STARTUP


- 1. Open the color box and take out the Submarine and Set Transmitter.
- 2. Take out the RC Submarine from the clear blister.

HOW TO INSTALL THE BATTERIES:

- Unscrew and lift up the battery door of the Transmitter and place

 3PCS X AAA(1.5V) batteries into the battery compartment. Then relocate the

 battery door and tighten the screw. Ensure the polarities of the batteries are correct.
- Unscrew and lift up the battery door of the the charging platform and place
 PCS X AAA(1.5V) batteries into the battery compartment. Then relocate the
 battery door and tighten the screw. Ensure the polarities of the batteries are correct.




CHARGING THE RC SUBMARINE:

- 1.Plug out the rear body from the front body.
- 2.Place the submarine on top of the charging platform unit as shown in the picture.
- 3. Press the charging button on the platform, then the LED indicator will turn on.
- 4.After the LED is OFF, plug out the submarine, and plug the rear body into the front body.
 It must be plugged tightly.

Remarks: A) If the power of the batteries is low, the LED light will become dim or will not come on at all.

B) If the submarine become slowly or the spotlight inside it become dimmer, please follow above charging procedures or if necessary replace batteries.

Attention: When re-charging the Submarine after playing, make sure the submarine is dry.



OPERATING THE RC SUBMARINE:

- 1. Screw/thread the antenna in the antenna hole located on top of the Transmitter.
- 2. Fully extend the Transmitter antenna.
- 3. Turn "ON" the Transmitter by pushing the switch to "ON" position.
- $4.\,\mbox{Hold}$ the Transmitter and point to the RC Submarine.
- 5. Press the forward and reverse buttons to make the submarine dive forward and backward respectively. Press the left button and right button to make it turn left and right respectively.
- 6. Leave it idles can make it float up.

7. Rings can be put into / removed from the head of torpedo to adjust the balance as seen in icture.


Reverse

Remarks: a) Transmitter and charging platform cannot be put under water as it is not waterproof.

- b) Interference may be happened accidentally when similar bands RC Submarine play at the same time.
- c) The Submarine is to be operated in water only when fully assembled.

Attention: a) When operating the Transmitter, please do not touch the antenna. Otherwise, the remote control distance and the speed of the submarine will both be reduced.

b) To preserve battery life, always turn "OFF" the controller after playing.

CAUTION:

- 1. Batteries should only be inserted or changed by adult.
- 2. Do not use rechargeable batteries.
- 3. Non-rechargeable batteries are not to be recharged.
- 4. Do not mix alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc), or rechargeable (nickel-cadmium) batteries.
- 5. Never mix old batteries with new batteries (replace all batteries at the same time).
- 6. Be sure to insert batteries with the correct polarities.
- 7. Remove batteries from product before extended storage.
- 8. Always remove old or dead batteries from the product.
- 9. The supply terminals are not to be short-circuited.
- 10. Check that the contact surfaces are clean and bright before installing batteries.
- 11. Only batteries of the same or equivalent type as recommended are to be used.
- 12. Exhausted batteries should be disposed of in special containers.



MAINTENANCE AND PERFORMANCE TIPS:

- Playing time for RC Submarine approximately 4 minutes.
- . Charging time is approximately 2 minutes.
- Note: Battery life varies depending on usage.
- Alkaline batteries are preferable to use
