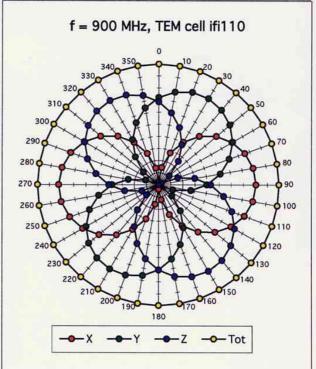

Receiving Pattern (ϕ), $\theta = 0^{\circ}$

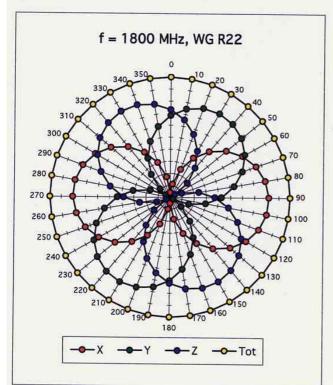


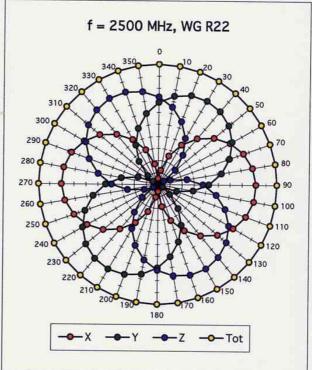




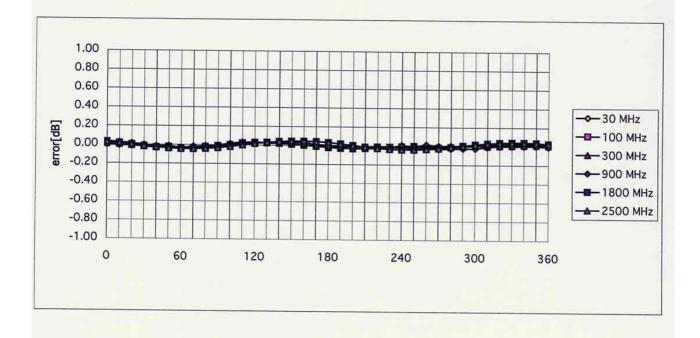


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Isotropy Error (ϕ), $\theta = 0^{\circ}$
