





CD and CD+G

Loading a Disc

- 1. Open the CD door.
- Load a CD, CD-R/RW, or CD+G disc into the karaoke machine, label side facing
- Close the CD door. 3

Playing a Loaded Disc

- Follow the instructions for Loading a Disc.
- Press the CD/Bluetooth button to 2. switch to CD+G mode.

The CD indicator will light up.

- Plug the included microphone into the Mic 1 or Mic 2 input.
- Press the Play/Pause button to begin playing the loaded disc.

Programming a Loaded Disc

- Follow the instructions for Loading a Disc and Playing a Loaded Disc.
- 2. Press the Stop button to stop the loaded disc.
- 3. Press the **Program** button.
- Press the Skip/Search buttons to select a track from the loaded disc.
- Press the **Program** button to add the 5. selected track to the program.
- Repeat steps 4 and 5 to program up to 20 tracks to play in a specified order.
- Press the Stop button to cancel a program.

Charging

Charging a Device

- Make sure the unit is plugged into the wall.
- Using the appropriate USB charging cable (not included), connect one end to the device and the other to the USB Charging Port on the unit.

Refer to the user's manual for your specific device for manufacturers required charging amperage as well as determining the appropriate cable for your device before charging.

The device will now charge.

Bluetooth Setup

Pairing a Bluetooth Device for the First Time

- Power on the unit by pressing the Power
- Press the CD/Bluetooth button repeatedly to switch to Bluetooth mode.
- Press the Pair button.

The pairing indicator will flash blue quickly and the unit will enter pairing mode. When pairing, remain within 3 feet of the

Using the native controls on your Bluetooth device, select the "IJB383" in your Bluetooth settings to pair.

If your device requests a password, enter the default password " 0 0 0 0 ".

Refer to the user's manual for your specific device for instructions on pairing and connecting Bluetooth devices.

When successfully paired and connected, the pairing indicator will display a solid blue light.

After initial pairing, the unit will stay paired unless unpaired manually by the user or erased due to a reset of the device.

If your device should become unpaired or you find it is unable to connect, repeat the above steps or press the Pair button to start the pairing process pairing again.

Playing Audio Wirelessly

- Follow the instructions for Pairing a Bluetooth Device.
- Use the native controls on the connected Bluetooth Device to select a
- To play, pause or skip the selected track, use the native controls on the connected Bluetooth Device or press the Play/ Pause or Tun/Skip/Search buttons.
- 4. Audio played through the connected Bluetooth device will now be heard through the speakers.

AVC

Automatic Voice Control

The AVC (Automatic Voice Control) dial adjusts the volume of the unit to compensate for varying levels of volume from the microphone. Turn the dial to adjust the degree to which the Automatic Voice Control compensates for variations in volume.


To manually adjust voice control use the Echo knob on the front of the unit.

Video and Audio Outputs

RCA Audio Output

Requires an RCA audio cable (included)


- Connect an RCA audio cable to the RCA Audio Output on the karaoke machine and an audio input on an external stereo system.
- Adjust the external stereo systems source to the input used in step one.
- Audio played through the karaoke machine will now be heard through the connected stereo system.



Connecting the Composite Video Output

Requires an RCA video cable (included)

- Connect an RCA video cable to the RCA Video Output on the karaoke machine and a video input on a television.
- Adjust the television source to the input used in step one.
