



SAR TEST PLAN EXPLANATION OF FCC IDs WITHIN RDT TEMPUS IC FOR CLASS II PERMISSIVE CHANGE CERTIFICATION FCC ID: ROSTEMPUSIC-2

The SAR test plan V3.0, submitted as an RF Exposure Info exhibit as part of the Form 731 application for certification, details a set of FCC IDs which are the original FCC IDs for the GSM and Bluetooth modules and SDIO WLAN card. All three devices have since been through Change in ID certifications detailed as follows:

The host equipment is the Tempus IC manufactured by RDT and it contains three completely unmodified radio modules:

1. Cinterion GSM module (original FCC ID: QIPMC55I) which went through a change in FCC ID application in December 2012 and RDT now hold a grant for this module under FCC ID: ROSTEMPUSIC-2.
2. Bluegiga Bluetooth module (original FCC ID: QQQWT11) which went through a change in FCC ID application in April 2013 and RDT now hold a grant for this module under FCC ID: ROSTEMPUSIC-BT.
3. The WLAN module RDT use is FCC ID: P5T-WL54SDIO, the grantee for which (and supplier to RDT) is AmbiCom Holdings. This WLAN module was originally certified by Abocom Systems Inc. under FCC ID: MQ4SDW11G i.e. the FCC ID listed on the first page of the SAR test plan.

AmbiCom Holdings went through a change in FCC ID application in January 2007 to allow them to market the WLAN module in their own name with their own FCC ID and that's how they supply it to RDT. RDT have no commercial relationship with Abocom Systems and all WLAN modules (FCC ID: P5T-WL54SDIO) are supplied by AmbiCom Holdings.

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
