

Date Code Labels and FCC Labels for WDU and Keyfob

**Change in specification.**

Lasershield received instructions about the FCC requirements for placement of the FCC ID number. The FCC ID number must be on a part of the product that is not removable – i.e. the battery door (which is removable) cannot be the only location of the FCC ID number.

Those instructions from the FCC require Lasershield to issue this change order for FCC and date code labels on the WDU and Keyfob.

**New Requirement for WDU**

A new label with the FCC ID number will be placed on the bottom housing of the WDU. Please see the picture on the following page for the placement of the label. The label will have an adhesive that will hold the label securely for the intended life of the product.

The new FCC ID number label will be 25mm x 5mm

*There is no change in the WDU battery door label and no change in the date code label that is placed on the battery door.*

**New requirement for keyfob**

We need to add the FCC ID number to the date code label for the keyfob. The location of the date code label for the keyfob will not change. The date code label of the keyfob will be larger to allow both numbers to be printed on the label. The label will have an adhesive that will hold the label securely for the intended life of the product.

The keyfob Date Code/FCC label will be 25mm x 10mm. Please see the picture on page 3 for the location and printing on the keyfob Date Code/FCC label.

*There is no change in the Keyfob battery door label. See page 4 for picture.*
