Colocation Exprosure Exclusion:

According to KDB 447498 D01 General RF Exposure Guidance v05r02, EUT has two 2.4 GHz band antenna and two 5 GHz band antenna. The power density for 2.4 GHz band is 0.2273 (refer to T301s 2.4 GHz band report R1407152-247 Final, section 4). So the sum of MPE ratio for four antennas is: 0.8406 which is smaller than 1.0. So the colocation exprosure exclusion applies.
