## 4.6 BAND EDGES MEASUREMENT

### 4.6.1 LIMITS OF BAND EDGES MEASUREMENT

Below  $-20\text{dB}$  of the highest emission level of operating band (in 100kHz Resolution Bandwidth).

### 4.6.2 TEST INSTRUMENTS

**NOTE:** The calibration interval of the above test instruments is 12 months and the calibrations are traceable to NML/ROC and NIST/USA.

### 4.6.3 TEST PROCEDURE

#### For Single TX:

The transmitter output was connected to the spectrum analyzer via a low lose cable. Set both RBW and VBW of spectrum analyzer to 100kHz with suitable frequency span including 10Hz bandwidth from band edge. The band edges was measured and recorded.

The spectrum plots (Peak RBW = VBW = 100kHz; Average RBW = 1MHz, VBW = 10Hz) are attached on the following pages.

#### For Dual TX:

- a. The EUT was placed on the top of a rotating table 0.8 meters above the ground at a 3 meter semi-anechoic chamber. The table was rotated 360 degrees to determine the position of the highest radiation.
- b. The EUT was set 3 meters away from the interference-receiving antenna, which was mounted on the top of a variable-height antenna tower.
- c. The antenna is a broadband antenna, and its height is varied from one meter to four meters above the ground to determine the maximum value of the field strength. Both horizontal and vertical polarizations of the antenna are set to make the measurement.
- d. For each suspected emission, the EUT was arranged to its worst case and then the antenna was tuned to heights from 1 meter to 4 meters and the rotatable table was turned from 0 degrees to 360 degrees to find the maximum reading.
- e. Set both RBW and VBW of spectrum analyzer to 100kHz with suitable frequency span including 100MHz bandwidth from band edge. The band edges was measured and recorded.

The spectrum plots (Peak RBW = VBW = 100kHz; Average RBW = 1MHz, VBW = 10Hz)

**NOTE:** The resolution bandwidth of test receiver/spectrum analyzer is 1 MHz and the video bandwidth is 10Hz for Average detection (AV) at frequency above 1GHz.

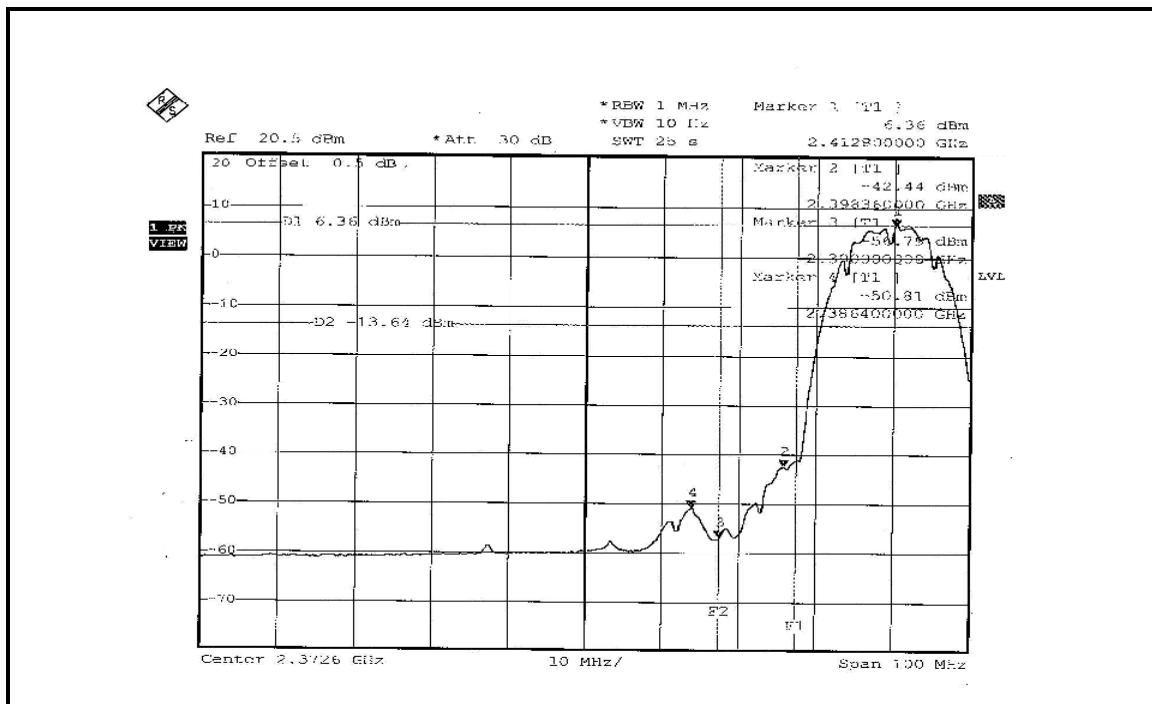
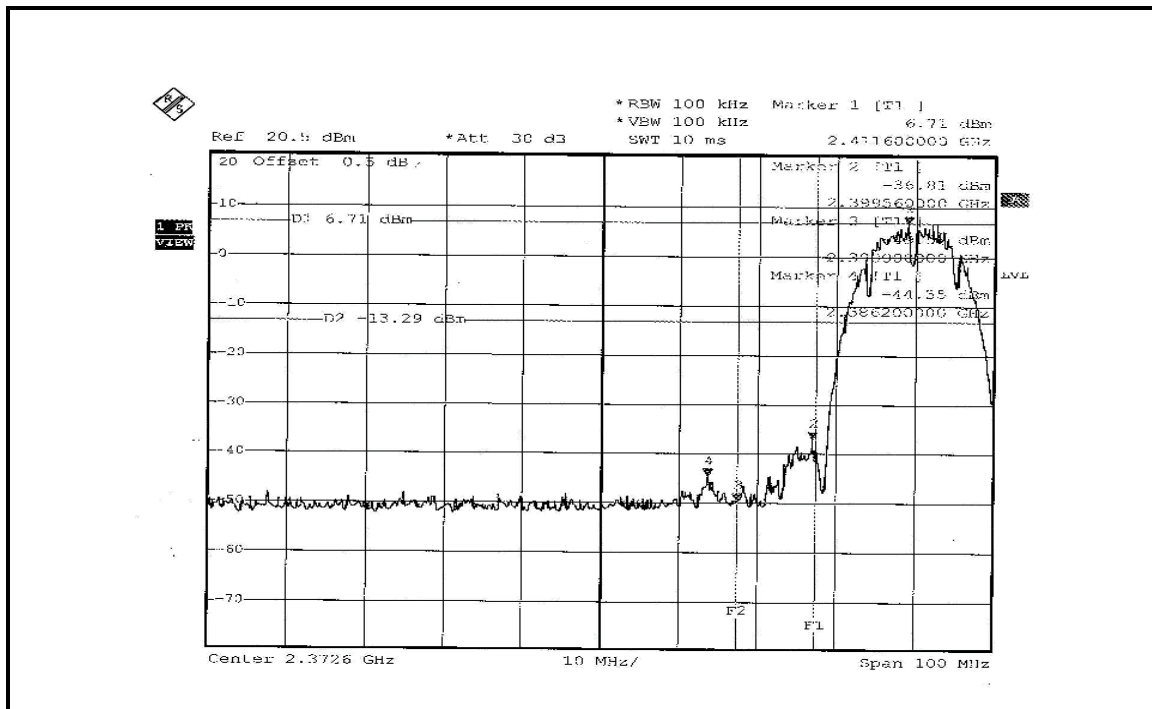
The band edge emission plot of DSSS technique on the next page shows 51.26dBc between carrier maximum power and local maximum emission in restrict band (2.38620GHz). The emission of carrier strength list in the test result of channel 1 at the item 4.2.7 is 111.89dBuV/m (Peak), so the maximum field strength in restrict band is  $111.89 - 51.26 = 60.63$ dBuV/m which is under 74dBuV/m limit.

