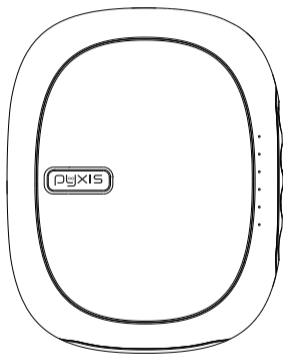

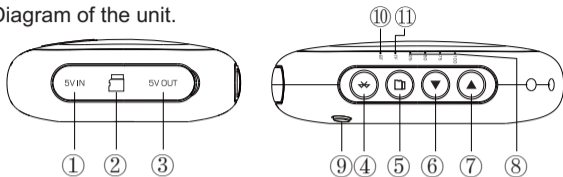

- ① USB Input Charging Port
- ② TF Card Slot

- ④ Bluetooth Mode play/pause music, answer/hang-up calls.
- ⑤ TF Card Mode
- ⑥ Previous Song / Volume Down
- ⑦ Next Song / Volume Up
- ⑧ Battery Indicator Light
- ⑨ Power Switch ON/OFF
- ⑩ Bluetooth Indicator Light
- ⑪ TF Card Indicator Light

## 5. Operation Instruction

### 5.1. Power On/Off

Long press  button to turn On/Off the speaker. Bluetooth function is on as well, and BT indication LED will keep flash.

### 5.2. Bluetooth Function

- If under TF card mode, press Bluetooth icon  to switch to Bluetooth mode; If not, ignore this step.
- Turn on Bluetooth function in your mobile phone, searching Bluetooth device.
- Choose “Palmbox” to pair (No need password)
- When it is paired successfully, you will hear a sound of for connection “DU” (When you switch from Bluetooth mode to other modes, Bluetooth will be disconnected. When back to Bluetooth mode, Bluetooth will be connected again automatically.)
- When calling is coming, press  to answer the calling.
- Press again to hang-up the calling.
- Under Bluetooth mode, press  to pause, and press  again to play music.
- Long press  to previous song, long press  to next song

- Press ▼ to decrease volume , press ▲ to increase volume

### 5.3. Playing music by TF card.

- Insert TF card into the unit, it will switch to TF card mode automatically and play music.
- If under Bluetooth mode, press ■ to TF card mode.
- Under TF card mode, press ■ to pause, press ■ again to play music
- Long press ▼ to previous song, long press ▲ to next song
- Press ▼ to decrease volume, press ▲ to increase volume

### 5.4. Micro USB Charging for the speaker

- Insert the micro USB charging cable into USB input charging port
- Battery indicator light flashing , indicate the speaker is in charging mode. LED light will stop flashing when speaker is fully charged.

### 5.5. External device charging

To charge a device, connect device to USB output slot via USB cable (not supplied).
