After a review of the submitted information, I have a few comments on the above referenced Application.

Administrative Issues:

- 1) The application appears to be for a "Change in ID" per 2.933, but includes a letter for a Class II Permissive change. Note that you may not perform both a Permissive Change and Change in ID in one application. Please clarify. Note that it appears that the device may not have any changes, but this can not adequately be determined. Note that for a Change in ID, a cover letter addressing 2.933(b)(4) does need to be provided.

The remaining questions below assume a Change of ID application is being submitted.

- 2) The authorization letter should include the date of grant as specified in 2.933(b).
- 3) External photographs of the new model for Thomson Telecom Belgium should be provided as specified in 2.933(b)(5).

Failure to provide the requested information may result in application termination.