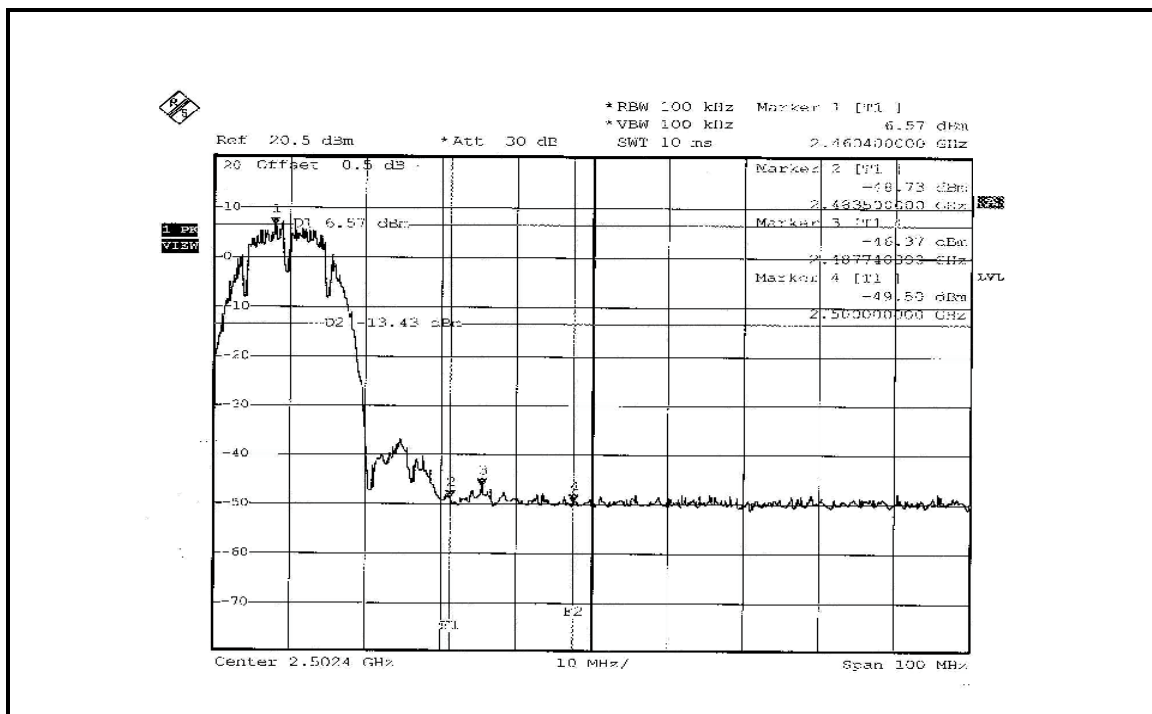
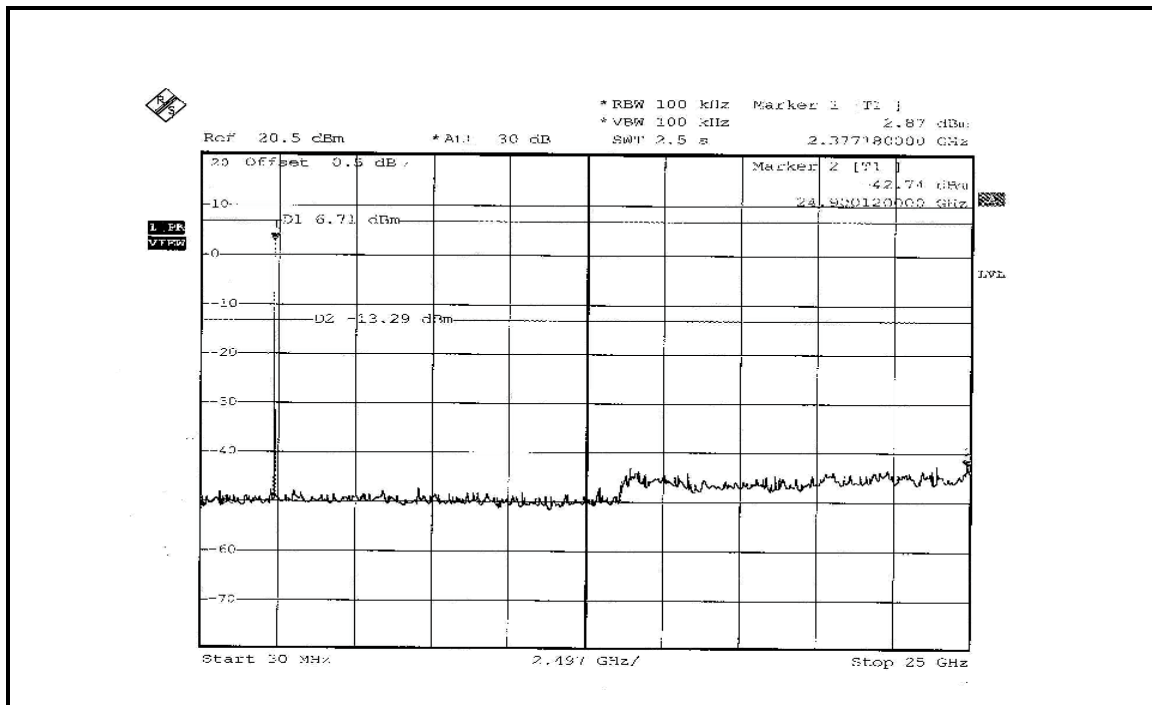
The band edge emission plot of DSSS technique on the next page shows 57.17dBc between carrier maximum power and local maximum emission in restrict band (2.38640GHz). The emission of carrier strength list in the test result of channel 1 at the item 4.2.7 is 107.84dBuV/m (Average), so the maximum field strength in restrict band is  $107.84 - 57.17 = 50.67$ dBuV/m which is under 54dBuV/m limit.

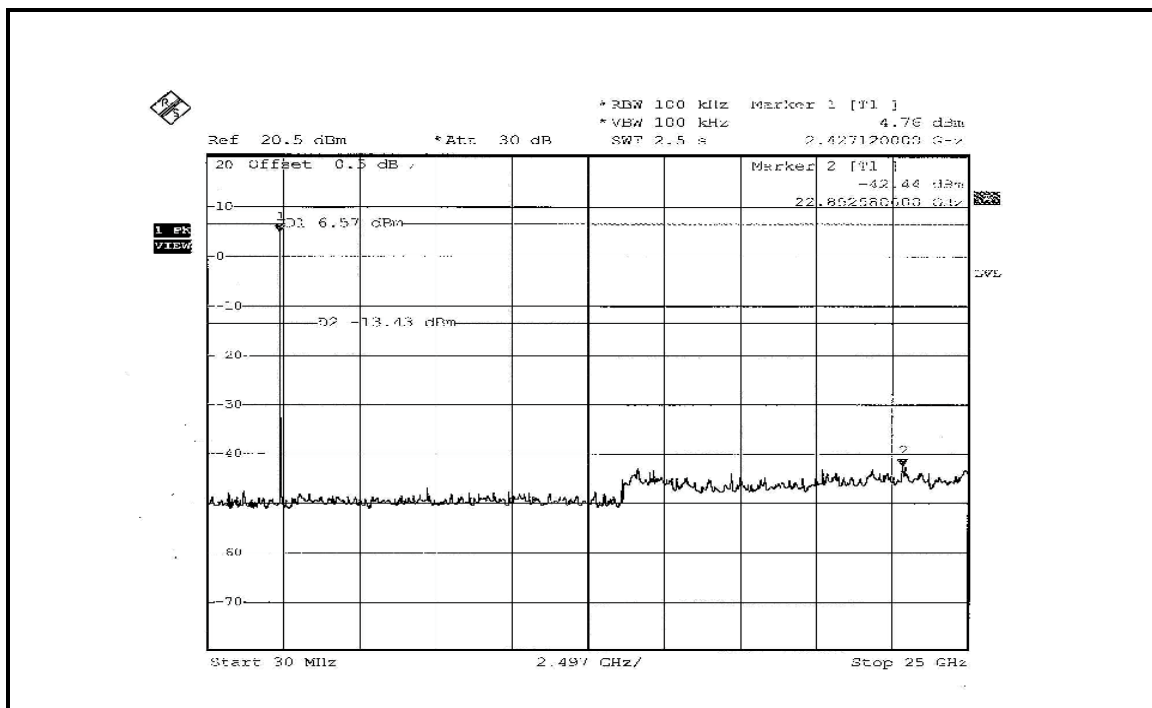
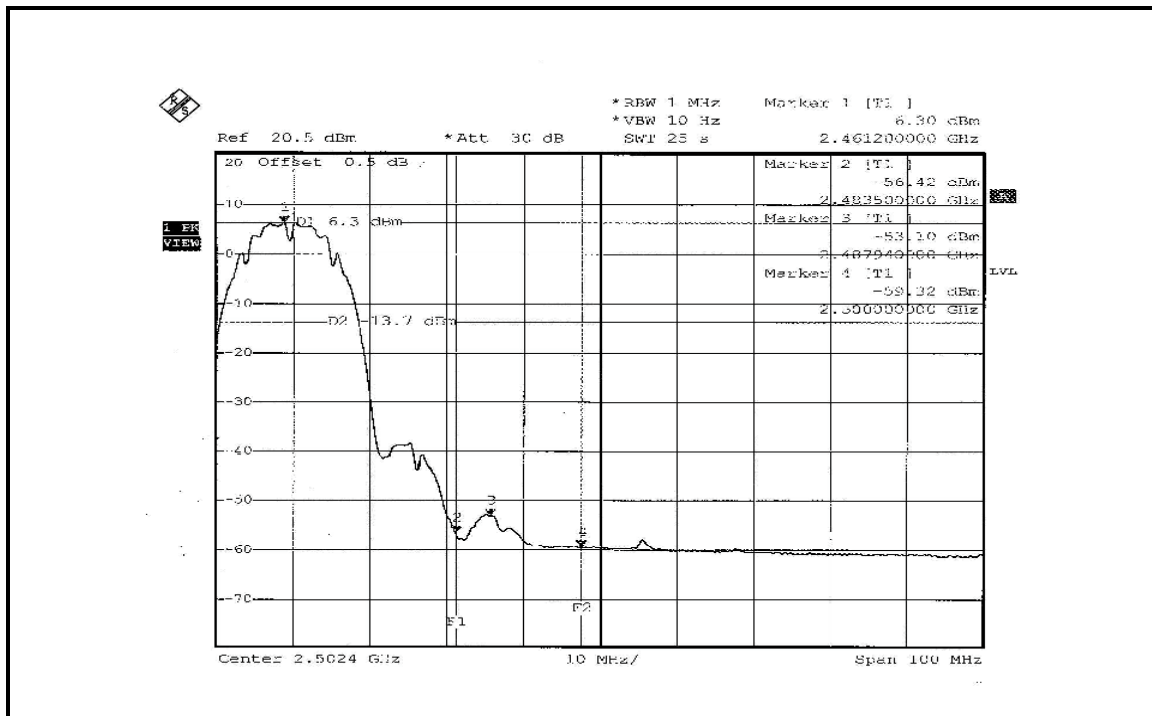
##### **NOTE 2:**

The band edge emission plot of DSSS technique on the next second page shows 52.94dBc between carrier maximum power and local maximum emission in restrict band (2.48774GHz). The emission of carrier strength list in the test result of channel 11 at the item 4.2.7 is 111.94dBuV/m (Peak), so the maximum field strength in restrict band is  $111.94 - 52.94 = 59.00$ dBuV/m which is under 74dBuV/m limit.

