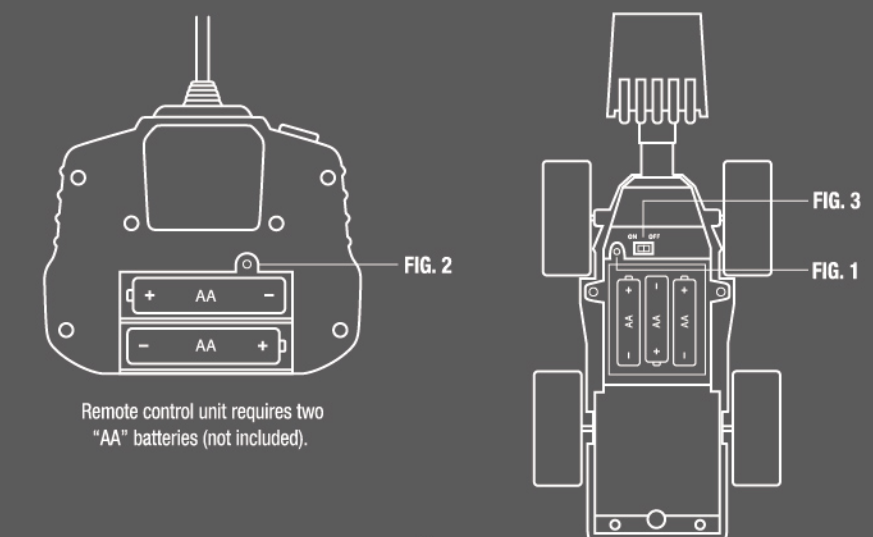

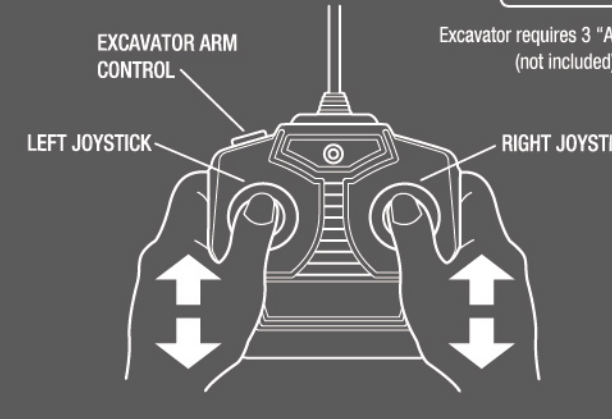
BATTERY INSTALLATION

- The excavator requires 3 "AA" batteries (not included). The remote control unit requires two "AA" batteries (not included). When changing batteries, adult supervision is required. Use alkaline batteries for best performance.
- Using a screwdriver, remove the screws from the battery compartment door located on the underside of the vehicle to open (Fig. 1).
 - Insert 3 "AA" batteries while observing the correct polarity.
 - Replace the screw/battery compartment door.
 - Next, remove the screws from the battery compartment door located on the backside of the remote control unit to open (Fig. 2).
 - Insert 2 "AA" batteries while observing the correct polarity.
 - Replace the screw/battery compartment door.
 - Switch the vehicle power switch to the "ON" position (Fig. 3).
 - The excavator is now ready for operation.



SAFETY PRECAUTIONS

- Do not operate during thunderstorms or rain.
- Avoid water, sand and snow when operating your vehicle.
- Do not submerge vehicle or controller in water.
- Never operate your vehicle on the street or highway.
- Adult supervision is recommended when operating this vehicle.
- Remove all batteries when not in use to avoid accidental operation.
- Never operate your vehicle in a confined or crowded area, and do not use people or animals as obstacles.
- Do not run your vehicle into furniture, objects or hard surfaces, as this will cause damage to both the object and the vehicle.
- Keep fingers, hair and loose clothing away from the tires, gears and motor while the vehicle is switched to "ON".
- Do not leave vehicle or controller near sources of heat or under direct sunlight for long periods of time.
- Do not leave vehicle or controller outside overnight. Dampness is harmful to interior components.



- OPERATING CONTROLS**
- Push both levers up to move forward
 - Push both levers down to move backwards
 - Push left lever to move right
 - Push right lever to move left
 - Press top left button to raise/lower excavator arm
