exceed the rated power of the power socket or the power cable to avoid fire accident.
- DO NOT touch the power cable or power plug in times of lightning to avoid electric shock accidents. Use power supplies that fit the device or those recommended in the instructions to avoid fire or electric shock accidents.
- Be alerted when using the device in conditions of unstable voltages, and be prepared to cut off power supply whenever necessar.

Clean the power plug and socket routinely, as dust and foreign substances would cause fire when they get wet.