The band edge emission plot of DSSS technique on the next third page shows 59.40dBc between carrier maximum power and local maximum emission in restrict band (2.48794GHz). The emission of carrier strength list in the test result of channel 11 at the item 4.2.7 is 107.75dBuV/m (Average), so the maximum field strength in restrict band is  $107.75 - 59.40 = 48.35$ dBuV/m which is under 54dBuV/m limit.

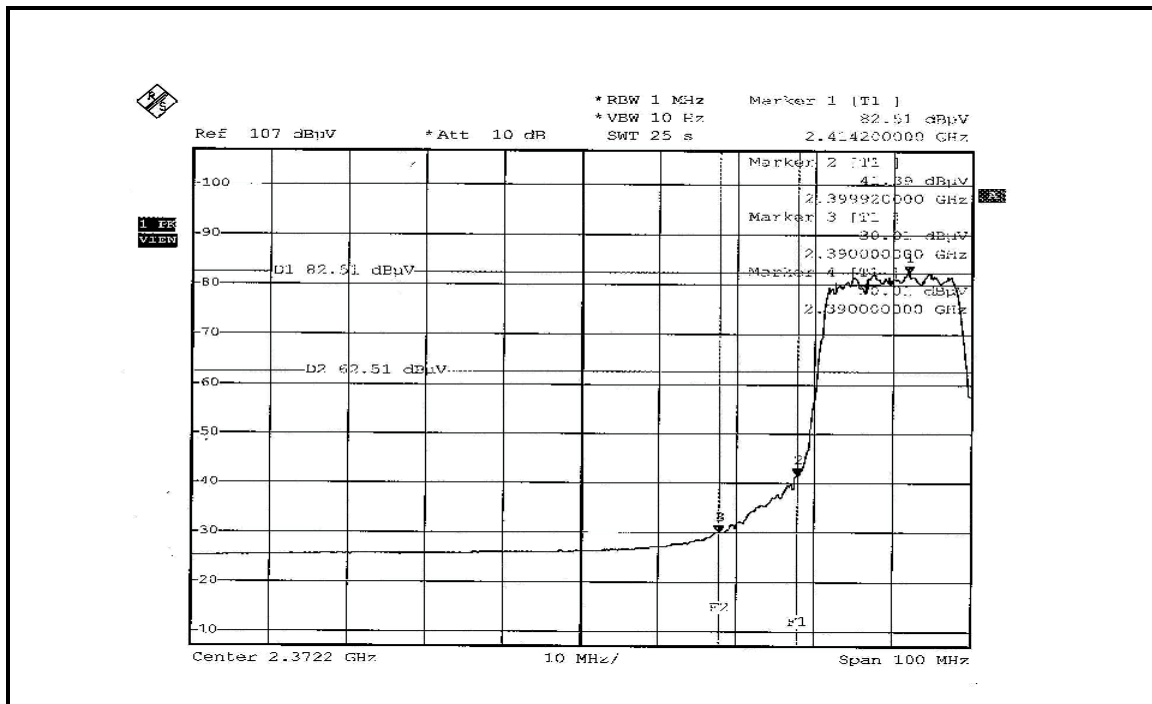
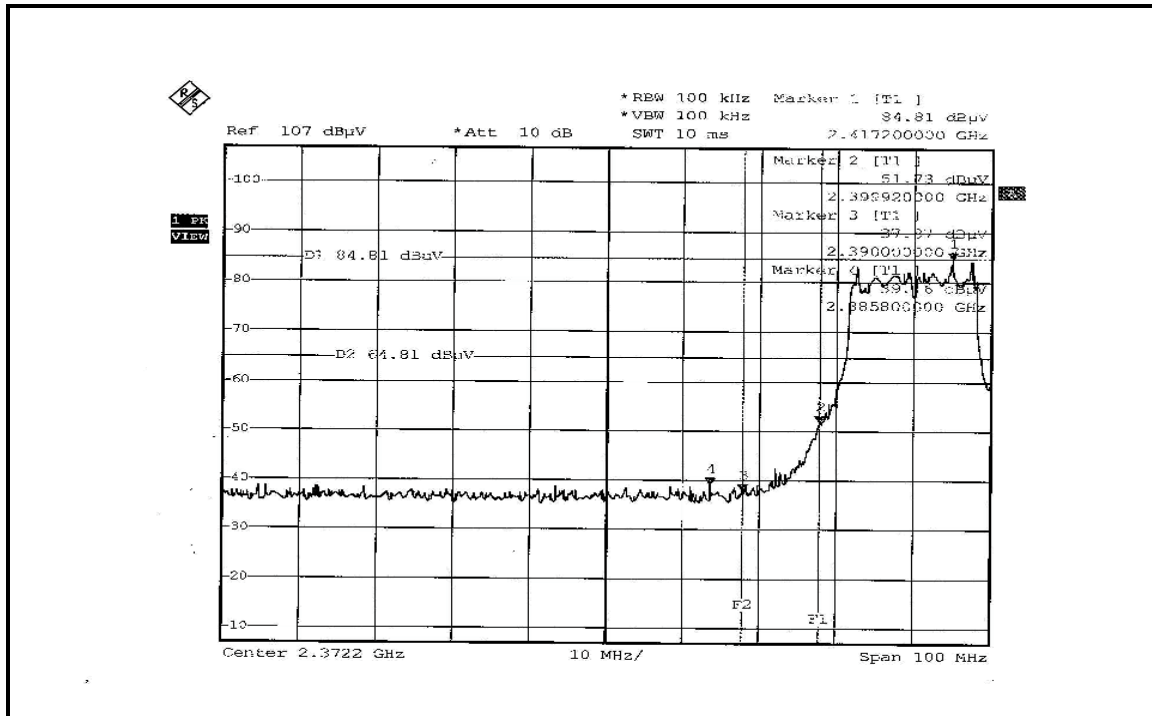
The band edge emission plot of OFDM technique on the next page shows 45.65dBc between carrier maximum power and local maximum emission in restrict band (2.38580GHz). The emission of carrier strength list in the test result of channel 1 at the item 4.2.7 is 113.26dBuV/m (Peak), so the maximum field strength in restrict band is  $113.26 - 45.65 = 67.61$  dBuV/m which is under 74dBuV/m limit.

The band edge emission plot of OFDM technique on the next page shows 52.50dBc between carrier maximum power and local maximum emission in restrict band (2.39000GHz). The emission of carrier strength list in the test result of channel 1 at the item 4.2.7 is 102.84dBuV/m (Average), so the maximum field strength in restrict band is  $102.84 - 52.50 = 50.34$  dBuV/m which is under 54dBuV/m limit.

