
1. Outlook Description

Front view



①. Touch panel: 7" Capacitive touch screen: Clicking and dragging on the screen are available.

Top view




① Volume "+"/ Volume "-"

2. Power Button Usage

Open

Press and hold the power button  about 2 seconds to open the screen

Shut down

Press and hold the power button , then the screen shows< Do you want to shut down>, tap<OK> to shut down.

Open the standby mode

In boot mode, you can tap the power button  on the top side of the tablet, the system will enter into the standby mode which can save power.

Close the standby mode

In the stand by mode, light tap of the power button on the top side to wake up the device, enter the normal state.

Force Off: If device does not respond, press and hold the power button for 8 seconds.

Note: If it is necessary, we don't suggest use **Force Off**. You should follow the steps to perform the shutdown.

Reset Button: Press the reset button to re-boot the device. Reset will erase all data on the device, please caution this feature. (**Note:** Current the reset function can not be restart, so after reset you need to press the power button to re-boot.)

3. Getting Started

Charge the device

Use this MID for the first time; charge your battery 4 hours to ensure that the battery is full of charged before use.

It is not recommended to use the device while charging.

- Apply the power adapter to charge for MID.
- Red battery indicate it's being charged. Please wait until it is fully charged and don't pull out the adapter while charging. When it is fully-charged, the indicate will turn to blue.

Lock and unlock the screen

Lock

Can be set to automatically lock screen or quickly press the power button to manually lock screen. The system provides four lock screen style for users. You can enter Settings → Security → Lock Screen to switch.

Lock screen displays the following:




You can set up the sleep time in the system of <display>.

The system will sleep automatically and lock the screen to the standby mode if without any inactivity when reaches the preset of standby time.

Unlock



Moving and dragging this  to unlock the screen and enter the application interface.



Wi-Fi Network Setup

Since many features require a Wi-Fi connection, we recommend you set up your Wi-Fi network now.

1. Tap  → Settings, → Wireless & networks.
2. Select Wi-Fi to turn on.

The device automatically scans and lists all local Wi-Fi Network found. A  indicates secure networks that require login name/password to connect.


3. Tap the desired network to which you want to connect, → enter the Network Password if applicable, → tap Connect.
4. Tap  to return to the Desktop screen.



If your Wi-Fi network is set as hidden, it won't be found by the auto scan.

Tap Add Wi-Fi network and follow the prompts to add your network.

Touch, hold and then slide icons to reposition them on the screen.


Touch, hold and slide icons onto  to remove them from the Desktop screen.

6. USB Connection


Connecting to a computer

1. Connect the MID and computer by Micro USB cable, the reminder column will show the remind information.
2. Click the USB icon, pop up the status with reminder information Show as below picture:

(1). click the “USB Connected”, it will as below Picture,



(2). In the pop-up picture, click “Turn on USB storage”; after the connection is successful, the robot icon will turn yellow. Show as below:



3. Copy files between your computer and your Android's SD card.

4. After copying finishes, click “Turn off USB storage” to uninstall, show as above picture:

When the device connected to the computer, please do not play files, in order to avoid adverse effects.

Connecting to a Keyboard, Mouse

Sometimes when you want to type for an extended period of time, you may want to connect a full-size keyboard to the MID.

Use the dedicated USB data cable to connect a keyboard to the MID.

You may also use this connection to add a mouse or storage device etc. to the MID.

7. Battery Management

The battery is not fully charged out of the box, so it is recommended that you charge the battery for at least 4 hours before you start to use the device.

The rechargeable battery is designed and manufactured to be used and recharged frequently. As with all batteries, the capacity of the battery reduces each time it is charged/depleted. However, you can still try to prolong the battery's lifetime by following the suggestions below:

- Use your Tablet at least once a week.
- Charge the battery regularly and fully.
- Never leave the battery fully discharged for a long period of time.
- Always keep the device and the battery away from heat.

Charge battery

Plug the power adapter into an electrical wall outlet, and then connect to the device to fully charge the battery before use (approx. 4hours).

When fully charged, the battery icon displays as: 

A fully discharged battery takes approximately 4 hours to fully charge, but you can use the device while plugged in when desired.

- ◆ Adjust to suitable volume. If you feel tinnitus, please turn down or stop using.
- ◆ Please charge if you meet those situations as below:
 - A、 No power is displayed on the battery icon.
 - B、 The system turn off automatically, turn off soon after turning on again.
 - C、 The keys do not work.
 - D、“” is displayed on the right-down corner of the device.

【TIPS】: Other chargers are not available. If you want an original charger, please contact us.

- ◆ When the machine is charging, it will be a little hot (but not too hot), this is normal, and won't effect your using.
- ◆ Do not remove the connector while formatting, downloading and uploading. Otherwise it will make the device get error.
- ◆ Do not dismantle this device by yourself, and do not polish it with alcohol, dilution, or benzene.
- ◆ Do not use this device where electronics is forbidden, such as on the plane.
- ◆ Do not use this device while walking and driving, avoiding traffic accident.
