The application contains technical information which Navtech Radar Ltd deems to be trade secrets and propriety. If made public, the information might be used to the disadvantage of the applicant in the market place.

Navtech Radar Ltd have request that the internal photos be held confidential for the following reasons:

- The internal circuit boards and components are not accessible to users without dismantling the unit.
- The unit is not accessible to the public as the installation locations are within secure locations such as within airport perimeters on posts typically 4-6m from ground level.
- The units are not field serviceable and must be returned to a service centre for operations that require the enclosure to be opened.
- Professional installers shall be subject to an appropriate NDA.
