

Sensus Non-Disclosure Memorandum

Sensus OEMs:

This memorandum serves as an additional agreement between Sensus and its OEMs stating that the OEMs will use the Sensus GFL3 module (See Appendix 1) in accordance with the FCC rules on modular approved devices. The Sensus GFL3 Transceiver is professionally installed inside various Sensus and third party meters. The module label will be located either on the side of the host meter or on the front of the host meter and will display both the FCC and IC IDs of the GFL3 module. Confidentiality of the internal photos and the technical manual is being requested because this is a non-consumer device which is not accessible by the general public, professionally installed, and is only serviceable by Sensus, or designated technicians.


