






# Introduction and Setup

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Plug the included AC power cord into an AC power outlet to power the unit.




#### Source/Pair


Adjust the switch to one of the sources to turn the unit on. In Bluetooth mode, press to begin pairing.

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# Bluetooth Setup

Pairing a Bluetooth Device for the First Time

Adjust the Source/Pair knob to the Bluetooth/Line in setting.

> The Pairing Indicator will flash blue slowly.

When pairing, remain within 3 feet of the unit.

Press the Source/Pair knob

The Pairing Indicator will flash blue quickly.

Using the native controls on your Bluetooth device, select the "ISB313CW" in your Bluetooth settings to pair.


> If your device requests a password, enter the default password " 0 0 0 0 ".

Refer to the user's manual for your specific device for instructions on pairing and connecting Bluetooth devices.

When successfully paired and connected, the Pairing Indicator will display a solid blue light.

> After initial pairing, the unit will stay paired unless unpaired manually by the user or erased due to a reset of the device.

If your device should become unpaired or you find it is unable to connect, repeat the above steps or press the Power/Source knob while on the Bluetooth/Line in setting to start the pairing process pairing again.



# **Using Bluetooth**

#### Playing Audio Wirelessly

- Follow the instructions for Pairing a Bluetooth Device.
- 2. Use the native controls on the connected Bluetooth Device to select a
- To play or pause the selected track, use the native controls on the connected Bluetooth Device.
- Audio played through the connected Bluetooth device will now be heard through the speakers.

### Radio

#### Tuning the AM or FM Radio

- Adjust the Source/Pair knob to the AM or FM radio in setting.
- Use the Tuning knob to adjust the radio to the desired frequency.
- Use the Volume knob to adjust the volume
- Adjust the Source/Pair knob to Off setting to turn the radio off.

#### Radio Reception

Adjust the position of the FM Antenna to improve FM radio reception.

An AM antenna is built into the clock radio. To improve AM radio reception, adjust the position of the clock radio.

#### Using the Line In

Requires a 3.5mm audio cable (not included)

- Adjust the Source/Pair knob to the Bluetooth/Line in setting.
- Connect a 3.5mm audio cable to the Line In on the unit and an audio output on an MP3 player or other audio source.
- Use the native controls on the connected MP3 player or other audio source to play and control audio played through the clock radio.

# Charging

#### Charging a Device

- Make sure the unit is plugged into the
- Using the appropriate USB charging cable (not included), connect one end to the mobile device and the other to the USB Port on the unit.

Refer to the user's manual for your specific device for manufacturers required charging amperage as well as determining the appropriate cable for your device before charging. Not suitable for charging iPads or other large devices.

The device will now charge.
