







- 1. Plug the Mini USB end of the included Mini USB cable into the USB port at the back of speaker.

- 4. Set your mobile phone or other Bluetooth enabled device to search for Bluetooth devices.



- 6. When the Bluetooth enabled device finds the speaker, select "PBT3002" from the list of found
- 7. If required, enter the password 0000. Select OK or Yes to pair the two units.
- 8. After a successful pairing, the LED indicator light will slowly blink BLUE.

The speaker will stay paired unless unpaired manually

by the user or erased due to a reset of the device. If your device should become unpaired or you find it is unable to connect, repeat the above steps to start

the pairing process pairing again.

- · If the speaker cannot pair up with the last device within 10 minutes, it will enter sleep mode. Switch the speaker off and on again to wake it up.
- The speaker will automatically connect to the last device that it was paired to. To switch to another device, turn off the current paired device and restart the pairing process.
- If the speaker has already been connected to a Bluetooth device, the speaker will reconnect with the Bluetooth device automatically.
- · Bluetooth will turn off when the 3.5mm Audio Cable is inserted. It will automatically pair with the last device when the Audio Cable is disconnected.

Battery use

This speaker comes with a rechargeable battery but it can also use 4 AA Alkaline batteries (not included) as well. There is no need to remove the rechargeable battery if you are using AA Alkaline batteries.

To install and use AA batteries follow the instructions

- 1. Open the battery compartment on the back of the
- 2. Install AA batteries be sure to match the polarities.
- 3. Close the battery compartment.

Note: If both hattery types are inserted, when the alkaline batteries' voltage is lower than the rechargeable battery, the speaker will be powered by the rechargeable battery; but if the AA Alkaline batteries' voltage is higher than the rechargeable battery, the speaker will be powered by the AA Alkaline

You can charge the rechargeable battery while the alkaline batteries are inserted.

Using as a wired speaker
