


Watching the monitor for an extended period of time without the engine running may deplete the vehicle's battery charge.

This product is designed for operation with a 12 Volt DC, negative ground vehicle. It is not suitable for operation under other conditions or voltages.




Do not cover or stop up heater ducts or vents. It may be the origin of a fire or receives an electric shock.


1. The operating temperature of this product is limited to -4°F ~ +176°F. Your vehicle can reach temperatures up to 212°F in the summertime.
2. From time to time when your vehicle is extremely hot or cold you must allow time for your air conditioner or heater to cool or heat the vehicle and for operating temperatures to return to normal operating ranges. Your monitor will return to its normal functions when these operating ranges are achieved.
3. Your optimum picture quality is achieved when you are directly in front of the monitor (+/-30 degrees).
4. Do not open covers and repair yourself. Refer servicing to qualified personnel.
5. DVD Players use an invisible laser beam which can cause hazardous radiation exposure. Be sure to operate the unit correctly as instructed.


This allows transmitting of the remote control's IR signals for controlling all functions of your monitor.






How to operate the monitor

Releasing the monitor


Push the open button (located at the front of your screen) and lower the monitor to the desired level. You can also adjust the swivel angle.



※ The monitor will automatically turn off when it is closed to the ceiling mount. When the monitor is opened again, it will automatically be turned on.

POWER and MODE select

1. Press the POWER button on either the remote control or the unit once to turn the power on. Press the same POWER button to turn your power off.



2. Press the MODE button on the remote control or the unit to achieve the desired TV Mode. Whenever you press the MODE button, you will select either the auxiliary input or the DVD mode.



■ How to select channels automatically

1. SETUP(A.MEMO) button on the remote control to select all available channels. (only TV mode)

※ Channel may not be selected in a bad RF signal region.

2. Select the channel you want by pressing arrow **▲/▼** button the remote control.

■ How to select channels by manual

Use to add or delete channels manually.

1. Select channels you want by pressing the number(0~9) buttons or arrow **▲/▼** button on the remote control.

2. Select ADD or DEL with the MENU(ADD/DEL) button on the remote control.



■ How to control the VOLUME

Listen to the Audio sound through the car installed speaker.

1. Bring up the on-screen picture control menu by pressing the PICTURE button on the remote control or the MENU button on the unit.

NORMAL




The screen will be the standard 4:3 ratio.


■ FM transmitter control function

(Remember to extend your car antenna.)


1. Bring up the on-screen picture control menu by pressing the PICTURE button on the remote control or the MENU button on the unit.




2. Select FM TX by pressing the SEL V/A buttons on the unit to move the cyan-colored cursor window up or down.



3. Press the ADJ < / > buttons on the unit to select a setting between 88.3, 88.5, 88.7, 88.9, and 90.1MHz.





4. Select an open frequency on your car radio - 88.3, 88.5, 88.7, 88.9, and 90.1.




■ Playing your DVD player

1. Press the POWER button on the monitor or on the remote control.



2. Press the MODE button on the remote control or the unit to select the desired DVD Mode.


Whenever you press the MODE button, you will select either the TV mode or the auxiliary input.



3. Insert the disc you want to play.

Most of DVD titles will be played automatically.

Caution : Insert the disc with the label side.



■ SETUP MENU-MAIN PAGE

Ø An invalid button press.

When this symbol appears, it indicates that an invalid button has been pressed. There are some differences between real functions and functions in manual.

You can easily modify setup information on the setup menu.

Caution : You should remove the disc from your DVD player first. Then press the (SETUP) button. If a DVD is playing when the (SETUP) button is pressed, the DVD player will be paused.

When the (SETUP) button is pressed, the monitor screen shows the setup menu as shown below. Select a menu category to modify according to individual preference.

1. Press the STOP button, if the disc is being played.
2. To call the SETUP menu, press the SETUP(A.MEMO) button.



3. Use the button to find desired items.

4. To turn off the SETUP menu, press the SETUP(A.MEMO)button again.

■ GENERAL SETUP

1. TV DISPLAY

You can select a TV screen aspect ratio according to your TV.

If the TV on which the movie is played "WIDE" type, choose "WIDE". If it is of "4:3" type, choose NORMAL/PS(Pan & Scan) or NORMAL/LB(Letter BOX).



NORMAL / PS 4:3 PAN & SCAN

Choose this setting if you want the movie to fill the entire screen. (This might mean that the left and right edges won't be seen)



NORMAL / LB 4:3 LETTER BOX

Choose this setting if you want to see movies in their original aspect ratio. (The movie might appear with black bars at the top and bottom of the screen.)



WIDE 16:9 WIDE SCREEN

Choose this setting if your DVD Player is connected to a widescreen TV. (This option is available only if the disc has a 16:9 display aspect ratio.)

Caution

This option is available only when the disc has the function.



2. ANGLE MARK

You can set up so that the angle mark appears on scenes.

On : When selected, the screen will show angle mark during disc play.

Off : When selected, no angle mark is shown on the screen.



3. OSD LANG

Use this option to set the OSD language.

When selected, change to set the on-screen display language.



4. CAPTIONS

Adjust caption selection.

On : Choose this setting to display captions.

Off : Choose this setting to close captions.



5. SCREEN SAVER

The screen saver is useful to prevent your display from becoming damaged. The screen saver picture appears when you leave the DVD player in stop mode for about two minutes.



6. LAST MEMORY

Adjusts last memory selection.



