

To comply with 15.202 requirements for client devices, the Sonos PLAY:1 are programmed at the factory for a specific geographic location or region code. The wireless LAN operating parameters such as available channels and transmit power levels are set based on the region code. Periodic system software updates cannot change the region code or wireless LAN operating parameters. The PLAY:1 is protected with a cryptographic signature, which prevents the loading of unauthorized software.
