## 11.1 Friis transmission formula: Pd= (Pout\*G)\ (4\*pi\*R<sup>2</sup>)

Where

Pd= Power density in mW/cm<sup>2</sup>

Pout=output power to antenna in mW

G= Numeric gain of the antenna relative to isotropic antenna

Pi=3.1416

R= distance between observation point and center of the radiator in cm Pd the limit of MPE, 1mW/cm<sup>2</sup>. If we know the maximum gain of the total power input to the antenna, through the calculation, we will know the distance where the MPE limit is reached.
