I have a few comments on this Application.

- 1.) This device is a 31mW transmitter feeding an 8dBi antenna for a total EIRP about 200mW. I simply do not believe the peak radiated field strength of the fundamental would be as low as you show in your Test Report. Please review, re-measure, and comment.
- 2.) The Manual does not give clear warnings to either end users or installers about the necessity for maintaining a minimum of 20cm separation from all persons. My assumption is that, although professionally installed, instances of indoor installation may occur. This will then necessitate the 20cm warning.
- 3.) In addition to the installation instructions provided, please supply information to be given to the end user, if different than what is included with this filing.
