I have reviewed the above referenced TCB Application and find that the following items are needed before the review can be completed:

1. There was no test report submitted for this dual band multi channel extender. Please submit a test report documenting compliance with the FCC Rule Parts 22 & 24 and the FCC Amplifier/Booster guide as well as the Industry Canada requirements for the associated IC application AN06I1913. Once these reports are received the applications will need to be reviewed again.
2. Please provide internal photographs with better resolution and clarity. The FCC acceptable criteria is that the components can be resolved and markings be read.
3. The Parts List exhibit submitted is actually a module list. Please submit a component/parts list as required by the FCC.

The items indicated above must be submitted before processing can continue on the above referenced application. Failure to provide the requested information within 30 days of the original e-mail date may result in application dismissal and forfeiture of the filing fee. Also, please note that partial responses increase processing time and should not be submitted.
