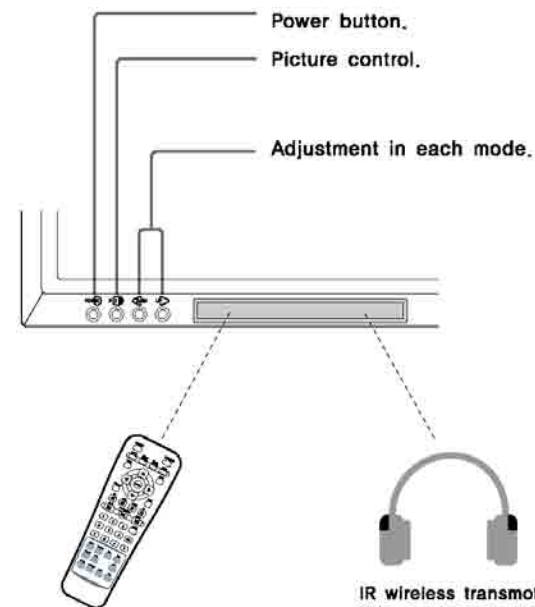
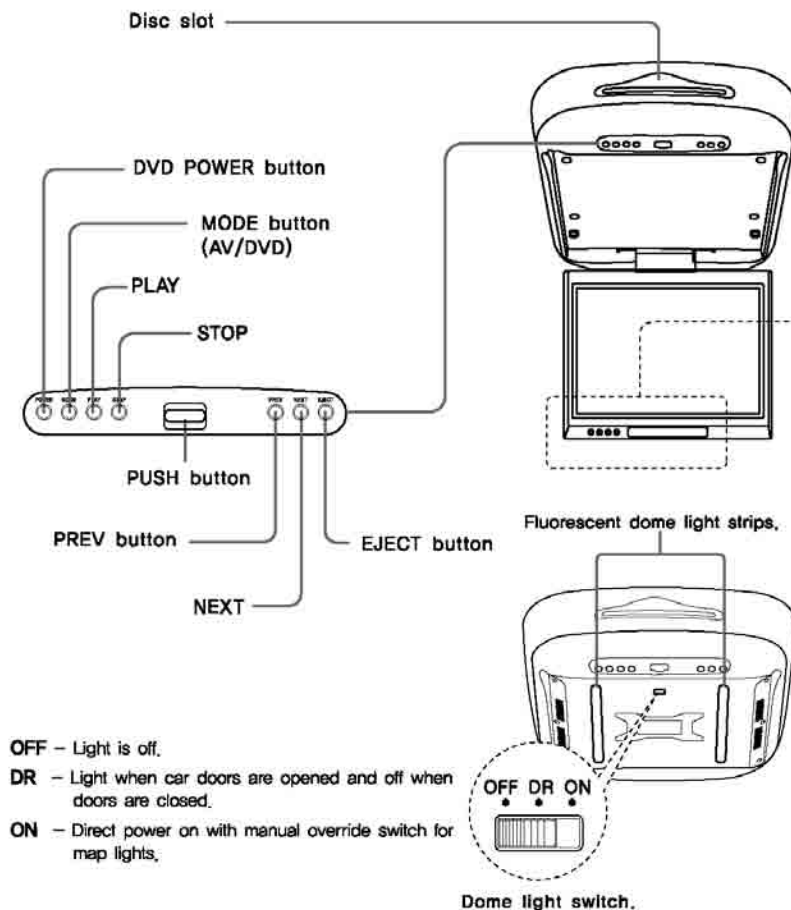


Check Point

1. The operating temperature of this product is limited to $-20^{\circ}\text{C} \sim 80^{\circ}\text{C}$. Your vehicle can reach temperatures up to 100 degrees centigrade in the summertime.
2. From time to time when your vehicle extremely hot or cold you must allow time for your air conditioner or heater to cool or heat the vehicle to operating temperatures to return to normal operating ranges. Your monitor will return to its normal functions when these operating ranges are achieved.
3. Your optimum picture quality is achieved when you are directly in front of the monitor (± 30 degrees).
4. Do not open covers and repair yourself, refer servicing to qualified personnel.
5. DVD Players use an invisible laser beam, which can cause hazardous radiation exposure for a long time of directed.
6. Do not cut the car power supply off while a disc is played, because it can cause damage in the DVD Player.

