Question #1: The user manual indicates this device is an extender, acting as a repeater. So this device might receive the RF signal from remote control, then forward the signal to receiver, so the device is a transceiver. Please clarify whether the device is a transmitter or a transceiver. If it is a transceiver, the correct equipment class should be "DSR" not "DSC". OK, thanks for your reminder

Question #2: Please clarify whether the device will be activated automatically or manually. The test report indicates the device is activated manually, the transmisssion time is calculated after the button is released. It seems the device only has a "Setup" button. Please explain which button is used for testing. If the device is activated automatically, please explain how the device meets 15.231(a)(2) requirement: "A transmitter activated automatically shall cease transmission within 5 seconds after

activation."

A:The device is activated automatically after receiving RF signals from another 433MHz transmitter(seems a switch which can transmit signal) When the EUT receives the RF signal from the transmitter(approved), then forward the signal to receiver. all the process takes time as the report expressed.
