After a review of the submitted information, I have a few comments on the above referenced Application.

1) FYI....Quanta has explained that the design will currently only utilize BT V1.2 compliant communication protocol even though the hardware will currently support BT V2.0 compliance. They also stated that they have no intention to upgrade the software to support above v1.2 for BT protocol. Should the EUT software ever be changed to support above BT v1.2 in the future, the device must be tested for the newer modulation present for Bluetooth. Dependent on the results obtained either a Class II Permissive Change or new FCC ID must be used at that time.
