I have a few comments on this Application. Depending on your responses, kindly understand there may be additional comments.

- 1.) The Internal Photographs are incomplete. Top and bottom of all circuit boards and all radio modules must be presented. Please supplement your existing internal photograph with additional circuit board views for both the Handset and Base.
- 2.) Rule 15.214(c) reads: 'The label... shall also contain the following statement: "Privacy of communications may not be ensured when using this phone."' Please indicate where this statement shall be found.
- 3.) Rule 15.214(d) requires the use of security codes to protect against unintentional access to the switched public telephone network. Several methods are described in this section to meet compliance. Kindly revise your Operational Description to describe the methodology used as a solution for this requirement. This statement is required under section 15.214(d)(3). FYI: This required document can be held Confidential, if desired.
- 4.) Although not specified in the Rules, an Occupied Bandwidth for both the Handset and the Base would be useful. This is to insure that all emissions will indeed lie within the band 902-928 MHz.
- 5.) FYI: Are any other spurious emissions data available for the band above 1GHz? If so, could you kindly add to the table of emissions you have already created in Section 3.5 of the Test Report? In general, it is the preference of this Reviewer to see at least 6 frequencies in addition to the fundamental emission frequencies. Please provide if available.