AUDIO SETUP

1. DOLBY DIGITAL SETUP

DUAL MONO

Use this function to set the input audio signal to fit into the speaker.



DYNAMIC

Use this function to change the setting from the factory. - Preset Off position.



2. EQUALIZER

EQ TYPE

This unit can produce a 3D surround effect, using 3D Surround Sound technology.


Choose the desired preset equalizer mode.

(None, Rock, Pop, Live, Dance, Techno, Classic, Saft)



BASS BOOST

This is enhanced at all levels without distorting other frequencies.



SUPER BASS

This is enhanced at all levels without distorting other frequencies.



TREBLE BOOST

This is enhanced at all levels without distorting other frequencies.



■ VIDEO QUALITY SETUP

1. QUALITY

SHARPNESS

Use this option to select screen sharpness.

Select screen sharpness using the direction **◀/▶** button and press the **ENTER** button.



BRIGHTNESS

Use this option to select screen brightness.

Adjust overall screen brightness using the direction **◀/▶** button.



CONTRAST

Use this option to select screen contrast.

Select screen contrast using the direction **◀/▶** button.

Contrast adjusts the image quality by increasing or decreasing the ratio of bright and dark screen section.



GAMMA

Select screen gamma using the direction **◀/▶** button and press the **ENTER** button. Gamma adjustment is to revive the dark screen section by raising the level of dark section, while leaving the bright screen section unchanged.



HUE

Select screen hue level using the direction **◀/▶** button.



SATURATION

Select screen saturation level using the direction **◀/▶** button.



LUMA DELAY

Select the Luma Delay menu and select the preferred video image quality.



■ PREFERENCE

1. TV Type

Choose a proper operating setting according to the color system of the TV Type - Multi system, NTSC, PAL.


- 1) Press the SETUP button during stop mode.
- 2) Press the **◀/▶** button to move to Preference.
- 3) Press the **▲/▼** button to move to TV Type.
- 4) Press the ENTER button.
- 5) Press the **▲/▼** button to select TV Type.



2. PBC (Paly Back Control)

This feature is only available when a (Super) Video CD is loaded. It allows you to disable or enable the PBC(Playback Control)menu of VCD discs.

- 1) Press the SETUP button during stop mode.
- 2) Press the **◀/▶** button to move to Preference.
- 3) Press the **▲/▼** button to move to PBC.
- 4) Press the ENTER button.
- 5) Press the **▲/▼** button to select On/Off.



3. AUDIO

Use the audio language menu to select the subtitle language that you prefer. If the disc you are playing has that language available, it will display subtitles in that language.

- 1) Press the SETUP button during stop mode.
- 2) Press the **◀/▶** button to move to Preference.
- 3) Press the **▲/▼** button to move to Audio.
- 4) Press the ENTER button.
- 5) Press the **▲/▼** button to select desired audio language.



4. SUBTITLE

Use the subtitle language menu to select the subtitle language that you prefer. If the disc you are playing has that language available, it will display subtitles in that language.

- 1) Press the SETUP button during stop mode.
- 2) Press the **◀/▶** button to move to Preference.
- 3) Press the **▲/▼** button to move to Subtitle.
- 4) Press the ENTER button.
- 5) Press the **▲/▼** button to select desired subtitle.



5. DISC MENU

Use the Disc Menu option to select the language you want a DVD's disc menu to be displayed in (not the same as the player menu)

- 1) Press the SETUP button during stop mode.
- 2) Press the **◀/▶** button to move to Preference.
- 3) Press the **▲/▼** button to move to Subtitle.
- 4) Press the ENTER button.
- 5) Press the **▲/▼** button to select Disc Menu.



6. PARENTAL

The Parental feature is a rating limit system, like movie ratings. It works with DVD's that have been assigned a rating. This option lets you determine how your player will react to discs that contain movies that are rated (in the U.S.A., the Motion Pictures Association of America rates movies as G, PG, PG-13, ect.). You decide which ratings require a password and which ones don't.

- 1) Press the SETUP button when stop mode.
- 2) Press the **◀/▶** button to move to Preference.
- 3) Press the **▲/▼** button to move to Parental.
- 4) Press the ENTER button.
- 5) Press the **▲/▼** button to select desired parental level.



7. COUNTRY REGION

Use this menu function to change the COUNTRY REGION.

- 1) Press the SETUP button when stop mode.
- 2) Press the **◀/▶** button to move to Preference.
- 3) Press the **▲/▼** button to move to Country Region.
- 4) Press the ENTER button.
- 5) Press the **▲/▼** button to select desired Country Region.



8. DEFAULT

If user selects reset from the setup menu, all the value of setup menu will be initialized by factory setting value. (Exception: Parental level, Region code and Password values will not be changed)

- 1) Press the SETUP button when stop mode.
- 2) Press the **◀/▶** button to move to Preference.
- 3) Press the **▲/▼** button to move to Default.
- 4) Press the ENTER button.
- 5) Press the ENTER button to select reset.



■ PASSWORD SETUP

1. PASSWORD MODE



2. PASSWORD CHANGE

- 1) Select "Password Setup" sub item
- 2) Enter your old password, and new password in 4 digits.
- 3) Re-enter new password for confirmation then press the ENTER button.



POWER

Power ON/OFF button.

OPEN/CLOSE

Each press of the EJECT button changes the play mode as the text to the right illustrates. When you insert your DVD disc into the DVD player, "DISC LOADING" will appear on the screen. Then the DVD disc is played automatically.

MODE

Changes each Play mode.
