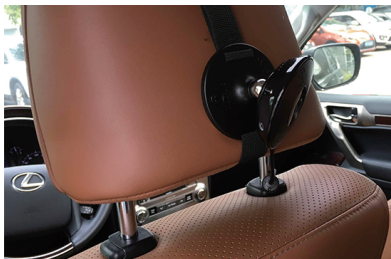


The user manual of i500X,i500S

Kids in Car



1. Fasten the belt on the headrest of the front seats.



2. Place the camera on the magnetic plate and plug in the power.

When your smart phone connects with i500X/S, you can receive and make calls but can't use on line GPS and surf the net.

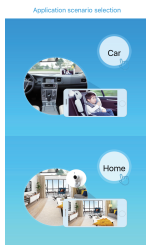
2. Turn on i500X/S and wait about 15s until the green light is on.

4. Open the APP and choose "Car".
