

Battery Caution:


Extreme ATV Instruction Manual

- 1. Non-rechargrable batteries are not to be recharged.
- 2. Rechargeable batteries are to be removed from the toy before being charged.
- 3. Rechargeable batteries are only to be charged under adult supervision.
- 4. Different types of batteries or new and used batteries are not to be mixed.
- 5. Only batteries of the same or equivalent type as recommended are to be used.
- 6. Batteries are to be inserted with the correct polarity.
- 7. Remove batteries from the product before extended storage.
- 8. The supply terminals are not to be short-circuited.
- 9. Batteries must be replaced by an adult.
- 10. We recommend to use alkaline batteries in the product to obtain better performance.
- 11. There are many brands of batteries existing on the market, if you do not get a proper connection, remove and insert again or try with another brand.
- 12. Exhausted batteries should be removed from the toys and disposed in special container.
- 13. Check that the contact surfaces are clean and bright before installing batteries.






Transmitter Battery Installation



Antenna Assembly







- 1. Make sure the transmitter's power switch is turned OFF when installing batteries.
- 2. Unscrew battery door of transmitter.
- 3. Install 1.5V(AA X 2) Alkaline batteries into the battery compartment; make sure the positive (+) and negative (-) poles are positioned correctly.
- 4. Replace the battery door and tighten the screw.

Charger Battery Installation

- 1. Unscrew the battery door on the bottom of charger.
- 2. Install 1.5V (AA X 4) Alkaline batteries in the battery compartment; make sure the positive (+) and negative(-) poles are positioned correctly.



Transmitter Index



To Charge The Vehicle

- 1. Plug the Vehicle into charger via the charging cord as indicated.
- 2. Press the charging button and make sure the LED indicator Lights up red, indicating it is charging.



Note:

- 1. Charging time is approximately 3 minutes.
- 2. Playing time is approximately 3 minutes.
- 3. The charging progress of the other 5 items is the same to this one.





Red LED Indicator /ON-OFF Switch




Turn the power switch of transmitter to ON position and operation indicator will light up.

Steering Alignment Lever of swift / storm Buggy



If you find the vehicle does not run in straight, you can adjust the steering alignment lever on the bottom of the vehicle.

Trigger Switch




pull and push the trigger to operate the vehicle moving forward or reverse. vehicle 's direction

Stunt Action for ATV Quad





Climb up the abstruction

Operation range is at least 5 meters. (Without interference)

- 1. Please extend the antenna of transmitter for better performance.
- 2. Please uncurl the antenna of vehicle for better performance.

 Avoid water damage to transmitter and vehicle. If they get wet, stop operating immediately and wait until they completely dry.
