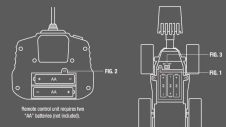

BATTERY INSTALLATION

The excavator requires 2 "AA" batteries (not included). The remote control unit requires 4 "AA" batteries (not included). When inserting batteries, make sure they are inserted in the correct orientation. Consult the battery compartment door located on the underside of the vehicle to insert (Fig. 3).
 • Insert 2 "AA" batteries into the battery compartment door.
 • Replace the cover/battery compartment door.
 • Make sure the cover/battery compartment door is closed properly.
 • Insert 4 "AA" batteries into the remote control unit.
 • Replace the cover/battery compartment door.
 • Insert the vehicle power switch to the "ON" position (Fig. 3).
 • The excavator is now ready to operate.



SAFETY PRECAUTIONS

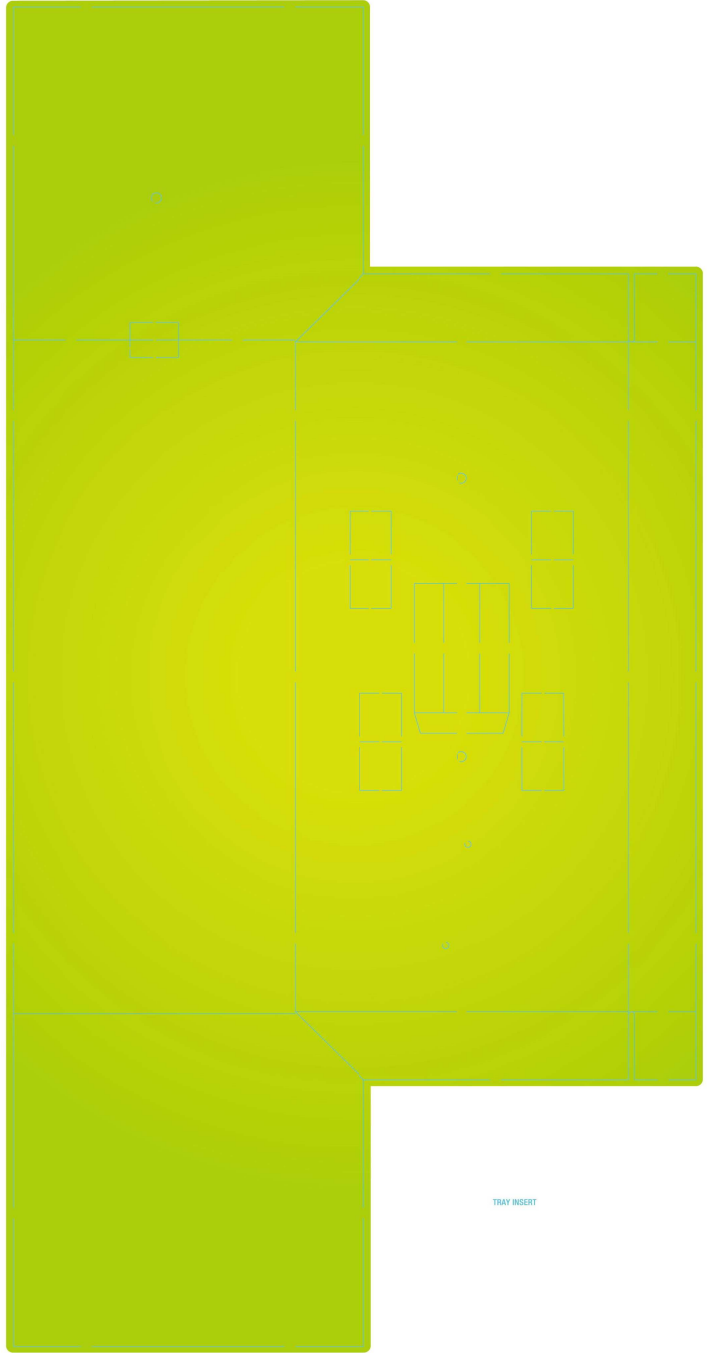
- Do not operate during thunderstorms or rain.