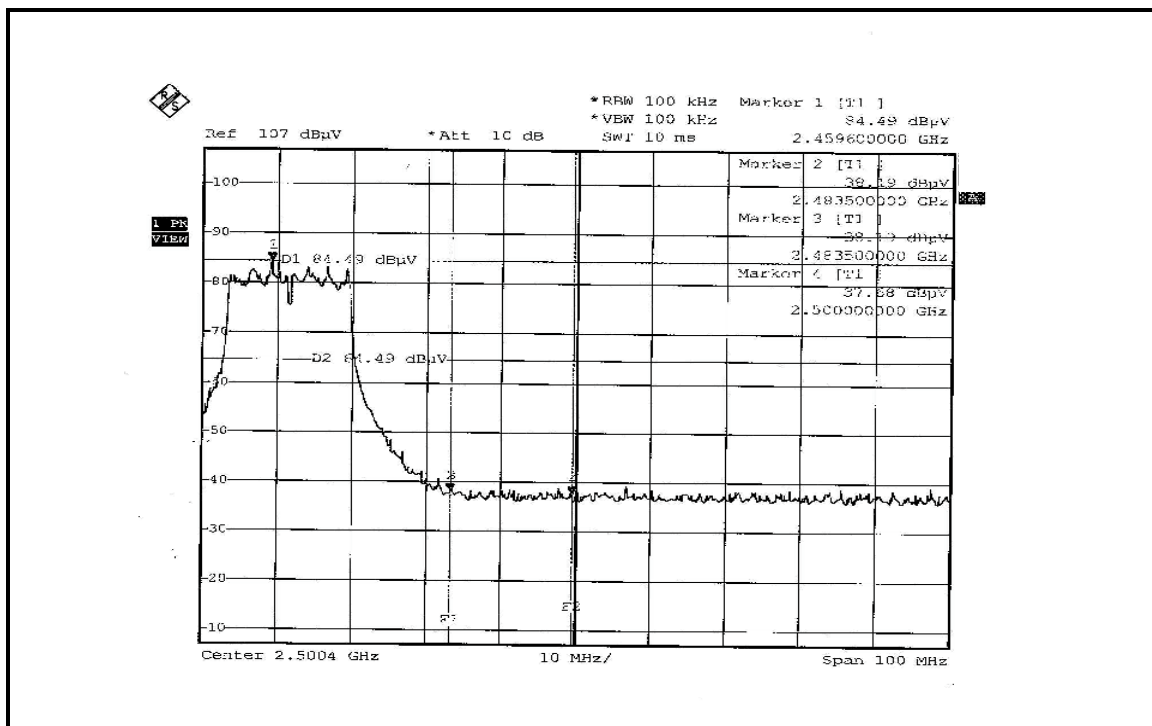
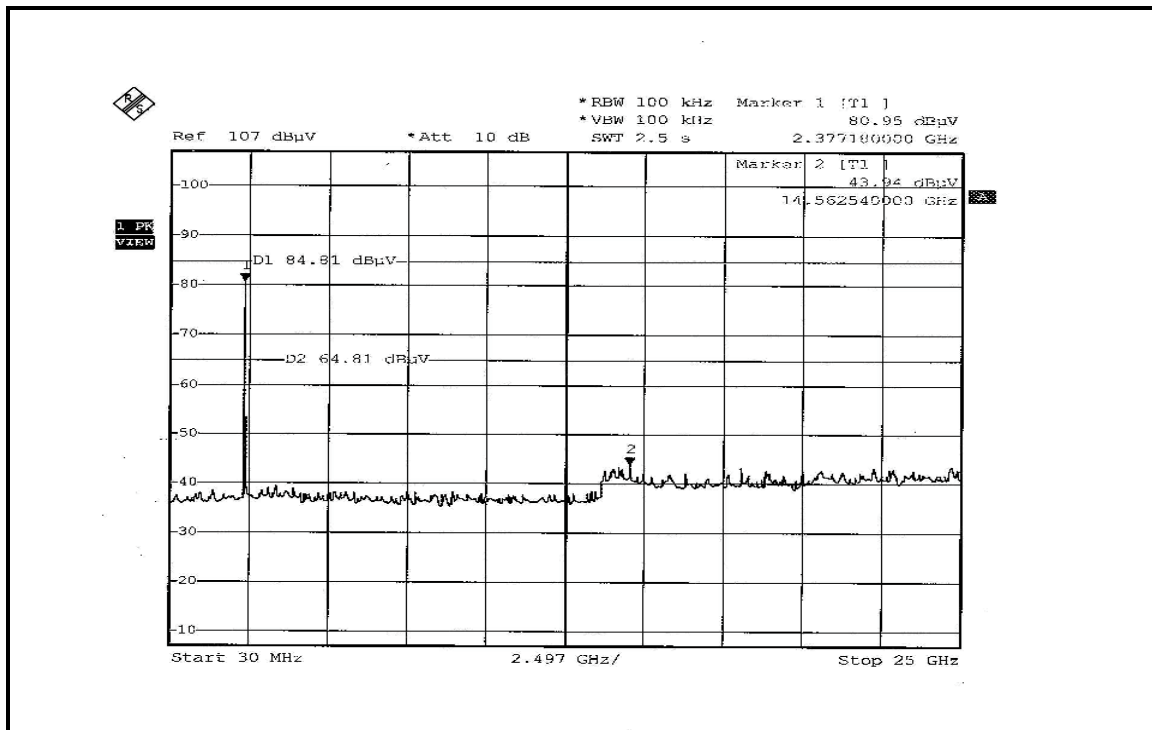

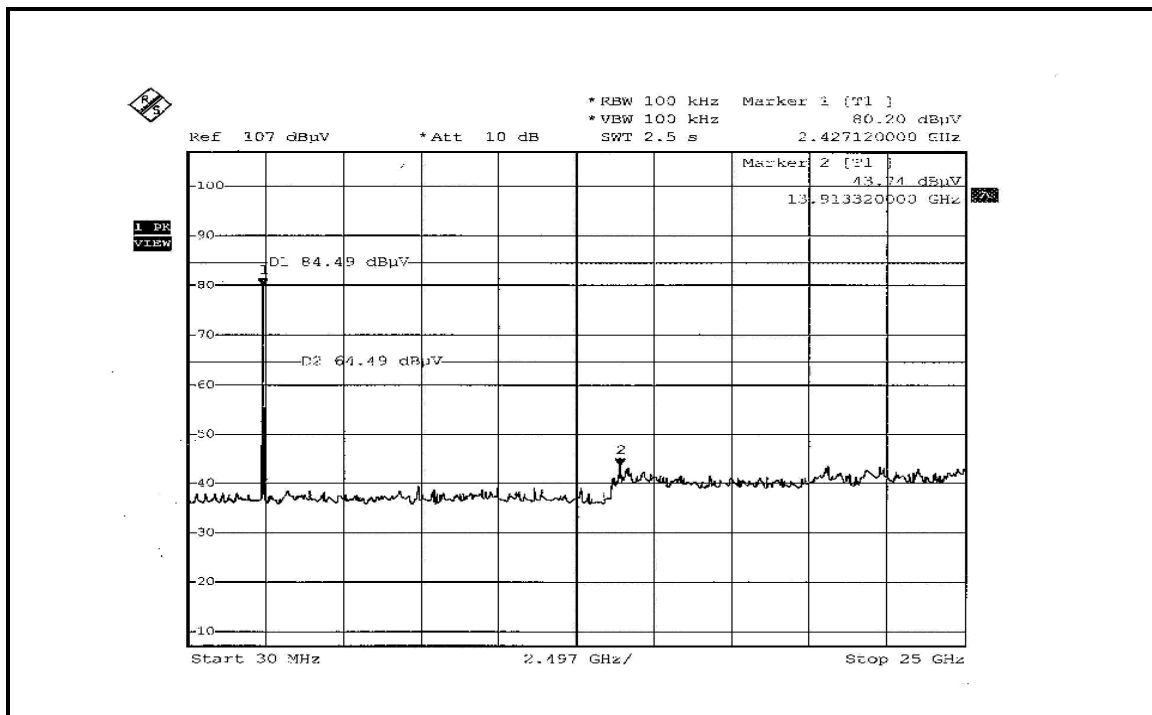
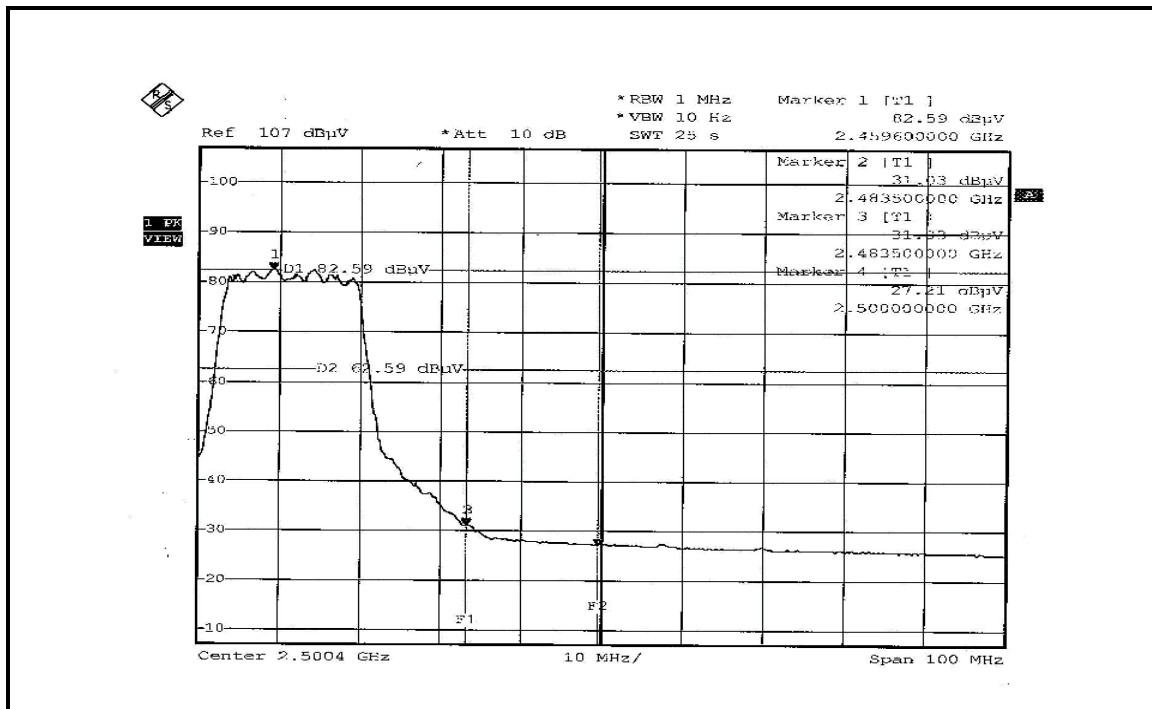
The band edge emission plot of OFDM technique on the next second page shows 46.30dBc between carrier maximum power and local maximum emission in restrict band (2.48350GHz). The emission of carrier strength list in the test result of channel 11 at the item 4.2.7 is 113.44dBuV/m (Peak), so the maximum field strength in restrict band is  $113.44 - 46.30 = 67.14$  dBuV/m which is under 74dBuV/m limit.