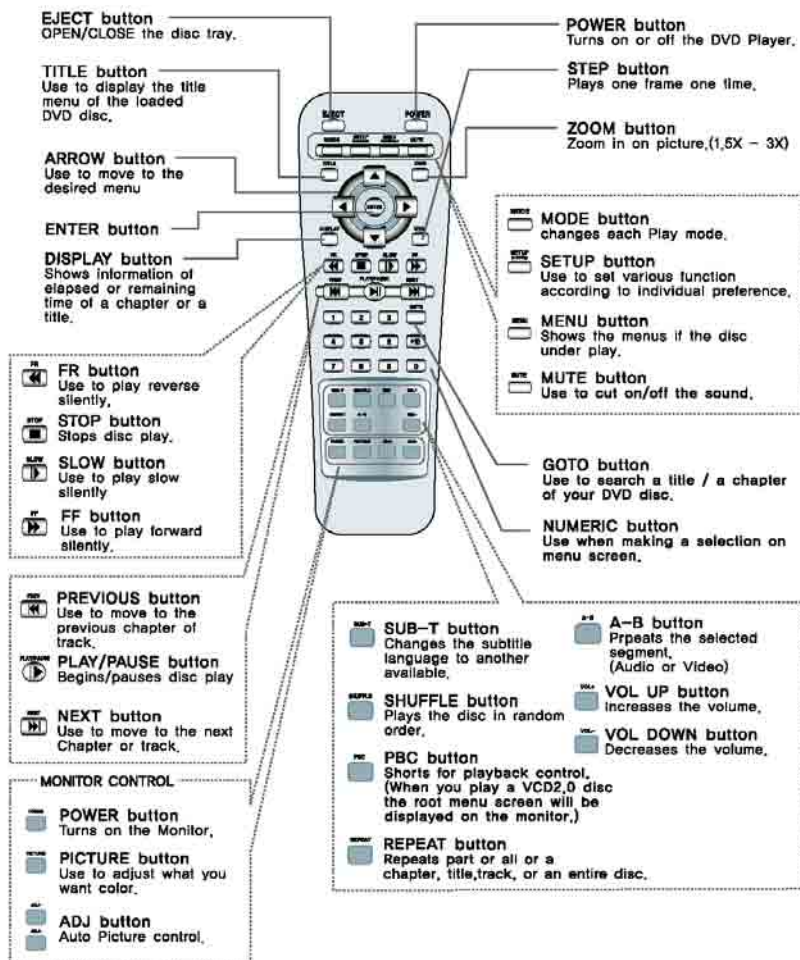

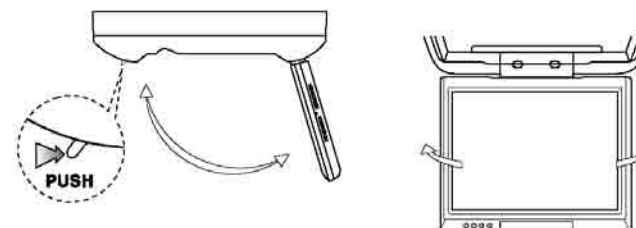

■ EXTRA PICTURE

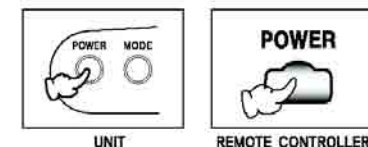
Push the open button, located at the front of your screen and lower the monitor to the desired level and angle of the swivel, mounted monitor.



※ When closing the displayed monitor on the ceiling mount, it will automatically be turned off. When opening the monitor again, it will automatically be turned on.

■ POWER AND MODE SELECT

1. Press the **POWER** button on the remote controller / the unit.
Press the **POWER** button once to turn the power on/ off.



2. Press the **MODE** button on the remote controller / the unit to achieve the desired **AV** Mode.
whenever you press the Mode button, the condition is to be changed as the picture.

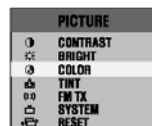
■ CONTRAST / BRIGHT / COLOR / TINT SELECTION

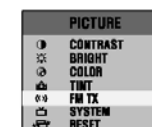
■ LISTENING TO YOUR MONITOR OVER YOUR CAR RADIO

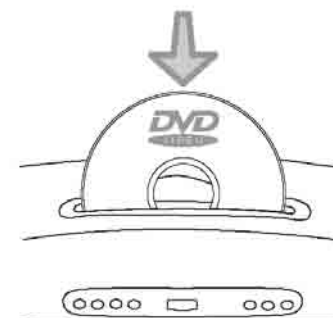

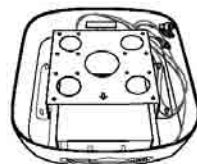

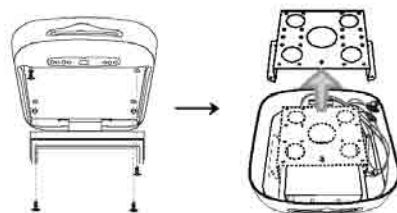

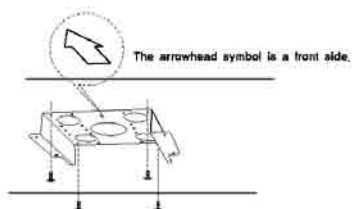

2. Disjoint the iron bracket from the unit like shown the picture. (Take apart the monitor from the ceiling mount bracket with unscrews four screws on the unit body.)

