

### Using instruction

(一) . Android OS



Turn on TP801, LED light.	
Slide your finger on Touchpad area to control the cursor on device screen.	
Mouse left button-Enter key, Right button-Back key	
Under Touchpad mode: (Click switch button to switch touch mode and keyboard mode)	<p>A. Touch panel supports click and double click as standard laptop.</p> <p>B. With Android OS, hold your left thumb on left of the touchpad, right thumb to slide left/right on touchpad to scroll a window left/right.</p> <p>C. When browsing website, hold your left thumb on left of the touchpad, right thumb to slide up/down on touchpad to scroll a window up/down</p> <p>D. Double click the touchpad to zoom in / out photos</p>
Under Keyboard mode: (click switch button touchpad mode and keyboard mode)	<p>A. Slight tap on character silk printing to get what you need.</p> <p>B. Tap Caps Lock key to switch capital letters and small letters.</p> <p>C. "#123 AB" key is switch button for No. and punctuation in ORANGE color.</p>

(二) . Windows 8 OS

When the power indicator becomes flashing, that means the built-in lithium power is low and need to charge. When charging full, the indicator will turn red into blue.