The band edge emission plot of OFDM technique on the next third page shows 51.56dBc between carrier maximum power and local maximum emission in restrict band (2.48350GHz). The emission of carrier strength list in the test result of channel 11 at the item 4.2.7 is 103.16dBuV/m (Average), so the maximum field strength in restrict band is  $103.16 - 51.56 = 51.60$  dBuV/m which is under 54dBuV/m limit.

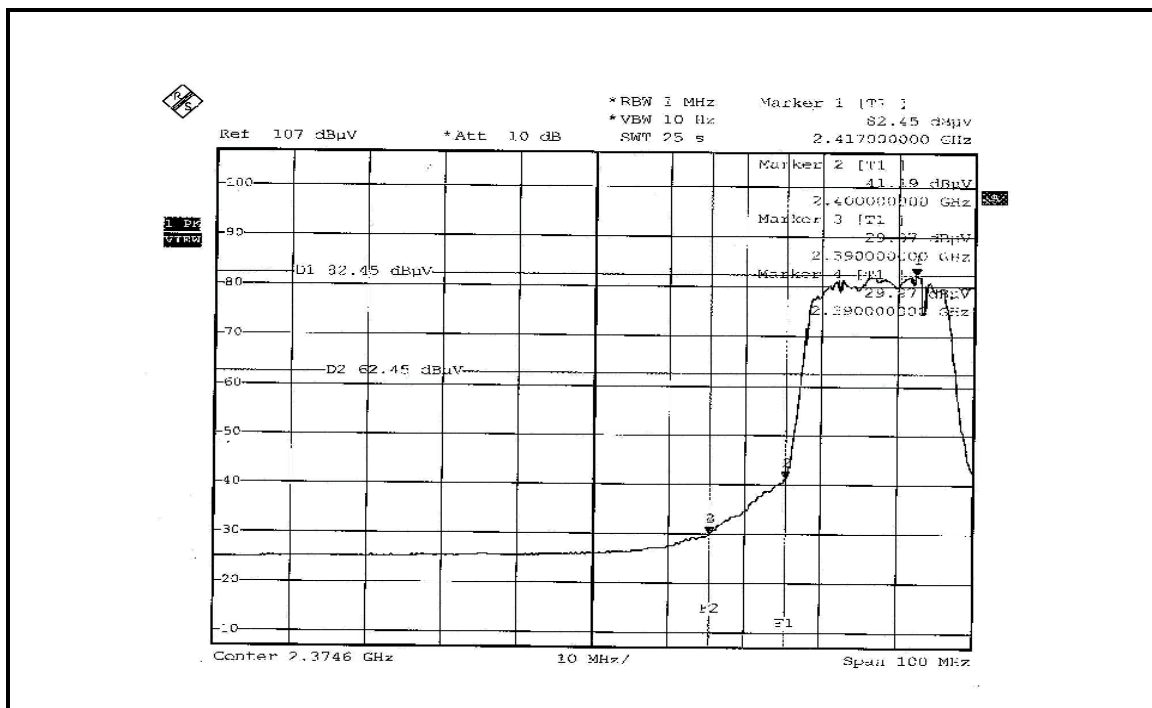
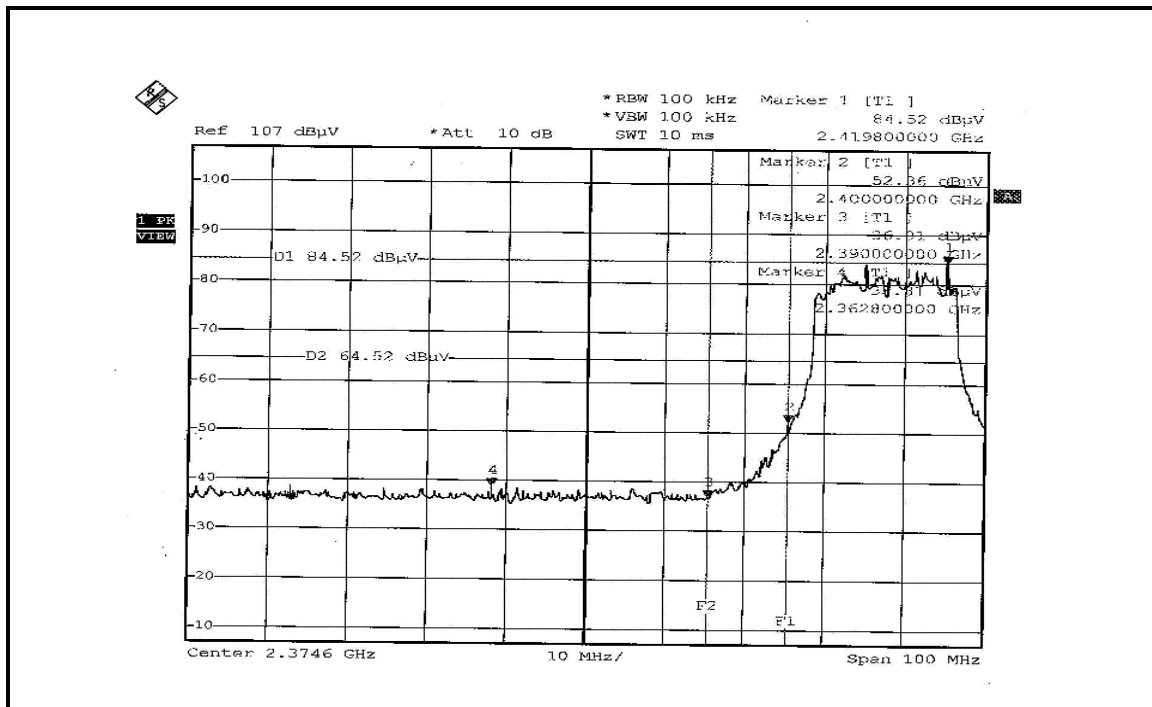
The band edge emission plot of OFDM technique on the next page shows 45.71Bc between carrier maximum power and local maximum emission in restrict band (2.36280GHz). The emission of carrier strength list in the test result of channel 1 at the item 4.2.7 is 112.30dBuV/m (Peak), so the maximum field strength in restrict band is  $112.30 - 45.71 = 66.59$ dBuV/m which is under 74dBuV/m limit.

