Dear Mr. Luu

This letter from Extreme Networks is an attestation of our compliance to the following 2 requirements for the Altitude 350-2 Wireless access point with integrated and detachable antennas, as requested by TIMCO-TCB on July 19, 2005.

1. *Part 15.15(b): The test report refers to Channel 1-14. Please provide an attestation that the device does not have any provisions for operations outside the USA frequency bands. Particularly, it should be stated that the user does not have any means (i.e. user controls or software) to operate the device outside the allocated frequency band in the USA.*
2. *Please provide an attestation from the applicant explaining how the reduction in maximum power to 18dBm will be achieved for compliance at the band-edges.*

There are no provisions in the product that provide for operations outside of the USA frequency bands. Neither are there means for the user, either via user controls or software that permit operation of the device outside the allocated frequency band in the USA.

For 802.11b operation, reduction in maximum power to 18dBm for compliance at the band-edges is achieved through a software parameter setting that is fixed in the software image. With this fixed software setting, output power at the peak and the band edges for each channel complies with the FCC standard. Please refer to the attached test report performed by Ultratech Engineering Labs Inc.