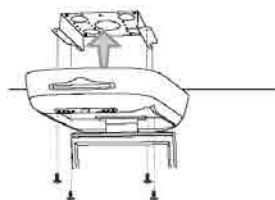


3. Tight the iron plate bracket with all screws on the ceiling.

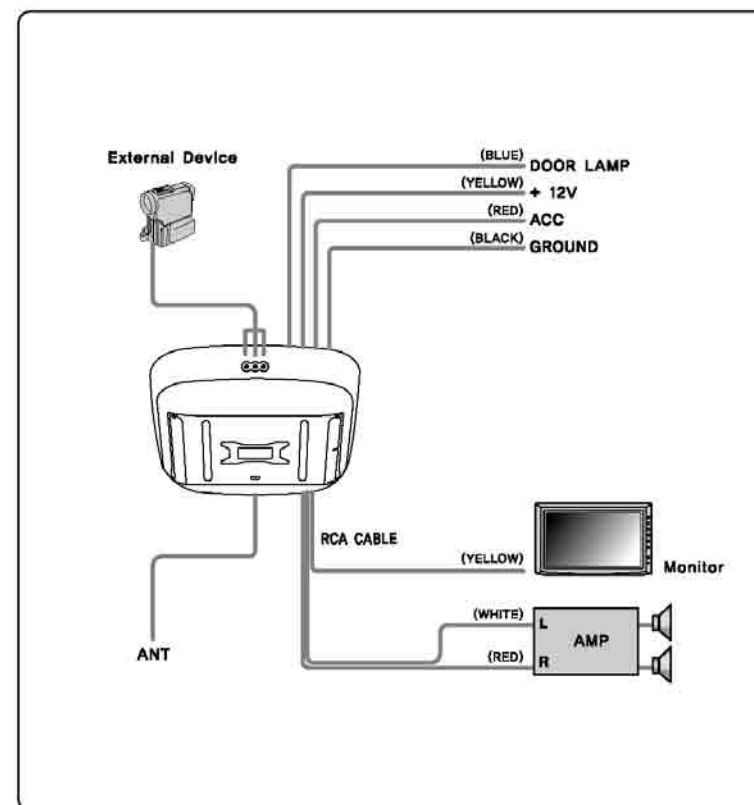


4. Connect all cable according to the condition of the diagram

Region code

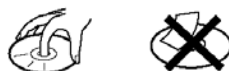
Your DVD player is designed and manufactured to region management information that is recorded on a DVD disc. The region number of this DVD Player is 3 and Plays free code also.

How to deal with disc

Don't touch the face carving information.
Don't stick label or glue-based note on disk(Don't use disks with remaining glue or damaged gluey label, it might result in damages to your DVD Player.)
Don't put discs at straight under the sunshine. And park your car under the shade.



Caution

Wipe softly with a wet cloth and then with a dry one.
Before playback, wipe the disc outwards from the center with clean cloth.
Do not use any type of solvent such as thinner, benzene, commercially available cleaners or antistatic spray.
Don't use scratched disc to avoid damaging your DVD Player.



TROUBLE SHOOTING

TROUBLE		ACTION
No Power	⇒	Check the AC power cable was connected properly
No Picture	⇒	Make sure that the equipment is connected properly, check the connected Monitor was turned on.
Stopped picture	⇒	Check the video cable was connected or TV/Monitor was turned on.
The playback picture is poor	⇒	Clean the disc.
No color	⇒	The Color system set by this unit does not match with that of TV/Monitor. Please check your System of the unit.
Distorted sound	⇒	Adjust the video system by pressing TV system button.(PAL, NTSC, MULTI)
The remote controller doesn't work properly	⇒	Remove the obstacles between the remote control unit and remote control sensor. Operate the remote controller in a short distance.
Displayed "DISK ERROR" on the screen	⇒	Set the power button to OFF and then back to ON alternatively, Turn off the power, disconnect the power plug and then reconnect it.

Check point

When a disk is brought from a cold environment to a hot one, there be steam on the face of disk or water will appear the pickup lens. It will effect the play.

1. Remove the disc from DVD player.
2. Please turn on the power (unload the disc) to operate it for an hour, vaporize the condensation with the home-grown heat.
3. You can use your DVD Player without any problems.