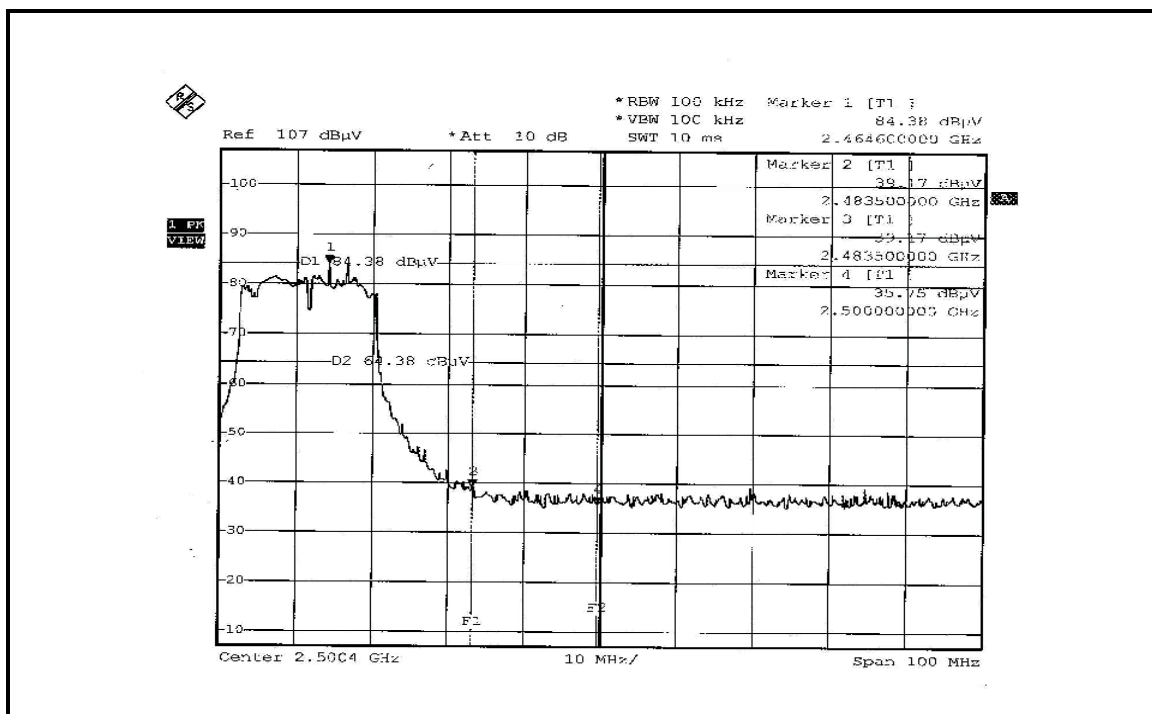
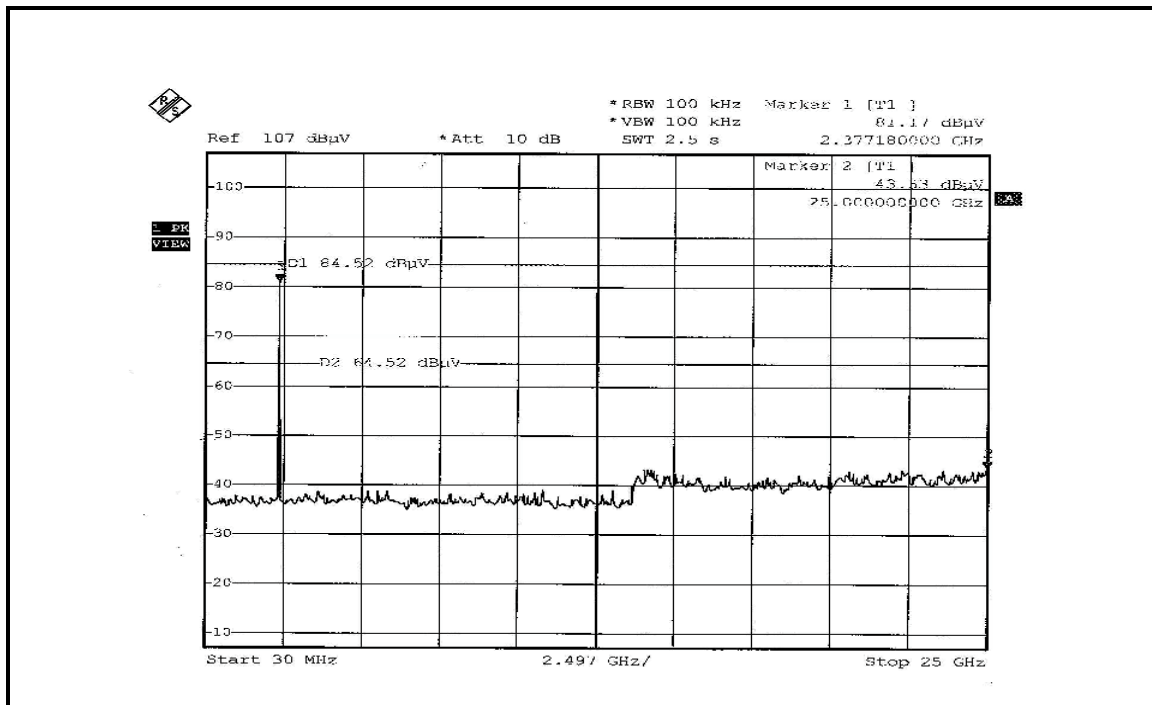
The band edge emission plot of OFDM technique on the next page shows 52.48dBc between carrier maximum power and local maximum emission in restrict band (2.39000GHz). The emission of carrier strength list in the test result of channel 1 at the item 4.2.7 is 103.15dBuV/m (Average), so the maximum field strength in restrict band is  $103.15 - 52.48 = 50.67$ dBuV/m which is under 54dBuV/m limit.

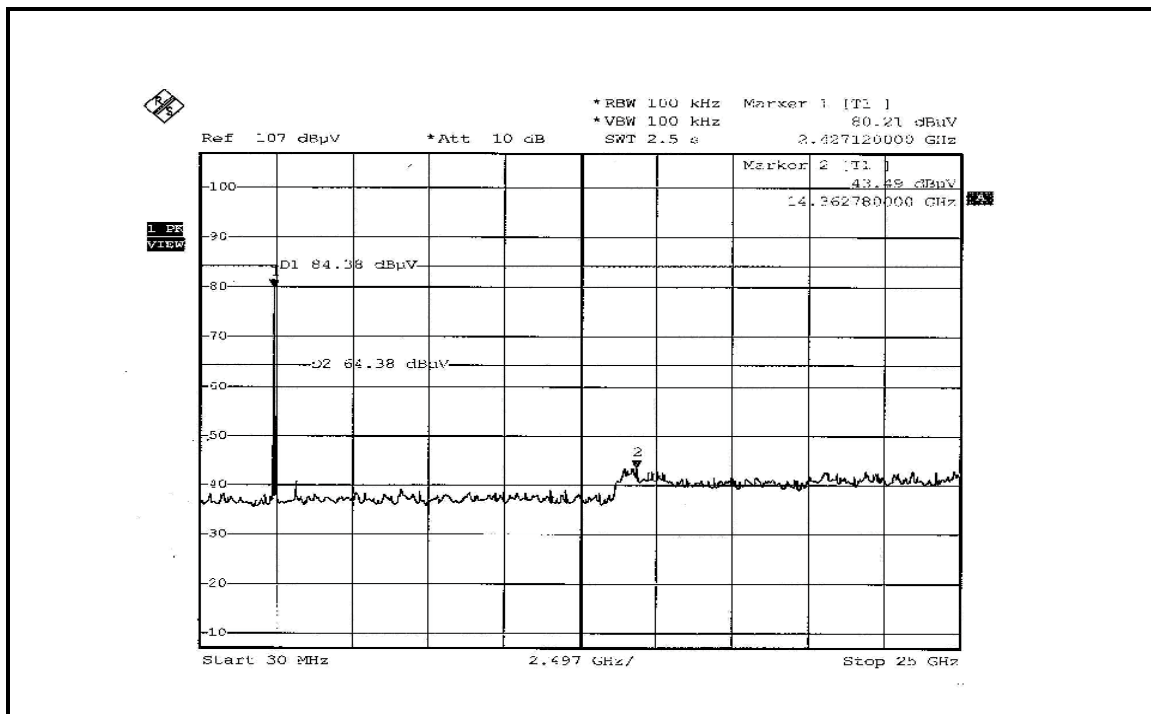
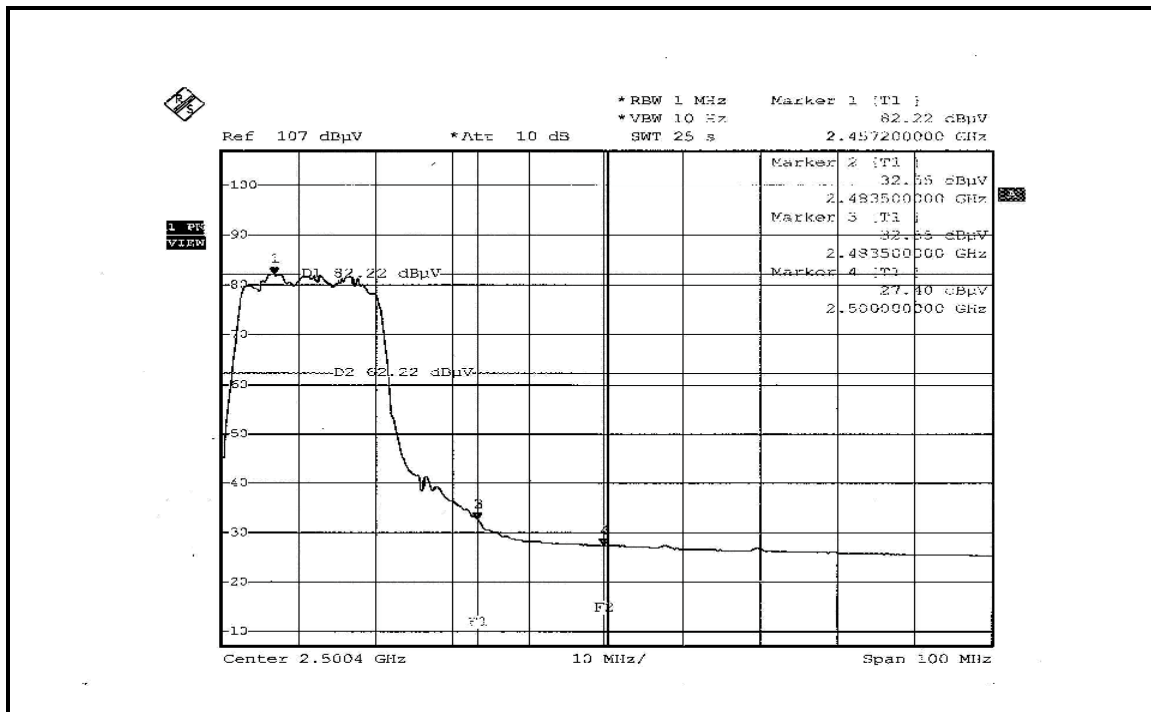

The emission of carrier strength list in the test result of channel 11 at the item 4.2.7 is 112.39dBuV/m (Peak), so the maximum field strength in restrict band is  $112.39 - 45.21 = 67.18$ dBuV/m which is under 74dBuV/m limit.

The band edge emission plot of OFDM technique on the next third page shows 49.67dBc between carrier maximum power and local maximum emission in restrict band (2.48350GHz). The emission of carrier strength list in the test result of channel 11 at the item 4.2.7 is 102.31dBuV/m (Average), so the maximum field strength in restrict band is  $102.31 - 49.67 = 52.64$ dBuV/m which is under 54dBuV/m limit.

