To Whom It May Concern,

The module FCC ID: SWX-SR4 a radio module tested under part 90 subpart Y Public Safety 4.940 to 4.990 GHz band, received an FCC Grant on July 11, 2006.

BelAir Networks is submitting for approval the subject mini-PCI form factor module for a change in identification as per part 2.933 for marketing advantages.

A letter of agent authorization from the original manufacturer (Ubiquiti Networks) is included as part of this submission.