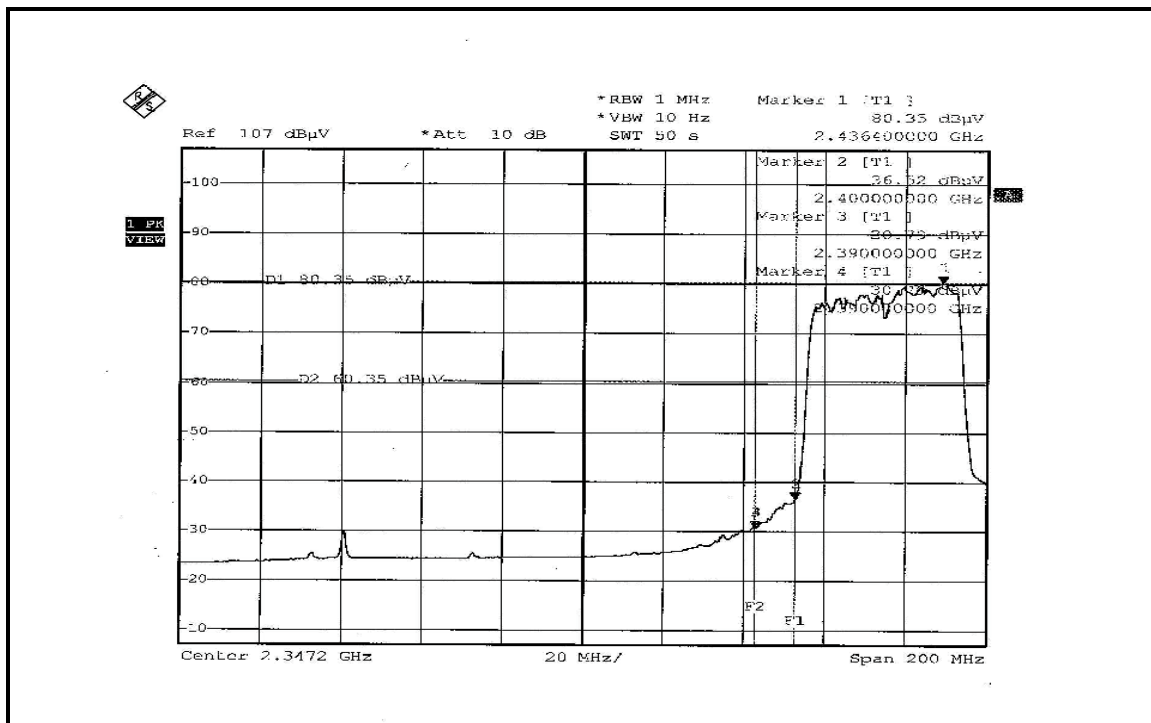
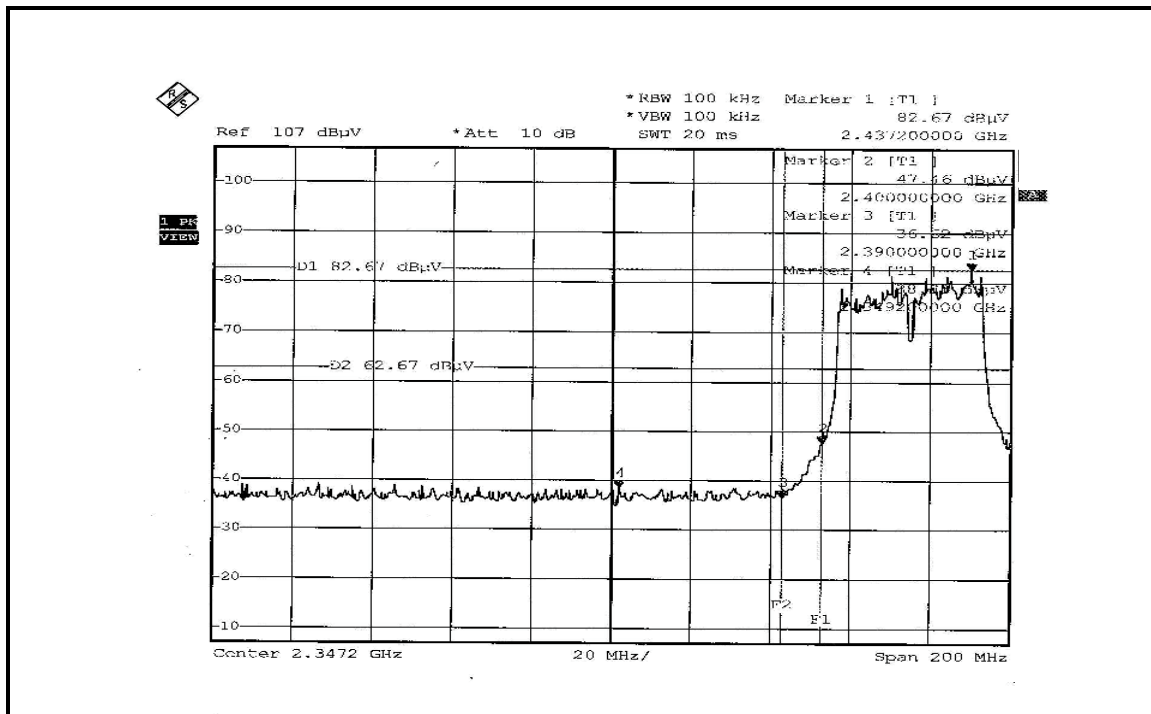
The band edge emission plot of OFDM technique on the next page shows 44.42dBc between carrier maximum power and local maximum emission in restrict band (2.34920GHz). The emission of carrier strength list in the test result of channel 1 at the item 4.2.7 is 107.59dBuV/m (Peak), so the maximum field strength in restrict band is  $107.59 - 44.42 = 63.17$ dBuV/m which is under 74dBuV/m limit.

The band edge emission plot of OFDM technique on the next page shows 49.56dBc between carrier maximum power and local maximum emission in restrict band (2.39000GHz). The emission of carrier strength list in the test result of channel 1 at the item 4.2.7 is 98.01dBuV/m (Average), so the maximum field strength in restrict band is  $98.01 - 49.56 = 48.45$ dBuV/m which is under 54dBuV/m limit.

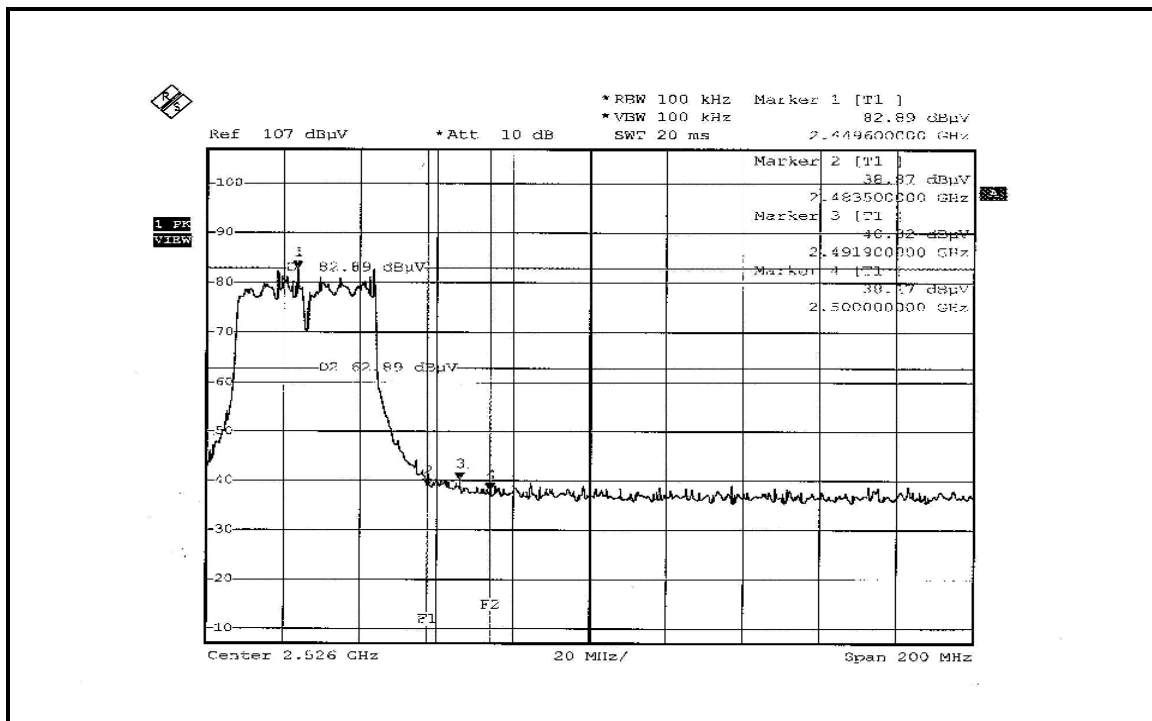
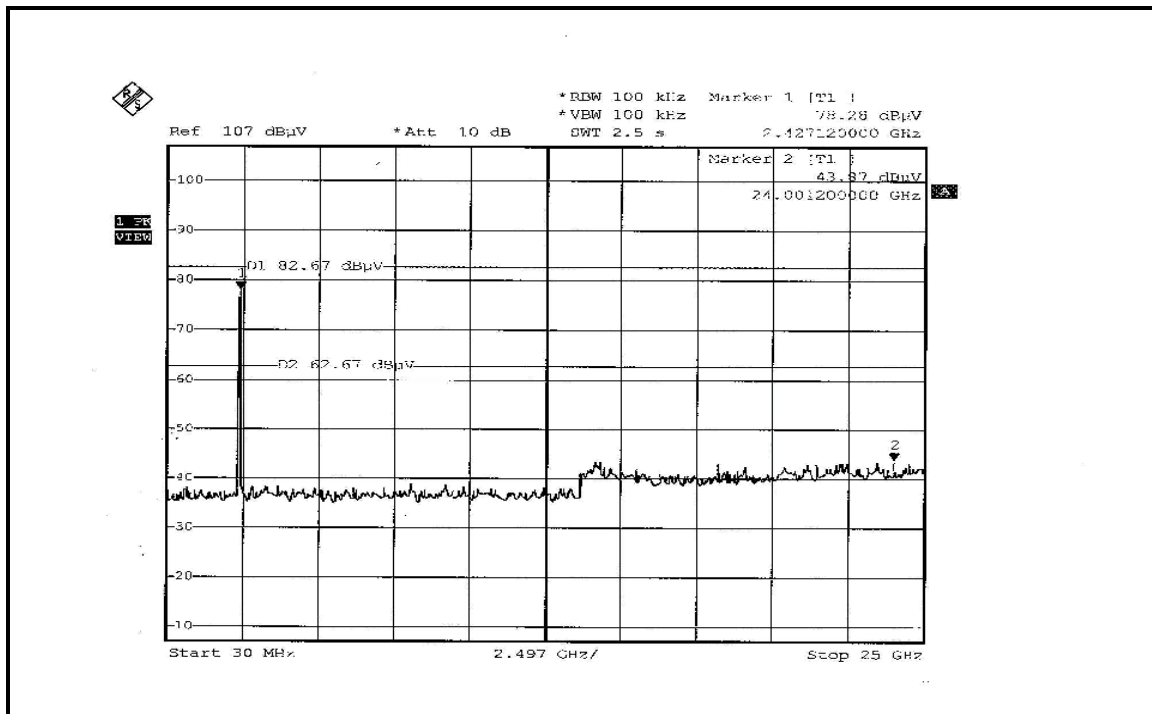

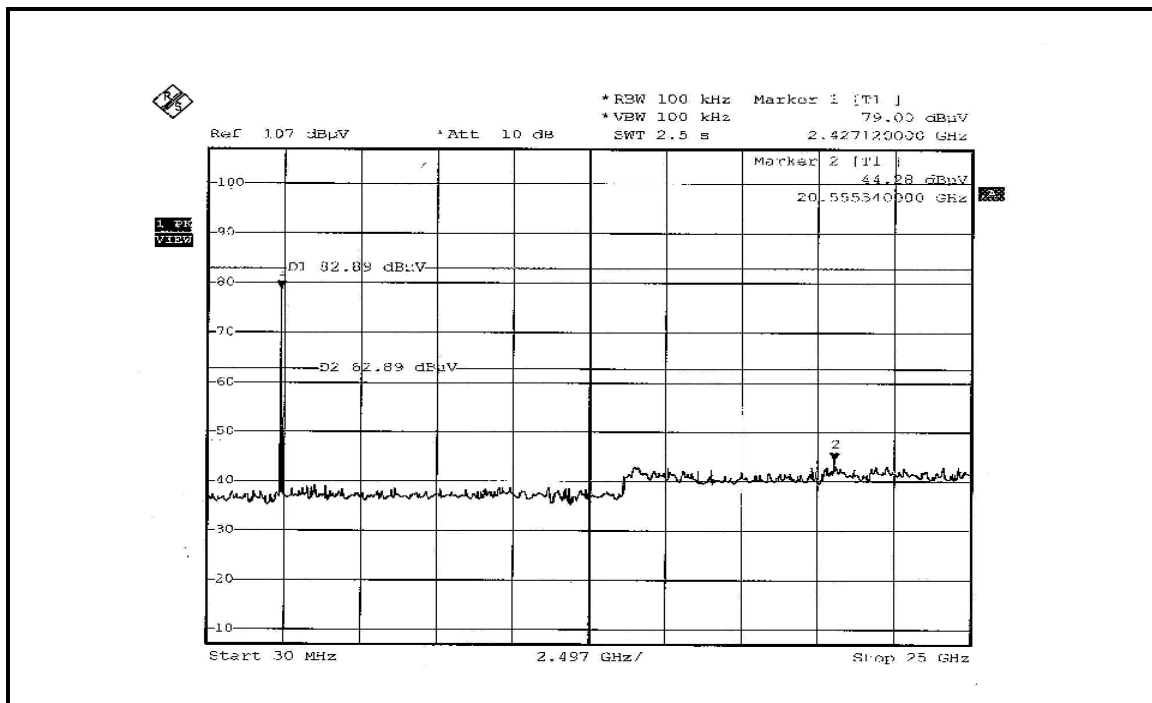
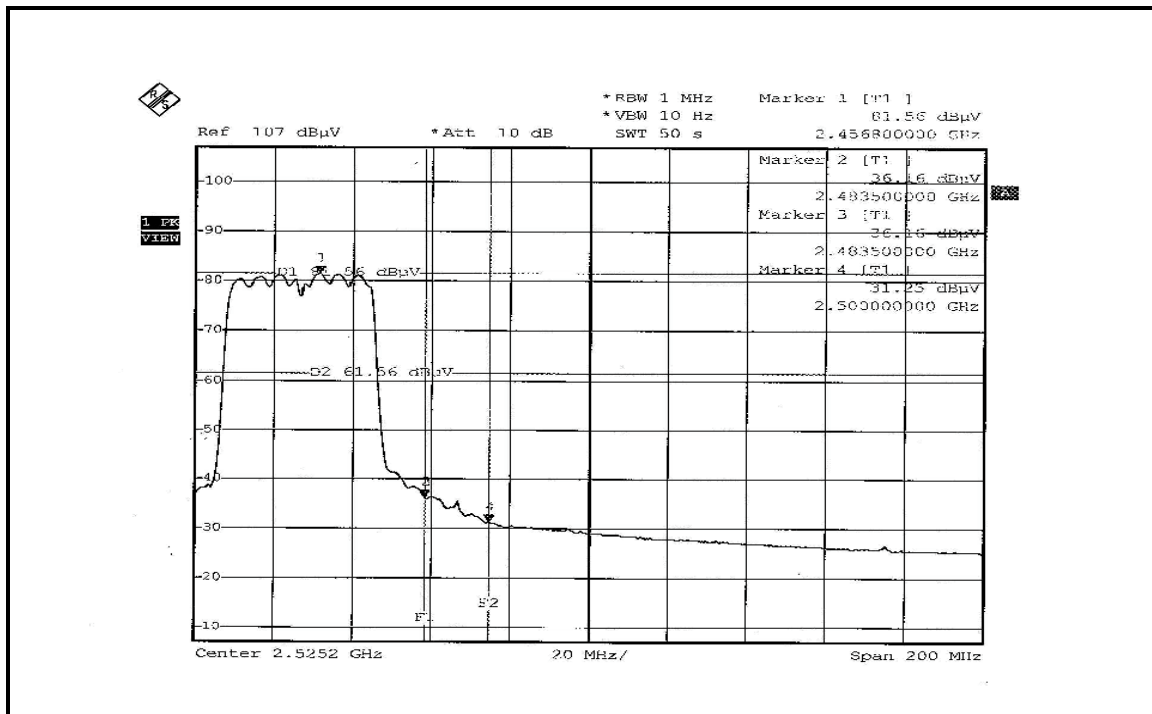
The band edge emission plot of OFDM technique on the next second page shows 42.57dBc between carrier maximum power and local maximum emission in restrict band (2.49190GHz). The emission of carrier strength list in the test result of channel 7 at the item 4.2.7 is 107.46dBuV/m (Peak), so the maximum field strength in restrict band is  $107.46 - 42.57 = 64.89$ dBuV/m which is under 74dBuV/m limit.

The band edge emission plot of OFDM technique on the next third page shows 45.40dBc between carrier maximum power and local maximum emission in restrict band (2.48350GHz). The emission of carrier strength list in the test result of channel 7 at the item 4.2.7 is 97.54dBuV/m (Average), so the maximum field strength in restrict band is  $97.54 - 45.40 = 52.14$ dBuV/m which is under 54dBuV/m limit.









## 4.7 ANTENNA REQUIREMENT

### 4.7.1 STANDARD APPLICABLE

For intentional device, according to FCC 47 CFR Section 15.203, an intentional radiator shall be designed to ensure that no antenna other than that furnished by the responsible party shall be used with the device. And according to FCC 47 CFR Section 15.247 (b), if transmitting antennas of directional gain greater than 6dBi are used, the power shall be reduced by the amount in dB that the directional gain of the antenna exceeds 6dBi.

### 4.7.2 ANTENNA CONNECTED CONSTRUCTION

The antenna used in this product is Dipole antenna with UFL connector. The maximum Gain of the antenna is 4dBi.
